AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Wolfgang Bartke

Bhutan (May 14)

Joint Communiqué on the 5th round of boundary talks between China and Bhutan.

Bulgaria (May 20)

Agreement on cooperation between the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference and Bulgaria's Fatherland Front. According to it, the two sides will exchange delegations or working study groups to discuss specific plans of cooperation, exchange experience and study living conditions of the people and activities of the two organizations. To deepen mutual understanding the two sides will also exchange material and publications.

Czechoslovakia (May 25)

A Agreement on the main directions of long-term economic and scientific-technical cooperation. It emphasises that the main goal of economic and scientific-technical cooperation was to make use of the newest findings of scientific-technical research for the development of the economies of both states, to take a mutual part in the technical restructuring of enterprises of the two sides, in the modernisation and construction of new sectors, to found jointly managed enterprises and to cooperate in industry. At the same time both countries are aware that scientific-technical progress is an important element in the intensification of the economy and increasing the effectiveness of production. They will therefore strive for the deepening of economic and scientific cooperation and for the widening of mutual goods exchange in 16 specified areas including nuclear energy and the peaceful use of nuclear energy, engineering, metallurgy and the gas industry, light in-

dustry, agriculture and the protection of the environment. Cooperation will also concern the health service, tourism and education. This agreement, which also includes forms of securing cooperation, is valid up to the year 2000. The agreement will be extended by five years each time unless one of the sides declines.

A Culture agreement (the first ever between the Chinese and Indian governments). Under the accord, the two countries will establish and develop closer relations in the realms of culture, art, education, social sciences, sports, public health, press and publishing, broadcasting, film and television. The agreement also stipulates that the two sides will grant scholarships and provide facilities to students for their study and researches in each other's countries.

Exchange of notes on Japan to give assistance gratis to four projects in China. The projects include the rehabilitation of the areas affected by the forest fire of the Da Hinggan Mountains in northeast China, the construction of the Beidaihe Central Research Station of marine ranching, the supply of audiovisual equipment for both the National Library of China and the Beijing Foreign Studies University.

A Agreement on Spain to grant China a 145-million U.S. dollars soft loan to finance the construction of a detergent plant.

Long-term program for scientific and technological cooperation in 1988-92. The program stipulates that the two countries will cooperate in the form of carrying on common studies, mutually transferring achievements in science and technology and exchanging experts and information in this field. Un-
