The Asiatic Society of Japan Prize

The Asiatic Society of Japan, established in 1872 and one of the oldest learned societies in Japan, intends to award a prize of US\$ 1,000 for an essay in Japanese studies within the areas of history, social studies, and literature. The winning essay will be published in the Society's *Transactions*. Candidates may select their own subject provided such subject has been previously submitted to and approved by the editor. The essay must be a genuine work of original research, hitherto unpublished, and one which has not been awarded any other prize. The length, excluding footnotes and appendices, should not exceed 8,000 words and the essay must be submitted on or before 31 December 1987.
