Applications are invited for a Stiftung Volkswagenwerk Southeast Asia Fellowship for German Scholars tenable at the Institute of Southeast Asian Studies, Singapore. Eligibility: The Fellowship is limited to applicants who

Eligibility: The Fellowship is limited to applicants who are national or permanent residents of the Federal Republic of Germany.

Qualifications: Candidates should have completed a university degree in one of the disciplines of the Social Sciences or Humanities, though preference would be given to those with Ph.D. or equivalent qualifications. The research proposed should result in a manuscript of acceptable standard, and, hopefully, one ready to be considered for publication. Accordingly, preference would be given to individuals who would be in a position to complete their proposed research projects in the time allotted under the Fellowship.

Duration of Award: The Fellowship can be for any appropriate length of time, ranging from 3 to a maximum of 12 months. Extension beyond 12 calendar months will not be considered.

Focus of Research: Maximum flexibility is to be allowed in terms of research and study, provided that the focus is on:

- (1) Southeast Asia, particularly work in the area of problems of development and modernization, and political and social change; and
- (2) any reasonable topic within the broad commercial, economic, cultural, and political dimensions of contacts between (and/or involving) Germany or Europe and Southeast Asia, or parts thereof.

Research Projects: Research projects submitted for consideration should be well thought-out and be as complete as possible in terms of aims and objectives, scope and schedule or work.

Stipend/Living Allowance: The range here will depend on the candidates' qualifications, experience and the specific conditions of leave from home institutions.

Other Benefits: In addition, support for travel und research is available.

Selection: Selection of candidates will be by a Selection Committee consisting of senior scholars from Southeast Asia. The Selection Committee will also include a German member.
