Angola (Dec 22)

Bulgaria (Dec 08)

Agreement on barter trade and payment for 1990. According to the agreement, China will export farm produce, light industrial products, chemical industry materials and electric domestic appliances. In return, Bulgaria will provide China with machinery and industrial raw materials.

Burma (Dec 26)

Agreement on economic and technological cooperation. Under it, China is to provide the Burmese government with an interest-free loan over a period of five years from January first of 1990 to December 31 of 1994. The loan shall be used to cover the deficiency in the expenses of Yangon-Thanyin railcum-road bridge under the two loans stipulated in the agreements on economic and technical cooperation between China and Burma in 1979 and 1987.

Congo (Dec 22)

Protocol on China to continue sending medics and paramedics to Congo.

Cuba (Dec 14)

Protocol on economic cooperation. It covers cooperation in agriculture, fishing, and sugar refining, as well as in the light, food, textile, electronics and machine-building industries.

Egypt (Dec 20)

Executive program 1990-92 of cultural cooperation. It covers education, health, culture and arts, broadcasting and television, journalism, youth and sports.

Iran (Nov 28)

Minutes on cooperation in economy, trade, science and technology. According to them, as of January 1, 1990, all payments between the two countries will be effected by convertible currencies. The minutes encourage organizations and firms of the two countries to increase the volume of bilateral trade to 600 million dollars. The volume of trade between the two countries reached 164 million dollars in 1988, up 150 percent over 1979. Contracts on 19 industrial projects have been signed between the two countries since 1984, involving 66.74 million dollars in total.

Protocol on radio and television cooperation. It calls for regular exchanges of radio and television programs, particularly those of interest to children, as well as those related to culture, sports, arts and national events.

Under an agreement China will continue sending medics and paramedics to Congo. It agreed to send 31 doctors and sanitary workers to hospitals for two year assignments. Since 1967 400 doctors and sanitary workers served in Congo.

An international conference center was opened at Madinet Nasr in Cairo. It was built with Chinese aid in three and a half years. The center which, occupying 25.4 hectares, consists of an auditorium with 2,500 seats, two smaller halls, a banquet hall, an exhibition hall, a presidential suite and a new center with up-to-date communication equipments.

Madagascar

China presented 12.9 tons of medicines and medical equipment. The medicine and materials, part of an overall 47,000-U.S.-dollar aid package, are intended to improve medical conditions in Mahitsy, Vatomandry and Ambovombe where a Chinese medical mission has been working since 1975.

Appointed minister of machine building and electronics industry. (XNA, Dec 26, 1989)

He has been the ministry's vice-minister before.

Liu Shuqing 刘 述 卿
Appointed director of the Foreign Affairs Office under the State Council. (XNA, Dec 28, 1989)

Liu had been ambassador to Poland (1972-77), Norway (1977-80), Bangladesh (1980-82), director of the Asia Department under the Foreign Ministry (1982-83), assistant minister of foreign affairs (1983-84), and vice-minister of foreign affairs (1984-89).

Shen Daren 沈 达人
Elected secretary of Jiangsu Province CP. (XNA, Dec 26, 1989)

Shen was born in 1928 in Jiangsu. He is a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee. His last position: deputy secretary of Jiangsu CP.

Shi Xiyu 石 希 玉
Appointed vice-minister of railways (XNA, Dec 28, 1989)

Shi had been in the position from 1985 until 1986.

Xu Dunxin 徐 敦 信
Identified as assistant minister of foreign affairs. (XNA, Dec 5, 1989)
Xu has been director of the Asia Department in the Foreign Ministry before.

Yu Hongen 于 洪 恩
Elected vice-president and 1st secretary of the Federation of Trade Unions. (XNA, Dec 25, 1989)

Yu, a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, had been minister of coal industry from 1985 until 1988. From then he has been chairman of the National Corporation for Coal Mines.

Yu Yongbo 于 永 波
Identified as deputy director of the General Political Department under the PLA General Staff. (XNA, Dec 8, 1989)

Yu, a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee and since Sep 1988 PLA lieutenant-general, has been director of the Political Department of Nanjing Military Region before.

Zhang Youcai 张 佑 才
Appointed vice-minister of finance. (XNA, Dec 28, 1989)

Zhang has been mayor of Nantong City before.

Zhao Zongnai 赵 宗 霁
Appointed vice-minister of personnel. (XNA, Dec 28, 1989)

Zhao, born 1929 and member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, has been deputy director of the Organization Department under the CCP Central Committee.

Zou Jiahua 邹 家 华
Appointed minister of the State Planning Commission. (XNA, Dec 26, 1989)

Zou, a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee and son-in-law of the late marshal and Politburo member Ye Jianying, has been minister of machine building and electronics industry before. It is not yet clear whether he remains in his position as state councillor.
