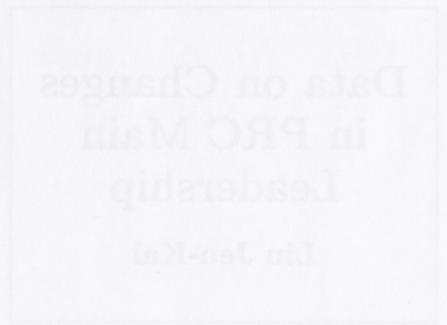

Afterwards, the Agreement on Plants Sanitary Cooperation was signed by Minister for Agriculture and Cooperation Maj-Gen Nyunt Tin and Chinese Agriculture Minister Du Qinglin. Minister for Livestock and Fisheries Brig-Gen Maung Maung Thein and Minister for Agriculture Du Qinglin signed the Agreement on Cooperation in the Animal Health and Quarantine and the Agreement on Fisheries Cooperation. Deputy Minister for Energy U Tin Tun and President of Petroleum Corporation (Ma Hu Chai), chairman of China National Petroleum Corporation International Limited signed the Contract for Improved Petroleum between Myanmar Oil and Gas Enterprise and China National Petroleum Corporation International Limited for oil and gas exploration in Block IOR-4 in Prome oilfield in Shwetaung, Pegu Division. (TV Myanmar, Rangoon, 12 Dec 01, in BBC PF, 14 Dec 01)

### Pakistan (Dec 20)

Seven agreements have been signed in Beijing today which will further promote economic development and science and technology in Pakistan. The first agreement regarding Chinese grant assistance to Pakistan was signed by the minister for finance, Mr Shaukat Aziz, while the minister for foreign [trade] and economic cooperation, Mr Shi Guangsheng, signed from the Chinese side. The second agreement on concessional loan for implementation of Saindak project was signed by Minister for Petroleum and Natural Resources Mr Usman Aminuddin, while the natural resources minister of China, Mr (?Zhou Yongkang) [name as heard], signed on behalf of China. The third agreement regarding joint revolving fund for research and development in the field of science and technology was signed by the Pakistan ambassador in China, Mr Riaz Khokhar, while the Chinese side was led by the chief of China Bank. The other three [as heard] agreements regarding extension of 500-km Muzaffargarh and Ghati transmission line and Jinnah Hydropower Project was signed by the

Pakistan ambassador in China, while the concerned officials of Chinese government signed on behalf of their respective side. (Pakistan TV, Islamabad, 20 Dec 01, in BBC PF, 21 Dec 01)

### Panama (Dec 05)

China, Panama sign economic cooperation pact Panama City, 5 December: Representatives from Panama and China on Wednesday [5 December] signed an economic cooperation-agreement between the two countries to strengthen commercial relations. Ma Yue, an official of the China Council for the Promotion of International Trade, and Ivan Cohen, leader of the Panamanian Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Agriculture, signed the document on the eve of the opening of the 5th Economic and Commercial Expo' of the People's Republic of China, which is to take place late Wednesday. Under the agreement, both countries will boost economic cooperation, and commit to establishing a regular information and viewpoint exchange mechanism on bilateral commercial expansion. The accord is also aimed at promoting the exchange of visits between entrepreneurs and traders from both countries. China's trade with Panama stood at around 1.2bn US dollars in the year 2000 with China's export up 33 per cent from the previous year. (XNA, 7 Dec 01)

After their talks, both Presidents attended a press conference on the launching of the new commission. The two countries also signed a treaty on extradition and notes were exchanged between foreign ministers of the two governments on the modalities of the China-South Africa Bilateral Commission. (XNA, 11 Dec 01)

### Vanuatu (Dec 17)

Vanuatu foreign ministers sign cooperation agreements Beijing, 17 December: The Vanuatu government will adhere to the "one-China" policy and promote cooperation with China in various sectors, the Vanuatu foreign minister, Jean-Alain Mahe, said here Monday [17 December]. Mahe told his Chinese counterpart Tang Jiaxuan at a meeting that Vanuatu attaches importance to bilateral ties with China, and appreciates the Chinese government's long-term economic and tech-

nological assistance. China and Vanuatu have achieved progress in cooperation in political, economic, agricultural and other fields since the two countries established diplomatic ties 19 years ago, Tang said, adding that bilateral relations should be further developed. The two signed documents of economic and technological cooperation after the talks. Mahe is visiting China from 17 to 22 December as Tang's guest. (XNA, 18 Dec 01)

#### **Hong Kong SAR Agreement with Lithuania** (Dec 04)

The government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HK-SAR) signed an agreement on abolition of visa requirements with the Republic of Lithuania in Hong Kong, enabling HKSAR passport holders to enjoy visa-free access to 93 countries and regions. Regina Ip, secretary for security, signed the agreement with Evaldas Ignatavicius, visiting deputy minister of foreign affairs of the Republic of Lithuania. The agreement represents collective efforts of Hong Kong and Lithuania to promote travel convenience in both ways which will further help promote trade, business and tourism ties between the two places. (XNA, 5 Dec 01)

#### **Macau SAR Agreement with Mainland China** (Dec 03)

Secretary for Social Affairs and Culture of Macau SAR, Fernando Chui Sai On, and the Director of China National Tourism Administration, He Guangwei, signed a protocol for cooperation in tourism on behalf of Macau SAR and the Mainland. Meanwhile, the two parties decided to hold working meetings every quarter to evaluate the result of the cooperation and to probe into the feasibility of cooperation in new tourism items. (Macau Government Information Bureau website, www.gcs.gov.mo, 3 Dec 01)

#### **Macau SAR Agreement with Lithuania** (Dec 06)

An agreement between the government of the Macau SAR and the government of the Republic of Lithuania on mutual exemption of visa requirements was signed in Macau by Florinda da Rosa Silva Chan, the Secretary for Administration and Justice, and Evaldas Ignatavicius, the Deputy

Minister of Foreign Affairs. Lithuania is the sixth country granting visa fee access to the Macau SAR passport bay agreement signing. (Macau Government Information Bureau website, www.gcs.gov.mo, 5 Dec 01)

#### **Macau SAR Agreement with Portugal** (Dec 10)

An agreement was signed between China's Macau Special Administrative Region (SAR) and Portugal to strengthen medical cooperation. The two governments were represented by State Secretary for Health of Portugal, Francisco Ventura Ramos, and Secretary for Social Affairs and Culture of Macau SAR, Fernando Chui Sai On. In line with the agreement, the two sides will exchange documents and books on medical science and new technology involved in the public health sector. Macau and Portugal will cooperate more closely in the sectors of community health care, prevention and control of illness, hospital management, medical training and services and academic exchanges. Chief Executive Edmund Ho Hau Wah of the Macau SAR attended the signing ceremony. (Macau Government Information Bureau website, www.gcs.gov.mo, 7 Dec 01; XNA, 11 Dec 01)

#### **Macau SAR Agreement with Cambodia** (Dec 12)

China's Macau Special Administrative Region and the Cambodian government signed an aviation agreement in Phnom Penh. Ao Man Long, secretary for transport and public works of the MSAR government, and Pok Sam-el, Secretary of State for aviation affairs at the Council of Ministers, inked the aviation agreement at the Council of Ministers. Under the framework agreement, the details of opening aviation between Macau and Cambodia will be decided later through discussions and consideration by both sides. (XNA, 13 Dec 01)

**Regulations for closing financial institutions** (Order No. 324 of the State Council). Adopted at the 47th meeting of an executive meeting on 14 Nov and signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 23 Nov 2001. This set of regulations consisting of 24 clauses will become effective on 15 December. (Xinhua, 4 Dec 2001, in BBC PF, 5 Dec 2001; full text: RMRB, 5 Dec 2001)

**Decision of the State Council on the amendment of the Regulations on the control of veterinary medicines** signed by Zhu Rongji on 29 Nov 2001 (Order of the State Council of the People's Republic of China No. 325). Consists of 9 chapters and 51 clauses. (Xinhua, Beijing, in Chinese 7 Dec 2001; full text: RMRB, 8 Dec 2001)

**Regulations regarding administration of pesticides** (Order No. 326 of the State Council, signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 29 Nov 2001). The revised regulations consist of 8 chapters and 49 clauses. They went into effect on 8 Dec 2001. (XNA, 9 Dec 2001; full text: RMRB, 9 Dec 2001)

**Anti-dumping regulations** (Order No. 328). Approved at the 46th executive meeting of the State Council on 31 Oct 2001 and signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 26 Nov 2001. The regulations consisting of 6 chapters and 59 clauses will be effective from 1 Jan 2002. (Xinhua, 10 Dec 2001, in BBC PF, 19 Dec 2001; full text: RMRB, 11 Dec 2001)

**Anti-subsidization regulations on import goods** (Order No. 329 of the State Council, signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 26 Nov 2001). Approved at the 46th executive meeting of the cabinet on 31 Oct 2001). They will come



into force on 1 Jan 2002. The statute is composed of 58 clauses in 6 chapters. (XNA, 12 Dec 2001; full text: RMRB, 12 Dec 2001)

**Statute on measures of protection of the People's Republic of China** (Order No. 330 of the State Council, signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 26 Nov 2001) Statute on limiting negative impact of imports on local industry. Approved by the State Council at its 46th executive meeting on 31 Oct 2001, will go into effect 1 Jan 2002. According to the code, which includes five chapters and 35 clauses, the Ministry of Foreign Trade and Economic Cooperation (MOFTEC) is responsible for handling petitions by local individuals, legal persons and institutions seeking protection. The MOFTEC will work together with the Ministry of Agriculture to deal with petitions involving farm products. Temporary protective measures will be adopted by the customs at the request of the MOFTEC, but the measures will last no more than 200 days, according to the statute. The term of protection will last no longer than four years. (XNA, 13 Dec 2001; full text: RMRB, 13 Dec 2001)

**Regulation on technology import and export administration** (Order No. 331 of the State Council, signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 10 Dec 2001). Approved by the State Council at its 46th executive meeting on 31 Oct 2001. The regulation will come into force on 1 Jan 2002. It has five chapters and 55 articles. (Xinhua, 18 Dec 01, in BBC PF, 21 Dec 2001; full text: RMRB, 20 Dec 2001)

**Regulations on the control of importation and exportation of goods** (Order No. 332 of the State Council signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 10 Dec 2001 and adopted by the State Council at its 46th executive meeting on 31 Oct 2001). The regulations will go into effect on 1 Jan 2002. They consist of 57 articles in 5 chapters. Main contents of the regulations include general principles, control of importation of goods, control of exportation of goods, state-run trade and designated business operation, monitoring importation and exportation of goods and provisional measures, promotion of foreign trade,

legal liability, and supplementary articles. (Xinhua, 19 Dec 01, in BBC PF, 20 Dec 2001; full text: RMRB, 28 Dec 2001)

**Regulation about administration of foreign-funded telecommunication enterprises** (Order No. 333 of the State Council, signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 11 Dec 2001). Adopted by the State Council at its 49th executive meeting on 5 Dec 2001. The regulation consisting of 25 articles will be effective on 1 Jan 2002. (XNA, 21 Dec 2001; full text: RMRB, 21 Dec 2001)

**International marine transport regulation** (Order No. 335 of the State Council, signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 11 Dec 2001). Adopted by the State Council at its 49th executive meeting on 5 Dec 2001. The regulation consisting of 7 chapters and 61 articles is to become effective on 1 Jan 2002. (XNA, 21 Dec 2001; full text: RMRB, 28 Dec 2001)

**Regulations for management of overseas funded insurance companies** (Order No. 336 of the State Council, signed by Chinese Premier Zhu Rongji on 12 Dec 2001). Adopted by the State Council at its 49th executive meeting on 5 Dec 2001. The regulations will come into effect on 1 Feb 2002. According to the regulations, all overseas funded insurance companies should seek the approval of the China Insurance Regulatory Commission before becoming established. The companies will be allowed to deal in property, liability, credit, personal, life, health and accident insurance. The regulations are applicable to overseas funded insurance agencies which are set up in Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan. (XNA, 23 Dec 2001; full text: RMRB, 28 Dec 2001)

**Regulation for putting on record rules and regulations** which are passed by regional legislatures and local governments, and departments of the central government (Order No. 337 of the State Council signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 14 Dec 2001). The regulation consisting of 22 articles is to become effective on 1 Jan 2002. (XNA, 23 Dec 2001; full text: RMRB, 22 Dec 2001)

**Regulation on foreign law firms** (Order No. 338 of the State Council, signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on

22 Dec 2001). Adopted by the State Council at its 51st executive meeting on 19 Dec 2001. The regulation on the opening up of the Chinese legal service market will be effective on 1 Jan 2002. According to the 35-article regulation, foreign law firms must first get approval from the State Council's judicial and administrative departments before they establish representative agencies in China. (XNA, 28 Dec 2001; full text: RMRB, 28 Dec 2001)

**Governing regulations for overseas financial institutions** (Order No. 340 of the State Council, signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 20 Dec 2001). Adopted by the State Council at its 50th executive meeting on 12 Dec 2001. The regulations consist of 7 chapters and 52 articles. They provide systematic explanations and requirements regarding the registration, business scope, supervision, liquidation and liabilities for overseas financial institutions. (XNA, 30 Dec 2001; full text: RMRB, 30 Dec 2001)

**Law on population and family planning** (Order No. 63 of the National People's Congress, signed by State President Jiang Zemin on 29 Dec 2001). China's first legislation on family planning and population was enacted by the 25th session of the Standing Committee of the Ninth National People's Congress. The law, to be enforced from 1 Sept 2002, is to continue the current government policy on birth control and family planning. It consists of 7 chapters and 47 articles. (Xinhua, 29 Dec 2001, in BBC PF, 29 Dec 2001 full text: RMRB, 30 Dec 2001)
