Thailand (Jan 15)

Minute of the 7th meeting of the Joint Committee on Scientific and Technical Cooperation. Under it, China and Thailand have agreed on 43 new scientific and technological cooperation items in the fields of industry, agriculture, medical and health and education.

Cyprus (Jan 16)

Minute of the 1st session of the Joint Commission on Economic, Scientific and Technical Cooperation. Under it, both sides agreed to promote bilateral economic cooperation by facilitating and assisting activities of competent organisations (firms) of both countries and to encourage collaboration of their respective companies in undertaking projects and providing services in third countries. Both sides also agreed to expand and diversify trade between the two countries, exchange visits of trade missions and businessmen, and hold fairs and exhibitions. On scientific and technical cooperation, the two sides agreed to encourage visits of scientific and technical personnel and exchange technical information, seeds, seedlings and specimens.

Trade contract on China's export of 20,000 tons of cotton. The cotton deal, worth 30 million U.S.dollars, was the largest made between the two countries this year. Last year, China for the first time exported 5,000 tons of cotton to Yugoslavia, which annually imports 140,000 tons of cotton.

CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Sudan

China agreed to construct the Omdurman vocational training center. At the projected center, there will be four training branches to cover 16 types of jobs involving civil engineering, mechanical processing, electrical equipment and car repairing. The center can train 500 people each term with equipment and tools provided by China. The project will be financed by China with a loan of 16 million yuan (about 6.3 million dollars) and constructed by Sudanese workers with Chinese technicians' help.

Chu Tunan 楚 图 南

Elected honorary chairman of the China Democratic League (XNA, Jan 9, 1987).

Chu has been the league's chairman before.

Fang Lizhi 方 厉 之

Expelled from the CCP, removed from his post as vice-president of the Hefei University of Science and Technology and assigned as research fellow at the Beijing Observatory (XNA, Jan 12, 1987).

Fei Xiaotong 费 孝 通

Elected chairman of the China Democratic League (XNA, Jan 9, 1987).

Fei, China's leading sociologist, has been the league's vice-chairman before.

Hu Yaobang 胡 邦 邦

The enlarged meeting of the Politburo on Jan 16, 1987, accepted Hu's resignation as general secretary of the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Jan 16, 1987).

Ji Fang 季 方

Elected honorary chairman of the China Peasants' and Workers' Democratic Party (XNA, Jan 3, 1987).

Ji has been the party's chairman before.

Li Wenshan 李 文 珊

Identified as deputy secretary of Hebei Province CP (Shijiazhuang Radio, Jan 21, 1987; cit. SWB, Jan 23, 1987).

Since 1983 Li has been serving in the Tibet CP, his last position being one of its deputy secretaries.

Li Yan 李 燕

Identified as deputy director of the Propaganda Department under the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Jan 12, 1987).

Li derives from the Communist Youth League: in July 1964 he was elected one of its Central Committee members. In 1983 he was reactivated and became secretary-general of the Propaganda Department.

Lu Jiaxi 卢嘉锡

Removed from his post as president of the Academy of Sciences (XNA, Jan 22) and appointed special advisor to the academy (XNA, Jan 26, 1987).

Peng Peiyun 彭佩云

Appointed secretary of the Party Committee of the Hefei University of Science and Technology (XNA, Jan 12, 1987).

Before the Cultural Revolution Peng had been deputy Party secretary of Beijing University. He was reactivated in 1982 and holds the position of a vice-minister of education since that time.

Teng Teng 腾藤

Appointed president of the Hefei University of Science and Technology (XNA, Jan 12) and vice-president of the Academy of Sciences (XNA, Jan 22, 1987).

Teng, born in 1930 in Jiangsu Province, studied engineering chemistry in the USSR. In 1984 he became vice-president of Qinghua University and in Feb 1985 vice-minister of the State Scientific and Technological Commission. In Aug 1986 he could be identified as deputy director of the Propaganda Department under the CCP Central Committee.

Yan Dongsheng 严东生

Removed from his post as vice-president of the Academy of Sciences (XNA, Jan 22) and appointed special advisor to the academy (XNA, Jan 26, 1987).

Zhao Ziyang 赵紫阳

Elected acting general secretary of the CCP Central Committee at the enlarged meeting of the Politburo on Jan 16, 1987 (XNA, Jan 16, 1987).

Zhou Guangzhao 周光召

Appointed president of the Academy of Sciences (XNA, Jan 22, 1987).

Zhou, a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, has been director of the academy's Institute of Theoretical Physics since April 1983.

Zhou Gucheng 周国诚

Elected chairman of the China Peasants' and Workers' Democratic Party (XNA, Jan 3, 1987).

Zhou has been the party's vice-chairman before.
