Agreement between the Bank of Communications and Credit Lyonnais S.A. for export credits totalling 200 million French francs. Under the general agreement, branch offices of the Bank of Communications can sign other export credit agreements drawing on this amount, and exportoriented businesses can apply for the loans when importing equipment or labor from France. Borrowers will enjoy an interest rate lower than that on the international market. (XNA, May 3, 1989)

Greece (May 11)

Agreement of the 2nd Session of the Joint Chinese-Greek Economic Committee. Under it, China and Greece have agreed to increase their bilateral trade in a more harmonious way and develop "dynamically" their economic cooperation in industry, agriculture, ship-repairs, ship-building and tourism on the basis of mutual benefit. 
