AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Germany, Fed. Republic (Mar 01)

Protocol on sports exchanges for 1987. According to it, China will send sports teams, coaches and sports delegations to Federal Germany no less than 17 occasions throughout the year, and the FRG, in return, will send back sports teams, coaches as well as delegations to China on seven occasions. (XNA, Mar 1, 1987)

Soviet Union (Mar 02)

Trade protocol for 1987. Under it, China will export soybean, maize, frozen pork, tea, cotton cloth, knitwear, handicrafts and other light industrial products in exchange for Soviet machinery, trucks, cars, planes, ferrous and non-ferrous metals, timber and chemical products. (XNA, Mar 2, 1987)

Philippines (Mar 04)

Trade protocol for 1987. Under it, China will import from the Philippines coconut oil, copper concentrates, chrome ore, copper cathodes, lumber, plywood, ferroalloys, natural rubber, phosphatic and compound fertilizers, bananas and other products. The Philippines is prepared to import from China crude oil, machinery, coal, steel billets, minerals, chemicals, soybean meal, cotton and other commodities. The protocol stipulates that both sides shall jointly endeavor to achieve more or less balance between the values of imports and exports in their two-way trade. The volume of trade between China and the Philippines in 1986 totaled 226 m US\$. Of the sum, China's imports to the country amounted to 130 m US\$. The balance of trade between the two countries has improved. In 1985, China enjoyed a surplus of 156 m US\$. But in 1986, the surplus was brought down to 34 m US\$. (XNA, Mar 4, 1987)

Poland (Mar 07)

Agreement on cooperation in social sciences and human studies. Under it, the Chinese Academy of Social

Sciences and Polish Academy of Sciences will organize exchange of visits by researchers to make on-the-spot investigations, give lectures and attend academic forums, and provide each other with academic publications. (XNA, Mar 8, 1987)

Cultural exchange program. FRG will provide 600 scholarships for Chinese scholars and students in 1987. China will open a German-teaching television program at home and hold two arts exhibitions in Federal Germany. In return, a Federal German ballet troupe will tour China and four German arts exhibitions will be opened in the country. (XNA, Mar 11, 1987)

Soviet Union (Mar 13)

Minutes of the 29th Session of the Joint Commission for Navigation on the Boundary Rivers. (XNA, Mar 13, 1987)

Egypt (Mar 15)

Protocol on scientific and technical cooperation. Under it, the two governments will exchange experts to study technology in many fields. They include the production of medicines and medical equipment anti-corrosion in prestressed concrete structures under sea, irriga-

tion and drainage in arid and semi-arid areas, small hydraulic power stations, milk production and processing, afforestation of shelterbelt in arid area, plant protection and green house techniques. The two sides will also exchange experience in the use of foreign investment. (XNA, Mar 15, 1987)

Canada (Mar 19)

Four memorandums of understanding. They are: memorandum of understanding between the government of Canada and the government of China concerning the establishment of a language training center, concerning the assistance to the 14 cities and open areas projects, concerning a project to provide human development training and concerning the assistance project to upgrade management education in China.

Under these agreements Canada will provide a free aid of more than 60 million Canadian dollars for China. (XNA, Mar 19, 1987)

Kuwait (Mar 19)

Agreement on a loan for a polypropylene project in Luoyang, Henan Province between China and the Kuwait Fund For Arab Economic Development. Since 1982, the fund has provided China with loans totalling 240 m US\$, which have been used for nine projects. (XNA, Mar 19, 1987)

Cameroon (Mar 28)

Agreement on China granting a loan. (XNA, Mar 28, 1987)

European Community (Mar 31)

Agreement on the establishment of the delegation of the commission of the European Community in China and the privileges and immunities. (XNA, Mar 31, 1987)

CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

General

China will continue economic aid to 63 developing countries involving 222 projects in 1987. The projects include 13 new projects, 59 continuing projects, 100 projects involving technological and managerial cooperation, and this year about 40 projects are scheduled for completion. Providing financial support to other third world countries has been one of China's ongoing policies, and the country has supplied 1,154 pieces of equipment to about 90 developing countries over the past 30 years. Most of the projects are running smoothly and have helped the recipients develop their national economy and raise the people's standard of living. In addition to funding new projects, China has picked up some industrial and agricultural projects which were suffering deficits and turned them into profit-making enterprises. A leather plant in Mali, textile plants in Burundi and Zambia, and the Tanzania-Zambia railway are just some of the projects improved through aid from China. (XNA, Mar 9, 1987)

Barbados

An eight-member Chinese vegetable-growing technical team left here for home today after successfully introducing more than 100 Chinese vegetables and setting up an experimental center here in the past four years. The team arrived in March 1983 under a two-year Sino-Barbadian government program. But the mission was extended due to its remarkable accomplishments. The Chinese technicians succeeded in introducing Chinese species that Barbadian people most like, including cabbage, long beans, eggplants, yam beans, mushroom and carrots, to a new environment. They produced a total of 75,500 kilograms of vegetables, bred 510 pounds of seeds and demonstrated cooking techniques to local people. (XNA, Mar 25, 1987)

Nepal

China agreed to construct a highway from Pokhara to Baglung. Under the contract, China will start the construction of this 73-km highway in the fall of 1987 and the whole project will be completed in 45 months. (XNA, Mar 22, 1987)

Identified as vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Heilongjiang Province. (Harbin Radio, Mar 16, 1987; cit. SWB, Mar 19, 1987)

He has been a vice-governor of Heilongjiang before.

Li Changchun 李昌春

Appointed governor of Liaoning Province. (XNA, Mar 9, 1987)

Li, an alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, has been acting governor of Liaoning since July 1986.

Yan Haiwang 阎海旺

Appointed vice-governor of Gansu Province. (XNA, Mar 18, 1987)

Yan was born in 1939. In 1963 he graduated from the Harbin Engineering College and later served as director of Gansu's Urban and Rural Construction Department.

Zhang Boxing 张卜兴

Elected governor of Shaanxi Province. (XNA, Mar 17, 1987)

Zhang was Shaanxi's vice-governor since June 1985 and its acting governor since Dec 1986.
