Algeria (Aug 26)

After the talks between visiting Chinese State Council Premier Zhu Rongji and Algerian Prime Minister Ali Benflis, Zhu and Benflis attended a ceremony for signing bilateral cooperation documents; and they are: the "Agreement Between the PRC Government and the Government of the Democratic People's Republic of Algeria on Economic and Technical Cooperation," "Plan for Implementing the Cultural Agreement between the PRC Government and the Government of the Democratic People's Republic of Algeria," "Certificate of Transfer on the Renovation Project of the Guelma Porcelain Plant", and "Protocol between the PRC Government and the Government of the Democratic People's Republic of Algeria on Dispatching Medical Teams to Work in Algeria." (Xinhua, 26 Aug 02, in BBC PF, 27 Aug 02; RMRB, 27 Aug 02)

Algeria and China signed four bilateral cooperation agreements. These are: An economic and technical agreement covering a six-million dollar loan, reimbursed within 25 years; a cultural programme for the period between 2002 and 2004; an agreement

on a new mosaic production unit for Guelma Province, and finally, a protocol for the sending of a Chinese medical team to Algiers. (Algerian TV, 26 Aug 02, in BBC PF, 28 Aug 02)

Cameroon (Aug 30)

Cameroon and China have signed a total of five cooperation conventions which have to do with the commercial activities of both countries; debt rescheduling; the renovation of the Yaounde Conference Centre; and the construction of a modern sports complex in the nation's capital worth 5.4bn CFA francs [8.8m dollars]. The signing of the five conventions was the high of an enlarged working session in Yaounde on 30 August between Cameroonian and Chinese delegations. ... Meanwhile the high point of the enlarged working session was the signing of five cooperation accords between Cameroon and China. The five accords included one for commercial, economic and technical cooperation; another on rescheduling Cameroon's debt to China; the third on a Chinese grant to Cameroon worth 72m CFA francs [107,000 dollars]; the fourth to renovate the Yaounde Conference Centre; and the final accord to construct a modern sports complex in Yaounde to the tune of 5.4bn CFA francs... (CRTV Radio, Yaounde, 30 Aug 02, in BBC PF, 1 Sep 02; XNA, 31 Aug 02)

Morocco (Aug 27)

After the talks between visiting Chinese Premier Zhu Rongji and his Moroccan counterpart, Abderrahmane Youssef, the two sides signed five documents on cooperation in economics, technology and culture. (RMRB, XNA, 29 Aug 02)

Hong Kong SAR Agreement with the Netherlands (Aug 26)

The Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) and the Government of the Netherlands signed an agreement concerning mutual legal assistance in criminal matters. The agreement was signed by the Secretary for Security Regina Ip on behalf of the HKSAR government and the Consul General of the Netherlands J. S. Haakma on behalf of the Netherlands government. According to a Hong Kong government gazette release on 26 August, the agreement was the 13th of its kind that the

HKSAR signed on international cooperation against crime. The Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters Ordinance, which provides the necessary legislative backing for the implementation of the agreement concerned, is already in place. It shall enter into force on the first day of the second month following the date on which both sides have notified each other in writing that their respective legal requirements for the entry into force of the agreement have been complied with. (XNA, 27 Aug 02)

Macau SAR Agreement with Egypt (Aug 14)

Holders of China's Macau Special Administrative Region (SAR) passports have been permitted to enter Egypt for a visa-free stay of up to 90 days, an extension from 30 days previously, the Macau Identification Bureau announced on 15 August. The treatment has been given to those who visit Egypt for tourism, business and border transit purposes, the bureau said. On the basis of reciprocity, holders of Egypt passports will also enjoy visa exemption treatment in the Macau SAR for a stay of up to 90 days. The above-mentioned arrangement will be effective from 14 August 2002. (Macau Government Information Bureau web site, www.gcs.gov.mo, 14 Aug 02; XNA, 16 Aug 02)

Macau SAR Agreement with the Netherlands (Aug 21)

Secretary for Administration and Justice Florinda Chan and the Consul General of Holland in Hong Kong and Macau, Jochum Haakma, signed an agreement designed to encourage investment protection on behalf of the two governments. The agreement, entitled "Agreement for Encouragement and Reciprocal Protection of Investments between the Government of the Netherlands and the Government of the Macau SAR of the PRC", would take effect after the two governments officially passed legislation for the implementation of this agreement. Consul General Haakma reaffirmed that Macau's geographic advantage and experience in the Guangdong and Fujian markets would be helpful to Western countries entering the Chinese market. PRC Laws and Regulations

Water Law of the People's Republic of China, revised and adopted at the 29th meeting of the 9th NPC Standing Committee on 29 August 2002. (Decree No. 74 of the President of the PRC, signed by President Jiang Zemin on 29 August 2002) (Full text: RMRB, 31 Aug 02)

China's newly revised Water Law, which consists of eight chapters with 82 articles, will become effective on 1 October this year. Compared to the original Water Law, which was drawn up and came into force in 1988, the revised version stresses unified management of water resources. It highlights efficient water consumption, steps up macro management and spells out a national strategy on water resources. It stresses the importance of a balance between water resources and the population, economic development and the environment and values environmental protection amid development, plus legal responsibilities in case of violations. Experts believe the revised law is calculated to build a water efficient and pollution-free society, achieve sustainable use of water resources and promote sustainable social and economic development. The new law focuses on improved efficiency in water use. It highlights saving, protection and rational distribution of water resources in an effort to promote a balance between resources and social and economic development and the environment, experts say. (XNA, 7 Sep 02)

China has taken another legal step forward by introducing its newly revised Water Law, to ease water-based problems such as a shortage of resources. Wang Shucheng, minister of water resources, said on 6 September it was vital to focus on tackling the problems of water shortages and water pol-

lution to ensure sustainable economic and social development. China, with a grave shortage of water resources, has a gross volume of 2.8 trillion cubic meters of water, and its per capita share is about 2,200 cubic metres, only one quarter of the world's per-capita availability. Of China's 668 cities, more than 400 suffer water shortages. And about half of the country's rivers, 90 per cent of urban water areas, are polluted to varying extent. Experts say problems such as water shortages, the frequent incidence of natural adversities and the worsening environment have become major factors restricting China's social and economic sustainable development. The revised Water Law, which sums up experiences and lessons learned since the Water Law was first implemented 14 years ago, stipulates the setting up of a pricing system to improve water consumption efficiency. Under the revised law, consumption will be charged according to normal pricing if it falls within a pre-set quota but if the quota is exceeded, high penalty fees will be charged. The practice has been carried out in some North China cities where a lack of water has become critical. The revised law tells local governments to work tirelessly to promote the use of water efficient technologies in both agriculture and industry. Tremendous efforts should be made to promote efficient water equipment for urbanites and recycling water should also be encouraged. As compared with 14 years ago when the Water Law was first put into practice, China's use of recycled water for industrial purpose has improved from 25 per cent to 50 per cent, and the rate for agricultural use has also been up between 30 per cent and 40 per cent. But the country's average annual water consumption has been increasing at a rate of 1.4 per cent. However, much should still be done to improve the utilization rate of water, experts say. Water pollution has aggravated China's shortage situation. The revised law stipulates that a system has to be set up to protect drinking water sources. To cope with the situation, governments at the provincial, autonomous regional and municipal levels should strive to protect designated sources of drinking water. The law says they should take effective steps to prevent both water resources drying up and water pollution in order

to protect the safety of drinking water for rural and urban residents. (XNA, 30 Aug, 7 Sep 02)

Law of the People's Republic of China on Surveying and Mapping, revised and adopted at the 29th meeting of the 9th NPC Standing Committee on 29 August 2002. (Decree No. 75 of the President of the PRC, signed by President Jiang Zemin on 29 August 2002) (Full text: RMRB, 1 Sep 02)

The newly-adopted revised law on surveying and mapping, to take effect on 1 December, will further regulate the government administrative behavior in surveying and mapping practices. (XNA, 30 Aug 02) The law consists of nine chapters with 55 articles.

Method for the Collection and Management of Social Support Payment. The method will come into effect on 1 September, 2002. (Order No. 357 of the State Council, signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 2 August 2002) (Full text: RMRB, 13 Aug 02)

The "Method for the Collection and Management of Social Support Payment" is a supplementary regulation of the "Law of the People's Republic of China Governing Population and Family Planning". Both the law and the method will be carried out beginning 1 September this year. The method includes 15 articles. The method is enacted to standardize the collection and management of social support payment, to safeguard the national policy of family planning, to protect the legal rights and benefits of citizens, and to realize a coordinated development of population, economy, society, resources, and environment. The method stipulates that the standard for the collection of social support payment is set on the basis of the per capita disposable income for urban residents or the per capita net income for rural residents. The amount of social support payment is also determined on the basis of the actual income of the party concerned as well as whether or not he has raised children in accordance with the laws and regulations. All provinces, autonomous regions, and municipalities shall stipulate, in accordance with their local conditions, the specific collection standard and method of payment. The method stipulates that when collecting social support payment, the de-

partment of the people's government in charge of family planning at the county level should make a collection decision in written form. It can also entrust the people's government at the township level or sub-district office to make a collection decision in written form. The party concerned should pay social support payment in full within 30 days after he receives the payment notice. If he has real problems, he can apply in written form with relevant departments for payment by instalments. The method also particularly emphasizes that no unit or individual is allowed to add, without authorization, payment items that are related to family planning or raise the standard for the collection of social support payment. The method stipulates that social support payment and fines for delaying payment should be turned over in full to the state treasury. Such payment and fines shall be managed in accordance with the regulations governing the management of local financial budget, which are stipulated by the Ministry of Finance of the State Council. Anyone who retains, misappropriates, embezzles, or keeps for personal use social support payment shall be duly punished. The method also stipulates in detail how migrant workers, who have more children than legally allowed, should pay the social support payment. (Xinhua, 10 Aug 02, in BBC PF, 11 Aug 02)

Regulations on the Implementation of the Trademark Law of the People's Republic of China. The regulations will come into effect on 15 September, 2002. (Order No. 358 of the State Council, signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 3 August 2002) (Full text: RMRB, 12 Aug 02)

The new regulations, which consist of 59 articles in eight chapters, are replacing the existing "Detailed Rules on the Implementation of the Trademark Law". The regulations cover the application process of trademark registration, examination of such applications, transfer and inheritance of registered trademarks, management of trademark usage, protection of registered trademarks and other areas. China's Trademark Law took effect in 1983 and was revised in 1993 to be more compatible with the World Trade Organization. (XNA, 12 Aug 02)

Regulations on the Implementation of the Copyright Law of the People's Republic of China. The regulation will come into effect on 15 September, 2002. (Order No. 359 of the State Council, signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 2 August 2002) (Full text: RMRB, 15 Aug 02)

The regulation was made on the basis of the Copyright Law passed at the 24th meeting of the 9th NPC Standing Committee on 27 October, 2001. The regulation, comprising 38 articles, will make it easier to enforce the law and keep the commitments made by the Chinese government to update the Copyright Law after the country's entry into the World Trade Organization. The regulation deals with the punishments for copyright infringement and clear explanations of the terms set out in the Copyright Law. (XNA, 15 Aug 02)

Regulations on the Implementation of the Pharmaceutical Administration Law of the People's Republic of China. The regulations will go into effect on 15 September, 2002. (Order No. 360 of the State Council, signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 4 August 2002) (Full text: RMRB, 17 Aug 02)

The regulations include 86 articles in 10 chapters, dealing with general provisions, pharmacy administration, medicine price and advertising management, and medicine supervision. (XNA, 15 Aug 02)

Regulations of the People's Republic of China on Export Control of Missiles and Missile-related Items and Technologies. These regulations will go into effect on the day of promulgation. (Order No. 361 of the State Council, signed by Premier Zhu Rongji on 22 August 2002) (Full text: RMRB, 26 Aug 02; full English translation: XNA, 26 Aug 02)

China will tighten control over the export of missiles and missile-related items and technologies to prevent the proliferation of missiles and other delivering systems. The 24-article regulations set clear provisions on the export control of missiles and missile-related items and technologies. China will practice a licensing system for the export of missiles and missile-related items and technologies. Without being licensed, no unit or individual shall ex-

port missiles and missile-related items and technologies, according to the regulations.

Gao Yan, spokeswoman of the Ministry of Foreign Trade and Economic Cooperation [MOFTEC], on 25 August made a statement on the promulgation of the regulations and the attached "Control List" by the Chinese government. The full text of the statement is as follows: A few days ago, the Chinese government promulgated the "Regulations on Export Control of Missiles and Missile-related Items and Technologies" and the attached "Control List". This is another important move taken by the Chinese government to strengthen control over exports and perfect the export control system. Over the past years, China has constantly strengthened its relevant export control mechanisms and its legislative work on export control in accordance with its non-proliferation policy and export control practice and by taking the practices of other countries as a reference. The "Law of the PRC on Foreign Trade," which was promulgated in 1994, clearly stipulates that China prohibits or restricts the export of goods and technologies harmful to national security or public common interests. The state subsequently promulgated a number of regulations on the control over the export of sensitive items including the "Regulations of the PRC on Supervision and Control of Chemicals," "Regulations of the PRC on Nuclear Export Control," "Regulations of the PRC on Export Control of Nuclear Items for Dual Use and Related Technologies," and "Regulations of the PRC on Export Control of Military Products." The promulgation and implementation of these regulations have played a positive role in standardizing China's export management, implementing its non-proliferation policy, safeguarding national security and public interests and fulfilling China's commitments to international obligations. The recent promulgation of the regulations on the export control of missiles and missile-related items and technologies and the attached control list marks a further improvement in China's export management system. In the future we will continue to push forward the process of institutionalization in the spirit of governing the country according to the
