AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Arab Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Agriculture (Apr 10)
Agreement for the establishment of a Sino-Arab Joint Chamber of Commerce. It is aimed at developing mutual understanding and friendship between the Arab countries and the People's Republic of China, and promoting economic cooperation between them. This is the first joint chamber of commerce to be established between China and other countries. (XNA, Apr 10, 1988)

Austria (Apr 13)
Memorandum of understanding to promote scientific cooperation. (XNA, Apr 13, 1988)

Ethiopia (Apr 12)
Agreement on the establishment of a joint commission for economic, scientific and technical cooperation and trade. According to it, the commission will be responsible for reviewing and examining the implementation of agreements in the above fields signed between the two countries. It will also undertake to study potentialities for expanding the bilateral cooperation and initiate and consider recommendations for increasing such cooperation. (XNA, Apr 12, 1988)

Hungary (Apr 08)
Work plan for cooperation in ten projects involving electronics, computer science, chemicals and agriculture in 1988-89. (XNA, Apr 8, 1988)

Great Britain (Apr 23)
Agreement on cultural, educational and scientific exchange to be carried out from April 1, 1988 to March 31, 1990. (XNA, Apr 23, 1988)

Greece (Apr 07)
Agreement between China and the Greek Agricultural Bank on cooperation in various joint ventures in agriculture and fishery. It provides

for joint production and exchange of technical know-how in fish-farming and seafood, fruit and vegetable canning. Bilateral cooperation will also be conducted in silk industry, seed production, tobacco processing, and the manufacturing of agricultural machinery and fishing boats. (XNA, Apr 7, 1988)

Greece (Apr 16)
Agreement on tourism cooperation. (XNA, Apr 16, 1988)

Malaysia (Apr 01)
Trade agreement. It stipulates that the contracting parties shall grant each other most-favored-nation treatment with respect to customs duties and other taxes applicable to their trade exchanges. (XNA, Apr 1, 1988)

Mozambique (Apr 23)
Agreement on cooperation in agriculture (for details see under "China's Economic Aid"). (XNA, Apr 23, 1988)

Nepal (Apr 21)
Minutes of talks of the intergovernmental economic and trade committee. Under it, Nepal hopes to export more items such as jute goods, hides and skin, medicinal herbs, rice and wheat flour to China and to restore the traditional barter trade on Chinese sheep and Nepalese grains. Pakistan (Apr 30)
Agreement on tourism cooperation. (XNA, Apr 30, 1988)

Philippines (Apr 16)
A Protocol on the importation and exportation of commodities for 1988.

Sweden (Apr 15)
Loan contract, under which Sweden will provide 20 million U.S. dollars in interest-free loans to Shanghai. The money will be used by the city's Wusong Chemical Works to import a Swedish toluene diisocyanate (tdi) plant to produce 10,000 tons annually. This is the largest of all Sino-Swedish governmental economic contracts ever signed. (XNA, Apr 15, 1988)

CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Foreign Aid in 1987

According to statistics collected by the Ministry of Foreign Economic Relations and Trade, last year China sent 2,910 experts and technicians to 62 countries to work on 146 projects. Of these projects, 36 were completed. In addition, China offered assistance to 104 projects previously completed by way of participation in management and administration, bilateral loan agreements and the supply of components and spare parts through barter trade. The Chinese side also organized the implementation of various forms of technological cooperation to seek new channels through which it would be able to offer foreign aid. (BRe, 18.-24.4.88)

Medical Aid

Since 1963, China has sent more than 10,000 medical professionals abroad, who have treated more than 70 million patients in more than 60 countries and regions worldwide. Currently more than 1,300 Chinese medical personnel are working at over 100 sites in 49 Asian, African, Latin American, South Pacific and the Mediterranean countries. (XNA, Apr 6, 1988)

Mozambique

Under a cooperation agreement, China will send experts to Mozambique to help the country develop agriculture. Under it, China will send some agronomists and an agricultural technical group to Mozambique and supply necessary equipment to cooperative projects. In

addition, China will provide some equipment, raw materials and spare parts as well as technical services to a textile factory in Nampula province.

Nepal

Since the first agreement of economic and technical cooperation signed in 1956 between the two countries, China has undertaken 37 assistant projects in Nepal such as highways, water conservation and irrigation projects, a paper factory and a sugar mill. To date, 26 projects have been completed with satisfactory quality.

Seychelles

China will help to build an Olympic-size swimming pool for local and international competitions and for teaching purposes under use of a Chinese loan of 6.6 million rupees (about 1.2 million U.S. dollars) signed in Dec 1987.

Table: Textile Mills

A. Textile Mills

The first big factories to be built in China for the purpose of mass production were textile mills. They were first constructed in the twenties at a time, therefore, when the country was still in a state of semi-colonial dependency, and were mostly under foreign ownership. When China decided just ten years after gaining independence to provide economic aid, it was able to use its technical know-how and include textile mills in its aid program.

29 countries, 13 in Africa, 8 in Asia, 5 in the Middle East, 2 in Latin America and one in Eastern Europe have profited from this aid.

The first textile mill was erected by the Chinese in 1960 in Kompong Cham, Cambodia, and the last was completed in 1987 in Benin. Although we do not have complete or detailed information about the industrial equipment of the individual mills, we can assume that an average type of mill would be equipped with over 530 looms and 27,000 spindles. The largest mill, measured in terms of the number of looms, was built in Ubungo, Tanzania, and was equipped with 978 looms. The largest, in terms of spindles, was built in Merktila, Burma, and was equipped with 80,000 spindles.

Eight projects are listed in the column "Planned in". The five planned in the seventies obviously got no further than the planning stage. The other three refer to a cotton plant in Antigua and Barbuda, a promise by China to donate 20 million U.S. dollars to Bangladesh for the construction of small textile mills in the private sector and an agreement with Mozambique to repair a textile mill.

B. Factories (Excluding Textile Mills)

Since the textile mills has formed the major part of Chinese aid in the field of industrial plants and factories, they are examined separately. All other plants and factories are examined together here, in order to show the broad range of Chinese aid in this sector. The table shows this most clearly.

It will be noticed that the construction of factories is restricted almost entirely to light industry projects. The only exceptions are the heavy machinery factory in Taxila, Pakistan, and two ordnance factories, one in Bangladesh and one in Pakistan. As regards the project in Taxila, the author was able to see for himself that out of date machinery was being used there to produce machines chiefly

for use in road construction. Such machines were in use in the West before the 2nd World War. It must be recognized, however, that China has achieved excellent results with machines of this type in road construction abroad (cf. Road Construction) and that poor countries will have to manage with these machines for a long time to come to improve and maintain their infrastructures.

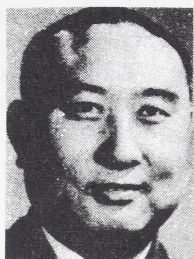

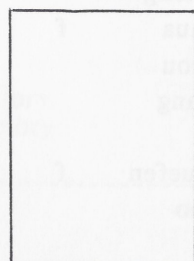
