CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Guyana

A Chinese interest-free loan of 5.5 million U.S.\$ will be used to finance three projects, including one from the private sector to set up a factory to produce five million high density polypropylene bags annually to satisfy local demand for packaging material, particularly farm products. Another agreement provides for the setting up of a

plant by Demerara Distilleries Ltd. to trap and utilize methane gas generated in its distillation operations. One loan will be used to provide the Georgetown city council with cleansing tools and equipment. (XNA, Jul 31, 1988)

Jordan

With Chinese assistance a sports city is under construction in Arbid, 80 kilometers north of Amman and covers an area of 100,000 square meters, including an out-door stadium which can accommodate 15,000 spectators, an indoor stadium for 2,000 spectators and a swimming pool. Construction of the project started in November 1987 and is scheduled to be completed in May 1990.

Nepal

Under a contract between the China National Complete Plant Export Corporation and the Nepalese government China agreed to design an international conference hall in Kathmandu. The hall or international convention center will cover a land of eight hectares with a floor area of about 10,000 square meters. It will be the largest conference hall in the country. It will mainly include a 1,150-seat auditorium hall and a medium-sized conference hall with 250 seats and equipped with public address and simultaneous interpretation system. A multi-functional hall with the same system equipment, two small-sized conference halls of 100-seat capacity each, two meeting rooms of 50-seat capacity each, vip chambers and some supporting facilities will be constructed in the center. The construction of the center will be done with Chinese financial assistance. The construction work will start next year.
