Agreement on goods exchange for 1989.

Philippines (Feb 20)
Protocol on the importation and exportation of commodities for 1989. Under it, China will import from the Philippines fertilizers, coconut oil, bananas, copper concentrates and copper cathodes, while the Philippines will import crude oil, machinery, electrical products, coal, textiles, foodstuffs and other products from China. The two countries agreed to set a bilateral trade target of 400 Mio. to 450 Mio.US\$ for the year 1989.
