Covering the fields of culture, art, sports, education and information, the program provides that the two sides will exchange visits by artists, educationists and journalists. They will exchange scholarships, educational publications, films and radio and television programs. They will also encourage the exchange of information and news between their news agencies.

Kuwait (Sep 21)

Loan agreement between China and the Kuwait Fund for Arab Economic Development for 6 million Kuwait dinars (about 21 million U.S.\$) to help finance a ductile cast iron pipe project in Liaoning Province. This is part of the fourth installment of loans from Kuwait to China. Since 1982, the middle eastern country has loaned China about 300 million U.S.\$ in three installments which have been used to help construct such major infrastructure projects as airports, harbors and electric power stations. The total cost of the pipe project is estimated at about 62.27 million U.S.\$, 33.7 percent

of which is loaned by Kuwait with an interest rate of five percent a year, in addition to 0.5 percent a year to cover administrative and other expenses incurred in the implementation of the loan agreement. The loan, which will be for a period of 18 years including a four-year grace period, is provided by the official Kuwait Fund for Arab Economic Development, whose director-general, Bader Mishari Alhumaidhi, is heading a three-member delegation to the sixth annual Sino-Kuwait loan meeting.

Bangladesh

China agreed to help construct a medium-sized bridge in northern Bangladesh. Under a contract relating to this project China will provide a soft loan of about 12.5 million U.S.\$ for the construction of the bridge in Bangladesh's northern district Mymensingh. The 464-meter-long Shambhugonj bridge over the river Old Brahmanputra will connect several northern districts with the capital of Dhaka.

Somalia

China handed over a mobile radio station. The radio station, valued at 1.5 million Chinese yuan (about 405,00 U.S.\$), was provided at the request of Somali president Mohamed Siad Barre. It will be stationed in Hargeisa, Somalia's second largest city. The radio station in Hargeisa was damaged last year during the fighting between government troops and anti-government rebels. The radio station, fit in three trucks, is made of a transmitter, a broadcasting section, a generator and other equipment.

Chen Boda 陈伯达

Deceased Sep 20, 1989 (TKP, Sep 29, 1989; cit. SWB, Sep 2, 1989).

The former secretary of Mao Zedong was sentenced to 18 years in prison because of his part in the activities of the Lin Biao affair in 1970. He was only released in October 1988.

Gu Yongjiang

Identified as assistant minister of foreign economic relations and trade (XNA, Sep 25, 1989).
Gu is a newcomer.

He Jingzhi 贺敬之

Appointed minister of culture (XNA, Sep 4, 1989).

He, a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, has been a member of the 7th NPC's Standing Committee before. He had been deputy director of the Propaganda Department under the CCP Central Committee from 1980 until 1987 and vice-minister of culture from 1987 until April 1988.

Huang Yu 黄 又

Deceased Aug 1, 1989 (Hefei Radio, Aug 6, 1989; cit. SWB, Sep 21, 1989).

Huang has been vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Anhui Province.

Li Mingzu

Identified as deputy secretary of Guangxi Autonomous Region CP (Nanning Radio, Sep 17, 1989; cit. SWB, Sep 22, 1989).

Li is a newcomer.

Liang Xiang 梁 湘

Dismissed from his positions as governor of Hainan Province and deputy secretary of Hainan Province CP (XNA, Sep 6, 1989).

Liang lost his positions due to his close connections to Zhao Ziyang.

Liu Hongru 刘 洪 儒

Recalled from his position as vice-president of the People's Bank (XNA, Sep 4, 1989).

Liu, an alternate member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, held this position since May 1982. He remains vice-minister of the State Commission for Restructuring Economy.

Liu Jianfeng 刘 剑 锋

Elected governor of Hainan Province (Zhongguo Xinwen She, Sep 14, 1989; cit. SWB, Sep 16, 1989).

A vice-minister of electronics industry from 1984 until 1984(?), Liu became a deputy secretary of Hainan Province CP in Sep 1988. He was born in 1936 in Tianjin.

Su Xing 苏 星

Identified as editor-in-chief of *Qiushi* the new leading Party theoretical journal (Lanzhou Radio, Sep 5, 1989; cit. SWB, Sep 8, 1989).

Su had been acting editor-in-chief of *HQ* until it ceased publication in July 1988. At about the same time he became a vice-president of the Central Party School.

Wang Shouqiang 王守强

Appointed vice-minister of water resources (XNA, Sep 4, 1989).

Wang is a newcomer.

Xu Xin 徐 信

Identified as director of the Beijing Institute for International Studies (XNA, Sep 14, 1989).

Xu has been the institute's deputy director since 1982. It is not yet clear whether he remains deputy chief of the PLA General Staff, a position he holds since 1982.
