Under it, the two sides pledge to promote scientific and technical cooperation between the two countries and materialize the cooperation by exchange of scientific experience and technical results in various sectors of economy and environment. The cooperation also comprises the exchange of visits of researchers and experts, research on subjects of common interest, organizing of seminars and exchange of samples of various seeds.

Agreement with the IAEA to accept agency safeguards on all Chinese civilian nuclear installations. China's move means that all five nuclear-weapon states, the United States, the Soviet Union, China, France and Britain, now open their non-military nuclear installations for international inspection.

Gambia

China has agreed to help Gambia with the construction of several projects. They include the rehabilitation of health centers built by China and the construction in Banjul of a courthouse valued at over 8 million U.S. dollars through an interest-free loan from China. Recent Sino-Gambian cooperative projects have included public health facilities, fishing and well-digging. In 1982, a stadium with a capacity of 20,000 was built in Bakau, 15 kilometers from the capital with Chinese technical aid and a loan of some four million U.S. dollars from China.

China sent about 127,000 U.S. dollars worth of medicines to Niger to help build up the Niamey hospital.

Chen was a newcomer when appointed vice-minister of the State Planning Commission in March 1988.

Chen Muhua (f) 陈慕华
Elected chairman of the Women's Federation. (XNA, Sep 5, 1988)

Chen has been a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee. She lost her positions as an alternate member of the Politburo in Nov 1987, and as president of People's Bank and state councillor in April 1988.

Ding Chuan'gen 丁关根
Appointed vice-minister of the State Planning Commission and director of the Taiwan Affairs Office under the State Council. (XNA, Sep 10, 1988)

Ding, an alternate member of the CCP Politburo, resigned on his own request from the post of minister of railways in Jan 1988.

Guo Dezhi 郭德志
Appointed vice-minister of justice. (XNA, Aug 31, 1988)

Guo has been director of the ministry's Propaganda Department before.

Hao Yichun (f) 郝治纯
Elected vice-chairman of the Women's Federation. (XNA, Sep 5, 1988)

Hao, born in 1919, has been a vice-chairman of the Jiusan Society since 1983. She is known chiefly for her research in micro-palaeontology.

He Kang 何康
Appointed vice-minister of the State Environmental Protection Commission. (XNA, Sep 6, 1988)

He, a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, also has been minister of agriculture.

Huang Qizao 黄启琛
Elected vice-chairman and secretary of the Women's Federation. (XNA, Sep 5 and 7, 1988)

Huang has been secretary-general and member of the Standing Committee of Sichuan Province CP before.

Huang Yicheng 黄毅诚
Appointed vice-minister of the State Environmental Protection Commission (XNA, Sep 6, 1988)

Huang has been minister of energy resources since April 1988.

Jia Shi 贾石
Deceased Sep 4, 1988. (XNA, Sep 6, 1988)

Jia had been vice-minister of foreign economic relations and trade from 1982 until Jan 1986 when he was appointed chairman of the China Council for the Promotion of International Trade.

Kang Keqing (f) 康克清
Elected honorary chairman of the Women's Federation. (XNA, Sep 5, 1988)

Kang, the widow of Zhu De, has been the federation's chairman before.

Kang Ling (f) 康令
Elected secretary of the Women's Federation. (XNA, Sep 7, 1988)
Kang is a newcomer.

Li Xu'e 李绪鄂
Appointed vice-minister of the State Environmental Protection Commission. (XNA, Sep 6, 1988)

Li had been a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee and minister of astronautics industry (1985-1988/03) and became vice-minister of the State Science and Technology Commission in May 1988.

Li Zhenqian 李振潜
Identified as vice-governor of Guangxi Autonomous Region. (China Reconstructs 1988/09)

Li, an alternate member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, also has been deputy secretary of Guangxi CP.

Liang Xiang 梁湘
Elected deputy secretary of Hainan Province. (XNA, Sep 5, 1988)
Liang has been governor of Hainan Province since Aug 1988.

Liu Huaqiu 刘华秋
Identified as assistant foreign minister. (XNA, Sep 7, 1988)

Liu has been director of the Foreign Ministry's America and Oceania Affairs Department before.

Liu Jianfeng 刘剑锋
Elected deputy secretary of Hainan Province CP. (XNA, Sep 5, 1988)

Liu had been vice-minister of electronics industry from 1984 until 1988/03.

Lu Leshan (f)
Elected vice-chairman of the Women's Federation. (XNA, Sep 5, 1988)
Lu is a newcomer.

Miao Yuntai 缪云台
Deceased Sep 3, 1988. (XNA, Sep 3, 1988)

Miao had been vice-chairman of the 7th CPPCC.

Nie Li (f) 聂力
Elected vice-chairman of the Women's Federation. (XNA, Sep 5, 1988)

Nie, a daughter of marshal Nie Rongzhen, has been vice-chairman of the Scientific and Technological Committee under the Commission of Science, Technology and Industry for National Defense since 1983. She also was appointed one of the five female major-generals of the PLA on Sep 16, 1988.

Qu Geping 曲格平
Appointed vice-minister of the State Environmental Protection Commission. (XNA, Sep 6, 1988)

Qu has been director of the State Environmental Protection Bureau before.

Song Jian 宋健
Appointed minister of the State Environmental Protection Commission. (XNA, Sep 6, 1988)

Song has been a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee and a state councillor of the government.

Wang Julu 王巨禄
Identified as deputy secretary of Liaoning Province CP. (Shenyang Radio, Aug 31, 1988, cit. SWB, Sep 9, 1988)

Wang has been a member of the Standing Committee of Liaoning CP before.

Wei Yu (f) 韦钰
Elected vice-chairman of the Women's Federation. (XNA, Sep 5, 1988)
Wei has been director of the Nanjing Engineering Institute since 1987.

Xu Shijie 许士杰
Elected secretary of Hainan Province CP. (XNA, Sep 5, 1988)
