Appointed director of the newly established Center of the Party Reform of the Political Structure (XNA, Feb 27, 1988). Bao, a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, has been vice-minister of the State Commission for Restructuring the Economic System since Feb 1984.

Chai Songyue 柴松岳
Elected vice-governor of Zhejiang Province (XNA, Feb 4, 1988).

Chen Junsheng 陈俊生
Appointed chairman of the Work Commission of Central Government Departments (XNA, Feb 28, 1988). Chen, a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, has been secretary-general of the State Council since Nov 1985.

Chen Tianren 陈天任
Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Anhui Province (XNA, Feb 3, 1988). Chen was a newcomer when elected deputy for Anhui to the 6th NPC in May 1983.

Chen Xifu 陈西夫
Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Xinjiang Autonomous Region (XNA, Jan 28, 1988). Chen is a newcomer.

Du Yijin 杜宜瑾
Elected vice-governor of Anhui Province (XNA, Feb 3, 1988). Du is a newcomer.

Gabulong 尔布龙
Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Qinghai Province (XNA, Feb 1, 1988). Gabulong has been vice-governor of Qinghai before.

Gu Chaozhao 谷超豪
Appointed president of the University of Science and Technology in Hefei (Hongkong Zhongguo Xinwen She, Feb 18, 1988; cit. SWB, Feb 27, 1988).

Gu is a professor of differential geometry. He remains in his position as director of the Mathematical Research Center under the Shanghai Communications University.

Han Fucai 韩福才
Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Qinghai Province (XNA, Feb 1, 1988). Han has been Qinghai's vice-governor since Nov 1981.

Huanjue Cailang 宦爵才郎
Elected chairman of the People's Congress of Qinghai Province (XNA, Feb 1, 1988). Huanjue belongs to the Tibetan minority. He has been deputy secretary of Qinghai CP since Apr 1983.

Huang Yu 黄驭
Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Anhui Province (XNA, Feb 3, 1988). Huang has been Anhui's vice-governor since Jan 1980.

Jiang Chunyun 姜春云
Elected governor of Shandong Province (XNA, Feb 6, 1988). Jiang was born in 1930. The 13th Party Congress elected him member of its Central Committee. Since Jul 1987 he has been Shandong's acting governor.

Jiang Minkuan 蒋民宽
Appointed vice-minister of the State Scientific and Technological Commission (XNA, Feb 15, 1988). Jiang, a member of the CCP Central Committee since Sep 1985, had been governor of Sichuan Province from May 1985 until Jan 1988.

Kuerban Ali 库尔班阿里
Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Xinjiang Autonomous Region (XNA, Jan 28, 1988).

Kuerban belongs to the Khazak minority. He is a newcomer.

Li Wenhui
Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Gansu Province (Lanzhou Radio, Feb 2, 1988; cit. SWB, Feb 16, 1988). Li is a newcomer.

Li Ye 李晔
Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Shandong Province (Jinan Radio, Feb 2, 1988; cit. SWB, Feb 16, 1988). Li has been Shandong's vice-governor before.

Liu Zhenhua 刘振华
Identified as political commissar of Beijing Military Region (Issues and Studies 1988/1). Liu, a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, has been in the same position of Shenyang Mil. Reg.

Lu Hong 卢洪
Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Shandong Province (Jinan Radio, Feb 2, 1988; cit. SWB, Feb 16, 1988). Lu has been Shandong's vice-governor before.

Lu Rongjing 卢荣景
Elected governor of Anhui Province (XNA, Feb 3, 1988). Lu was born in 1934. The 13th Party Congress elected him member of its Central Committee in Nov 1987. He has been Anhui's acting governor since Jun 1987.

Lu Shengdao
Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Qinghai Province (XNA, Feb 1, 1988). Lu is a newcomer.

Ma Mingliang 马明亮

Appointed chairman of the Work Committee of Departments under the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Feb 28, 1988).
Wen, a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee and alternate member of its Secretariat, has been director of the CC's General Office since Jun 1986.

Elected vice-governor of Anhui Province (XNA, Feb 3, 1988).
Wu has been vice-chairman of the People's Government of Tibet Autonomous Region before (since Jan 1984).

Wu Junzhou

Elected vice-governor of Shanxi Province (XNA, Jan 28, 1988).
Wu is a newcomer.

Wu Minda 吴敏达

Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Zhejiang Province (XNA, Feb 4, 1988).
Wu has been Zhejiang's vice-governor before.

Xiaerxibieke Sitike 夏尔西别克 司的克

Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Xinjiang Autonomous Region (Ürümqi Radio, Jan 28, 1988; cit. SWB, Feb 2, 1988).
Xiaerxibieke belongs to the Kirgiz minority. He is a newcomer.

Xu Feiqing 许飞青

Elected chairman of the People's Congress of Gansu Province (Lanzhou Radio, Feb 1, 1988; cit. SWB, Feb 16, 1988).
Xu has been vice-chairman of the Congress since May 1985.

Identified as commander of the PLA Navy (XNA, Feb 16, 1988).
Zhang, born in 1930 and an alternate member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, has been the navy's deputy commander since Jul 1985.

Zhang Renxia 张润霞

Elected vice-governor of Anhui Province (XNA, Feb 3, 1988).
Zhang is a newcomer.

Zhou Yibing 周衣冰

Identified as commander of Beijing Military Region (Beijing TV, Dec 13, 1987; cit. SWB, Dec 14, 1987).
Zhou derives from the 4th New Army. In 1981 he was identified as chief of staff of Beijing Mil. Reg. In May 1983 he was identified as deputy political commissar of the Commission of Science, Technology and Industry for National Defense and in May 1987 as deputy commander of Beijing Mil. Reg. In Nov 1987 he was elected member of the CCP 13th Central Committee.
