China has agreed to help Gambia with the construction of several projects. They include the rehabilitation of health centers built by China and the construction in Banjul of a courthouse valued at over 8 million U.S. dollars through an interest-free loan from China. Recent Sino-Gambian cooperative projects have included public health facilities, fishing and well-digging. In 1982, a stadium with a capacity of 20,000 was built in Bakau, 15 kilometers from the capital with Chinese technical aid and a loan of some four million U.S. dollars from China. (XNA, Sep 7, 1988)

China sent about 127,000 U.S. dollars worth of medicines to Niger to help build up the Niamey hospital. (XNA, Sep 1, 1988)




