AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Australia (Nov 17)

A Tax agreement which is for the avoidance of double taxation and the prevention of fiscal evasion with respect to taxes on income. The agreement, a follow-up one for investment protection which was signed in Beijing last July, is designed to encourage mutual investment and trade.

B Fishery agreement under which Chinese fishing boats will have access to the waters along the north-western coast of Australia for fishing for one year with a quota of 4,800 tonnes.

Investment guarantee agreement for the reciprocal encouragement and protection of investments.

Agreement on setting up a joint Economic and Trade Commission.

Mongolia, People's Republic (Nov 04)

Protocol of mutual supply of goods and payments. It calls for China to exchange textiles, machinery, fruit and light industrial products for Mongolian planks and furs.

Mongolia, People's Republic (Nov 28)

Treaty on the border system and on solution to border issues. It stipulates that it is aimed at maintaining the stability of the Sino-Mongolian border and peace in the border region, and at making the two sides abide by the border system and solve border issues on the principle of mutual understanding and cooperation. It also stipulates regulations on solving border issues and other related affairs.

Morocco (Nov 08)

Loan agreement, under which China will lend eight million U.S. dollars, interest free, to be used for the construction of a sport stadium in the capital, dams, and other projects.

Nepal (Nov 25)

Letters relating to one-year extension of the 1983 agreement on trans-frontier pasturing by border inhabitants. Under it, the inhabitants of Dolakha, Mustang and Humle on the Nepalese side will be provided trans-frontier pasturing on the Chinese side while the inhabitants of Furang area of China's Tibet will have similar facilities on the Nepalese side.

New Zealand (Nov 22)

Investment protection agreement. It provides investors from both countries with assurances of non-discriminatory treatment, transferability of funds, compensation in the event of expropriation and dispute settlement procedures.

A Sports exchange protocol for 1989.
B Plan for cultural exchange from 1989 to 1990, under which 70 Chinese students and 160 Korean students will be sent to each side during the next two years. China and Korea will also exchange visits by educational, cultural and artist delegations as well as books, films and data of science and technology during the period.

Peru (Nov 02)

Basic agreement for economic and technical cooperation, which will extend to all areas, especially in agriculture, family husbandry, fishing, energy, metallurgic industry, chemistry, the iron and steel industry and petrochemicals, mining and telecommunication. China will provide equipment and materials and send specialists to Peru for assembling, adjusting and using the equipment provided. The agreement will be carried out in the form of joint venture and investment programs. In addition, a joint commission at the ministerial level will be established to review the implementation of the agreement.
