The Association for Korean Studies in Europe announces its 1984 Conference, which will be held at Van Mildert College, University of Durham, England, 12-17 April 1984.

Papers, in English, French, German or Korean, may be offered on any subject in Korean studies, but members suggested at the 1983 Membership Meeting that two themes might be particularly appropriate this time: the centenaries of Korean-British and Korean-German diplomatic relations, and Korean music, the study of which has been encouraged at Durham.

The cost of the Conference is expected to be about £100 (Sterling) per participant. The Association has funds to subsidise the costs of travel and participation.
