AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Botswana (Apr 06)

Protocol on China to send the 5th medical team consisting of 13 doctors who will work in the Princess Marina Hospital in the capital and the new Francistown Hospital.

Agreement on cooperation in urban development, house building and personnel training.

Hungary (Apr 26)

Summary of talks on the 4th Meeting of the Sino-Hungarian Committee for Economic, Trade and Scientific and Technological Cooperation. The two sides signed agreements on three co-operation projects of machinery and discussed possibilities of agricultural cooperation, according to the summary.

Agreement on civil air transportation. China and Mongolia suspended air flights in 1967. Irregular flights between the two countries have been restored since 1986. To meet the development of bilateral relations in recent year, the two countries agreed to sign a civil air transportation agreement, which plans to start regular flights this May.

Agreement on setting up a cooperation committee to promote economic, trade, scientific and technological development.

Pakistan (Apr 20)

9th protocol of science and technology cooperation for 1989-90. Under the protocol, both sides have agreed to conduct 24 items' cooperation in the areas of agriculture, energy, health and micro-electron. So far 180 items of science and technology cooperation in the areas of electronics, marine science, industrial development, renewable energy, food and agriculture, minerals and other sciences have been implemented since the first protocol of science and technology cooperation signed between China and Pakistan in 1976.

Memorandum on cooperation in tourism. CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Botswana

Under a protocol of Apr 6, China will send the 5th medical team to Botswana consisting of 13 doctors. They will work in the Princess Marina Hospital in the capital and the new Francistown Hospital.

Ethiopia

Under an agreement of Apr 25, China will help Ethiopia build a sewing thread-factory in Addis Ababa. China will complete the construction of the factory in 16 months and then train Ethiopian workers for the factory. China will provide a loan of 46 million Renminbi Yuan (12.4 million U.S. dollars) for the project. Once completed, the factory will produce 360 tons of thread every year and provide the country with 400 job opportunities.

Ghana

The China State Construction Engineering Corporation and the Ghanaian government signed two construction contracts. The two projects are building of the Kwame Nkrumah Memorial Park and the construction of public stands on the Independence Square. The two projects, both in Accra, are estimated to cost 876 million cedis (about 3 million U.S. dollars). The China State Construction Engineering Corporation has already completed two projects since its establishment in Ghana in September, 1987. They were the expansion of the dyeing and printing workshop of the Ghana Textiles Manufacturing Company and the renovation of the head office of the 31st December Women's Movement.

Iraq

The Hindiya barrage, 80 km south of Baghdad, was inaugurated at the end of April 1989. The 240-million-U.S.dollar project, one of the largest projects China has ever built in foreign countries, started in October, 1984. The China State Construction Engineering Corporation (CSCEC), the main contractor of the barrage project

on the Euphrates, is responsible for the whole project, ranging from exploration, designing, construction, equipment supply and installation. Some foreign companies including those from France, Federal Germany, Switzerland and Japan joined the project as sub-contractors. The large-scale engineering complex includes the barrage, a navigation lock, a fish passage, six bridges, a 60-megawatt power station and housing. The CSCEC will continue a one-year work of maintenance and training after its completion.
