CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Cameroon

Under a draft contract of Jan 21, 1989, China agrees to construct an agricultural project in northern Cameroon. The three-year project will cover 800 hectares, and is the fifth cooperative venture between the two countries. The 4-billion-cfa-franc (more than 133 million U.S. dollars) project will enable this region to greatly increase cereal production.
