Trade protocol for the 1990 fiscal year.

Protocol of the 29th Session of the Joint Commission for Scientific and Technological Cooperation. The document specified 58 projects of cooperation involving energy resources, light industry, machine-building and electronics industry, and agriculture.

Agreement on mutual exemption of visas. Under it, Chinese citizens holding valid diplomatic, service or ordinary (for public affairs) passports of China and the Turkish citizens holding valid diplomatic, service or special passports of Turkey will be exempted from visa requirements for entry into, exit from or transit through the ports of the two countries open to international tourists. Yemen Socialist Republic (Nov 01)

Protocol on cultural cooperation for 1989-91.
 (Aden Radio, Nov 1, 1989; cit. SWB, Nov 7, 1989)

Zaire (Nov 27)

Cooperative agreement to increase higher learning and develop scientific research. Under it, China will offer one million yuan (over 266,000 US\$) by supplying equipment, sending professors and increasing scholarships for Zaireans. The agreement states that each party will designate a higher learning school in their country to renew and develop the inter-university cooperation through exchanges of conference members, teachers, advocates, researchers, as well as scientific informations and documents.

UNIDO (Nov 21)

Agreement on the establishment of the UNIDO-Beijing Center for International Industrial Cooperation. The center is the representation of UNIDO in the field. Its main task is: to exchange information on international cooperation and investment, to extend opportunities for foreign investment in China, and to strengthen cooperation with enterprises worldwide, especially small and medium-sized ones. China and UNIDO have enjoyed good cooperation for many years. The organization now has in China more than 50 investment projects worth 39 million US\$. (XNA, Nov 21, 1989)

Bangladesh

Under a memorandum, China agreed to construct a 210,000 kW thermal power plant at Raozan, Parthali in Chittagong. (XNA, Nov 17, 1989)

Cameroon

Under a protocol, China is to send its 57th medical team to replace its predecessors. (XNA, Nov 29, 1989)

Nepal

China will offer a grant-assistance to Nepal to build complete-set projects and consolidate existing ones. The new projects will be decided later on through mutual consultations. In the past decades, China and Nepal have cooperated in fields including textile, sugar, brick making and road construction. According to Nepalese statistics, a total of 42 Chinese-aided programs have been undertaken in Nepal with 36 already completed, three under construction and three to be launched soon. (XNA, Nov 20, 1989)

Niger

China agreed to grant 937,000 US\$ to finance the air conditioning of the gymnasium in Niamey. The omnisports complex built through the cooperative efforts of China and Niger comprises a 30,000 seats stadium and a 3,000 seats gymnasium. (XNA, Nov 8, 1989)

Appointed member of the Military Commission under the CCP Central Committee. (XNA, Nov 10, 1989)
Chi, a member of the CCP Central Committee, has been chief of the PLA General Staff since Nov 1987. He is a son-in-law of Yang Shangkun.

Ding Xiaonong 丁孝浓

Deceased Nov 11, 1989. (XNA, Nov 25, 1989)

Ding's last position: vice-minister of materials.

He Shangchun 何尚存

Identified as commander of Beijing Garrison. (XNA, Nov 2, 1989)
He has been the Garrison's deputy commander before.

Hong Xueshi 洪学智

Appointed member of the Military Commission under the CCP Central Committee. (XNA, Nov 10, 1989)

Hong has been the commission's deputy secretary-general before.

Jia Zhijie 贾志杰

By-elected member of the CCP 13th Central Committee by its 5th Plenum. (Beijing TV, Nov 9, 1989; cit. SWB, Nov 14, 1989)

Jia has been alternate member before. Since May 1986 he also has been governor of Gansu.

Jiang Zemin 江泽民

Appointed chairman of the Military Commission under the CCP Central Committee. (XNA, Nov 10, 1989)

Jiang's other positions: Member of the CCP Politburo (since Nov 1987), of its Standing Committee (Jun 1969) and general secretary of the Secretariat.

Li Guangsheng 李广生

Identified as commander of Henan Military District. (XNA, Nov 19, 1989)

Li is a newcomer.

Li Ping 李萍

Appointed vice-governor of Gansu Province. (XNA, Nov 29, 1989)

Li, born in 1932, has been director of the Gansu Planning Commission before.

Liu Huaqing 刘华清

Appointed vice-chairman of the Military Commission under the CCP Central Committee. (XNA, Nov 10, 1989)

Liu, former commander of the PLA Navy (1982-88), has been deputy secretary-general of the commission before.

Liu Shuqing 刘述卿

Recalled from his position as vice-minister of foreign affairs. (XNA, Nov 17, 1989)

Ni Hongfu 倪鸿福

Elected deputy secretary of Shanghai CP. (XNA, Nov 4, 1989)

Li, born 1934, has also been vice-mayor of Shanghai (since Apr 1988).

Qin Jiwei 秦基伟

Appointed member of the Military Commission under the CCP Central Committee. (XNA, Nov 10, 1989)

Qin's other positions: Member of the CCP Politburo (since Nov 1987), state councillor (Apr 1988) and minister of national defense (Apr 1988).

Xiao Xuchu 肖旭初

Identified as commander of Guangxi Military District. (XNA, Nov 13, 1989)

Xiao has been political commissar of the district before.

Yang Baibing 杨白冰

Appointed secretary-general of the Military Commission under the CCP Central Committee and member of the Secretariat of the CCP Central Committee. (XNA, Nov 9, 1989)

Yang, a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, has been director of the PLA General Political Department since Nov 1987. He is a younger brother of Yang Shangkun.

Yang Shangkun 杨尚昆

Appointed 1st vice-chairman of the Military Commission under the CCP Central Committee. (XNA, Nov 9, 1989)

Yang has been the commission's secretary-general before. His other positions: Member of the CCP Politburo (since Sep 1982) and president of the PR China.

Zhao Nanqi 赵南起

Appointed member of the Military Commission under the CCP Central Committee. (XNA, Nov 12, 1989)

Zhao, a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, has been director of the PLA General Logistics Department since Nov 1987.
