appointed secretary of CCP Hainan Provincial Committee (see C.a., 2001/7, p.809/19) last August, was elected as the new chairman of Hainan Provincial People's Congress during the 5th meeting of the 2nd Hainan PPC on 6th September 2001. (RMRB, XNA, 7 Sep 01)

### Cambodia (Sep 20)

After the talks of visiting Chinese Minister of Public Health Zhang Wenkang with his Cambodian counterpart, the two sides signed a Memorandum of Understanding on Eliminating AIDS for Mobile Population in the Mekong Sub-region. (XNA, 21 Sep 01)

### Ireland (Sep 03)

Visiting Chinese Premier Zhu Rongji and his Irish counterpart Bertie Ahern attended the signing ceremony of a memorandum of understanding on cultural cooperation. (XNA, 5 Sep 01)

### Kazakhstan (Sep 12)

Visiting Chinese Premier Zhu Rongji and his Kazakhstani counterpart Kasymzhomart Tokayev signed a joint communique and an agreement on the utilization and protection of cross-border rivers. Their ministers inked agreement on the avoidance of double taxation on income, the exchange of letters on China's providing of assistance to Kazakhstan, an agreement on the cooperation in seismic study and another on health cooperation. (XNA, 14 Sep 01)

### Russia (Sep 08)

Visiting Chinese Premier Zhu Rongji and Russian Prime Minister Mikhail Kasyanov attended an agreement signing ceremony, at which they signed a joint declaration of the 6th Sino-Russian prime minister meeting, while other Chinese and Russian officials signed six cooperation documents. The six documents include a summary of the 5th meeting of the committee for regular China-Russia prime minister meeting, agreements on the promotion of aviation safety, the rules of the telecommunication and information technology subcommittee under the Sino-Russian prime minister regular meeting committee, the feasibility study for the construction of an oil pipeline between China and Russia as well as a contract on the purchase of five Russian passenger planes. (XNA, 10 Sep 01)

### Vietnam (Sep 18)

The narcotics control departments of South China's Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region and Vietnam's Guang Ninh Province signed an agreement in Nanning on joint action against drug trafficking. The collaboration between the two sides is significant for combating the drug dealings on the border between the two countries, said Lu Binghua, representative of the Guangxi Narcotics Control Commission and director of the region's Public Security Department. Lu said the agreement has been reached under the initiative and coordination of the United Nation Drug Control Program and the joint efforts between drug control departments of China and Vietnam. (XNA, 19 Sep 01)

### Hong Kong SAR Agreement with Ireland (Sep 19)

The Hong Kong SAR and the government of Ireland signed an agreement on mutual legal assistance in criminal matters, a HKSAR government release said. The agreement was signed by Secretary for Security Regina Ip on behalf of the HKSAR government and Minister for Justice, Equality and Law Reform John O'Donoghue on behalf of the Irish government. The agreement is the 12th of its kind that the HKSAR has signed on international cooperation against crime. The major kinds of assistance covered by the

agreement are serving documents; taking evidence; executing requests for search and seizure; transferring persons to appear as witnesses; and identifying, tracing, restraining, forfeiting and confiscating proceeds and instrumentality of crime. The agreement shall enter into force 30 days after both sides have notified each other in writing that their respective requirements for the entry into force of the agreement have been complied with. (XNA, 20 Sep 01)

### Hong Kong SAR Agreement with the United Kingdom (Sep 18)

Shipowners in Hongkong and the UK will only need to pay tax in either Hong Kong or the UK on their income derived from the other part starting from April 2002. The agreement on this matter has passed through all necessary legislative procedures for approval, a spokesman for the HKSAR government said on 18th September. "Together with similar arrangements with the United States and Chinese mainland and the confirmed provisions of reciprocal tax exemption with the tax authorities of New Zealand and South Korea, HK shipowners are exempt from tax on their international shipping income in four countries and the mainland," the spokesman explained. (XNA, 19 Sep 01)

### Macau SAR Agreement with Czech (Sep 26)

Secretary for Transport and Public Works, Ao Man Long, and the Minister of Communications of Czech Republics signed the aviation agreement in Prague on behalf of the two governments. This is the 33rd aviation agreement that the SAR signed with a foreign country. (Macau Government Information Bureau website, www.gcs.gov.mo, 26 Sep 01)

### Macau SAR Agreement with Japan (Sep 14)

Those who hold the Macau Special Administrative Region (SAR) passports will be granted multiple-entry tourist visas valid for no more than three years by the Japanese government as of 3rd October, according to the latest official sources. This means the maximum term of validity of the tourist visas will be extended by two years, the Identification Bureau of the SAR government has announced. At



present, the Japanese citizens enjoy free-visa treatment for no more than 30 days in Macau. (XNA, 15 Sep 01)

### **Macau SAR Agreement with Poland (Sep 03)**

China's Macau Special Administrative Region (SAR) and the Republic of Poland announced the exemption of visa requirements for the passport holders of the other side. The agreement was signed in Macau by Florinda Chan, secretary for administration and justice of the Macau SAR, and Radoslaw Sikorski, deputy foreign minister of Poland, on behalf of their respective governments. Poland is the 30th country that offers free-visa treatment to those who hold the Macau SAR passports. (XNA, 4 Sep 01)

## **PRC Laws and Regulations**

**Decision of the State Council and the Central Military Commission on Amending the "Regulations on Recruitment Affairs"**. The decision will go into effect on the day of promulgation. (Order Nr. 316 of the State Council of the PRC and the Central Military Commission of the PRC, signed by both Premier Zhu Rongji of the State Council and Chairman of the Central Military Commission Jiang Zemin on 5th September 2001.)

**Regulations on Recruitment Affairs**, issued by the State Council and the Central Military Commission on 24th October 1985 and revised according to the "Decision of the State Council and the Central Military Commission on Amending the 'Regulations on Recruitment Affairs'". (Full text of the revised regulations and the decision: RMRB, 10 Sep 01)

The regulations consist of ten chapters with 55 articles. They include revisions, supplements and fine-tuning of 22 articles of the previous Regulations on Recruitment Affairs, which had been in force since October 1985 and were considered to be unable to meet the demands of modern-day China. The revised regulations further defined division of responsibilities, streamlined the relation between officials and the recruitment work, and improved the registration system in the military, laying a good foundation for improving recruitment work. In the meantime, the revised regulations have made recruitment procedures stricter, while expanding the scope of recruitment, which will make it easier to recruit higher-quality soldiers. (XNA, 10 Sep 01; Xinhua, 9 Sep 01, in BBC PF, 11 Sep 01; RMRB web site, 10 Sep 01, p.6, in BBC PF, 11 Sep 01)

**Anti-desertification Law of the People's Republic of China**. (Decree No. 55 of the President of the PRC, signed by President Jiang Zemin on 31st August 2001) (Full text of the law: RMRB, 3 Sep 01) This law, which consists of seven chapters with 47 articles, will become effective as of 1st January 2002.
