Die deutschen Wissenschaftler sollen mehr in englischer Sprache publizieren, um auch international wahrgenommen zu werden; und sie sollen mehr in referierten Zeitschriften veröffentlichen, da dies ein Ausdruck wissenschaftlicher Qualität ist. Dies hat der Wissenschaftsrat bisher in nahezu jedem Gutachten gefordert, das er - im Rahmen der Evaluierung der Institute der Blauen Liste - über ein außeruniversitäres Forschungsinstitut erstellt hat. Das Gleiche wird auch von den Wissenschaftlern der Universitäten verlangt; und was die Asienwissenschaftler betrifft, so war es die einhellige Meinung von Vertretern aller regionalen Fächer während einer Podiumsdiskussion, die die DGA im Mai 1997 in Berlin veranstaltete, daß deren Forschungsergebnisse unbedingt durch Veröffentlichungen in englischer Sprache weltweit stärker bekannt gemacht werden sollten.

Um dabei ein kleine Hilfestellung zu leisten, wurden vom Institut für Asienkunde die folgenden Zeitschriften angeschrieben und um Informationen zu ihrer Veröffentlichungspraxis sowie zum Referee-Verfahren gebeten. Aus Platzgründen werden bei den einzelnen Zeitschriften nur die jeweiligen Antworten und nicht alle Kategorien aufgeführt.
