AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Austria (May 13)

Health agreement. The cooperation program includes organisation of the health sector, instructing and advanced training for doctors and medical employees, fighting infectious diseases, and implementing research projects. (Vienna Radio, May 13, 1989; cit. SWB, May 23, 1989)

Finland (May 18)

Seven agreements between the State Science and Technology Commission and Finland. They cover such projects as training of scientific and technological personnel, loans and water conservancy. (XNA, May 18, 1989)

France (May 03)

Agreement between the Bank of Communications and Credit Lyonnais S.A. for export credits totalling 200 million French francs. Under the general agreement, branch offices of the Bank of Communications can sign other export credit agreements drawing on this amount, and export-oriented businesses can apply for the loans when importing equipment or labor from France. Borrowers will enjoy an interest rate lower than that on the international market. (XNA, May 3, 1989)

Greece (May 11)

Agreement of the 2nd Session of the Joint Chinese-Greek Economic Committee. Under it, China and Greece have agreed to increase their bilateral trade in a more harmonious way and develop "dynamically" their economic cooperation in industry, agriculture, ship-repairs, ship-building and tourism on the basis of mutual benefit. (XNA, May 12, 1989)
