## AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

### Japan (Mar 03)

Loan agreement between the Export-Import Bank of Japan and the Bank of China. Under it, the Export-Import Bank of Japan will provide a total loan of 72.598 billion Yen (abt. 580 million US\$) to the Bank of China for the development of northeast China's Liaohai oil field and other inland oil fields. (XNA, Mar 3, 1989)

### Soviet Union (Mar 03)

Protocol on commodity exchange and payment for 1989. Under the trade protocol, totalling 4.8 billion Swiss Francs (abt. 3.1 billion dollars), China will sell to the Soviet Union tungsten ore, soybeans, corn, meat, meat by-products, fruit, knitwear, thermos flasks, handicrafts and machinery. The Soviet side will provide China with steel products, non-ferrous metal, wood, fertilizer, generators, electric locomotives, cars, airplanes and refrigerators. (XNA, Mar 3, 1989)
