Under it, the two countries will exchange information and documents on sanitation and epidemic prevention, maternal and child health, and medicine. Elected vice-governor of Hunan Province (Changsha Radio, Jul 7, 1989; cit. SWB, Jul 13, 1989). Dong is a newcomer.

Gu Xiulian (f) 顾秀莲
Appointed minister of chemical industry (XNA, Jul 6, 1989).

Gu, a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, had been governor of Jiangsu Province before (1983/04-1989/04).

Li Shuji 李树基
Appointed vice-governor of Yunnan Province (Kunming Radio, Jul 16, 1989; cit. SWB, Jul 20, 1989).

Li was a newcomer when elected deputy secretary of Yunnan CP in July 1985.

Ruan Chongwu 阮崇武
Appointed minister of labor (XNA, Jul 6, 1989).

Ruan, a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, has been vice-minister of the State Science and Technology Commission since July 1987.

Su Shaozhi 苏绍智
Dismissed from his position as president of the Society for the Study of the Theory and Practice of Mao Zedong Thought (XNA, Jul 30, 1989).

The well-known Su is among the first victims of the new political course after the smashing of the students' unrest.

Yan Jiaqi 严家其
Dismissed from his post as member of the Standing Committee of the Youth Federation (XNA, Jul 28, 1989).

Yan is the most prominent of the younger generation of China's political scientists. He became director of the Institute of Political Sciences under the Academy of Social Sciences in 1985 at the age of 43. In this position he was among the first to advocate the abolition of lifelong tenure for Party and State leaders. After what is called "The Beijing turmoil" by the official Chinese press he fled China together with his wife. In mid-July he became one of the co-founders of the "Chinese Democratic Front", founded by several dissidents in Paris. Only one week later, the State Press and Publications Administration put his publications on a black list.
