### Botswana (June 12)

Chinese President Jiang Zemin and Botswana President Festus Mogae attended a signing ceremony on several cooperative agreements, including an agreement between the two foreign ministries to establish political consulting mechanism, a framework agreement on preferential credit granting, an inter-governmental agreement to encourage and protect investment, and a cultural exchange executive plan for 2001-2003. (XNA, 13 June 00)

### Bulgaria (June 28)

China and Bulgaria signed five documents on bilateral cooperation in culture, education, health, environment, communications, and labor and social affairs during Premier Zhu Rongji's visit. (RMRB, XNA, 29 June 00)

### Cameroon (June 14)

Chinese Foreign Minister Tang Jiaxuan and Augustin Kontchou Kouomegni, visiting Cameroonian minister of state for foreign relations, signed an agreement on establishing political consultation between the two foreign ministries. (XNA, 15 June 00)

On 16th June, Shi Guangsheng, minister of foreign trade and economic cooperation, and Augustin Kontchou signed an agreement that says China will offer assistance to the African country. (XNA, 17 June 00)

### Finland (June 13)

China and Finland signed a memorandum of understanding to boost their cooperative relationship in the procuratorial sector. Han Zhubin, the visiting procurator-general of the Supreme People's Procuratorate of China, and his Finnish counterpart, Matti Kusi-maki, signed the document, which aims to work together to train procurators of the two sides and to exchange law information periodically. (XNA, 14 June 00)

### Iceland (June 22)

China and Iceland signed a memorandum of understanding to strengthen existing cooperative agreements between the two countries' supreme courts. Under the memo, which was signed by visiting Chinese Chief Procurator Han Zhubin and his Icelandic counterpart Bogi Nilsson, the legal departments of the two nations will arrange exchanges of officials to discuss issues of common interest and relevant legal documents. They will also exchange procurators to carry out professional studies or receive further professional training. (XNA, 24 June 00)

### Iran (June 22)

China and Iran signed five documents in Beijing. The five inter-governmental documents include cultural and educational exchange programs for the period 2000-2002, an agreement on mutual promotion and protection of investment, a memorandum of understanding on energy cooperation, a memorandum of understanding on tourism cooperation, and a letter of intent on mineral and metallurgical industry cooperation. Chinese President Jiang Zemin and Iranian President Seyyed Mohammad Khatami witnessed the signing of the documents. (RMRB, XNA, 23 June 00)

### Moldova (June 07)

China and Moldova signed three agreements in Beijing. The three inter-governmental agreements are on cooperation in public health and medical sciences, prevention of dual taxation and tax evasion, and civil avia-

tion transportation. Chinese President Jiang Zemin and visiting Moldova President Petru Lucinschi witnessed the signing of the documents. (RMRB, XNA, 8 June 00)

Beijing and Chisinau, the capital city of Moldova, signed a memorandum of cooperation with President Petru Lucinschi attending the signing ceremony. Beijing Mayor Liu Qi and Mayor of Chisinau Serafim Urechean signed the memorandum on behalf of their respective cities. Beijing and Chisinau signed a cooperative agreement in 1997. (XNA, 8 June 00)

### Norway (June 19)

China and Norway signed a memorandum of understanding on cooperation between the two countries' supreme procuratorates. Visiting Chinese Chief Procurator Han Zhubin signed the memo in Oslo. (RMRB, 21 June 00)

### Spain (June 25)

Chinese Premier Zhu Rongji and visiting Spanish Prime Minister Jose Maria Aznar attended a signing ceremony of an agreement on combating organized crime and a programme on financial cooperation. (RMRB, XNA, 26 June 00) Spain and China signed two cooperation agreements: the first of them concerning internal affairs issues and, above all, mutual help for the fight against organized crime; the second, a financial cooperation agreement to the tune of 700m US\$, that is to say, some 130b Pesetas. (RNE Radio 1, Madrid, 25 June 00, in SWB, 27 June 00)

### United States (June 19)

China and the United States signed an agreement on mutual legal assistance in criminal matters in Beijing. Chinese Assistant Foreign Minister Zhang Yesui and US Charge D'affaires to China Eugene Martin signed the agreement on behalf of their respective governments. The agreement includes mutual assistance in service of documents and in investigation and taking evidence as well as assistance in freezing, seizure and forfeiture proceedings. The two countries held two rounds of talks on the agreement in September 1998 and March 1999. Both sides initiated an agreement in March 1999. (RMRB, XNA, 20 June 00)

### International Agreement

On 15th June, China, the Congo, Lesotho, Latvia and Slovakia became signatories to the revised World Customs Organization (WCO) Convention, which is aimed at facilitating customs procedures. The five countries joined Algeria, Sri Lanka, Zambia, Zimbabwe and Australia which are the countries that have signed the Kyoto Convention since its revision in June last year. The WCO still needs 30 more countries to sign the revised customs convention in order for it to take effect. The revised convention has established modern international standards in customs procedures. Designed to enable more rapid clearance of goods, people and conveyances, the new procedures are expected to maximize the use of new information technology and modern clearance techniques based on risk analysis. The signatory nations will facilitate international trade, stimulate economic growth and provide targeted customs control at their borders and frontiers after they have incorporated the revised convention into national legislation. The Brussels-based WCO now has 151 members, of which 61 signed the previous Kyoto Convention that took effect on September 25, 1974. (XNA, 16 June 00; RMRB, 17 June 00)

### HKSAR Agreement with Norway (June 02)

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) signed an air services agreement with the Government of the Kingdom of Norway. Secretary for Economic Services Stephen Ip signed the agreement on behalf of the HKSAR government. Hong Kong has signed air services agreements with all the three Scandinavian countries. The agreement brings the number of air services agreements signed by Hong Kong to 44. (XNA, 3 June 00)

## PRC Laws and Regulations

“Regulations on financial reports of enterprises“. These regulations, which consist of six chapters with 46 articles, will become effective on 1st January 2001. (Order No.287 of the State Council, signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 21st June 2000) (Full text: RMRB, 29 June 00)

China publicized procedures on 20th June governing the operation of the domestic philately market, in an effort to step up the administration of philatelic activities and protect the order of the philately market. The “Procedures Governing the Philately Market“, jointly published by the China State Postal Bureau and the State Administration of Industry and Commerce, regulate both trading activities in the philately market and the selling of stamps and postal items by postal enterprises. China has four million members of philatelic associations at various levels, and every year more than 10 million sets of commemorative and special stamps are ordered from post offices. (RMRB, XNA, 21 June 00)
