AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Sweden (Apr 06)

A Memorandum of understanding on cooperation in the field of space activities for peaceful purposes. It says that the areas of common interest lie mainly in the fields of space science, including material sciences in microgravity; remote sensing, including applications in the fields of forestry, agriculture and monitoring of the environment; and other elements of science and technology in the field of space activities as selected on the parties.

B Agreement concerning China's purchase of pulp from Sweden.

C Letter of intent between the Electric Power Research Institute of the Chinese Ministry of Water Resources and Electric Power and Asea AB regarding the establishment of a Sino-Swedish power development center. According to it, China and Sweden will cooperate in high-voltage transmission. The Swedish side has expressed its willingness to grant loans to China to build a Sino-Swedish power transmission development center.

D Agreement on a Sino-Swedish soil conservation project. According to it, the two sides will carry out research and cooperation in soil conservation on China's loess plateau.

E Agreement on the management and operation of the Beijing Hua Qiao mansion (draft).

Argentina (Apr 08)

Postgraduate scholarship exchange program agreement as a complementary accord to the existing scientific and technical cooperation treaty.

Protocol of the 8th session on scientific and technical cooperation. Under it, the two sides agreed on 18 cooperative projects covering forestry, agriculture, public health, transport, water conservation and electric power, seism, coal industry and aquatic products.

Belize (Apr 09)

Agreement on economic and technical cooperation. According to it, the Chinese government will provide an interest-free loan to Belize to finance complete projects, technical cooperation and supply of equipment.

Agreement on higher education. It envisages a broadening of scientific and research cooperation, and as of the academic year 1987/88, Polish students will be able to take full courses of higher studies in Chinese universities.

German Democratic Republic

(Apr 21)

Protocol on cooperation in coal mining and processing. According to it, both countries will further their cooperation in setting up a gas factory in northeast China city of Harbin as well as their cooperation in two other major engineering on coal mining and processing. The protocol also regulates ways to implement exchange of technological personnel and training of workers.

Netherlands (Apr 24)

Document on agricultural economic cooperation. In order to intensify and deepen the existing relationship and establish new contacts between the two countries in the agricultural sector, the two sides agreed on a series of activities including mutual visits and Dutch participation in agricultural exhibitions and seminars and symposia in China. They are also to cooperate in the field of agricultural research through departments concerned in the two countries' ministries of agriculture within the framework of the joint agricultural working group.

The two sides will broaden inter-university cooperation between the Dutch University of Wageningen and China's Nanjing Agricultural University. Cooperation will be increased between the two countries in the training of skilled working forces, such as practical training in livestock raising.

The officials from the two countries also discussed the possibility to set up a training center for poultry and pig production and training facilities in the field of greenhouse horticulture and dairy production in China.

Uganda (Apr 25)

Agreement on economic and technical cooperation under which China provides an interest-free loan of 80 million yuan (21.3 million U.S.dollars) within a period of 5 years from July 1, 1987. The loan shall be mainly used for the construction of a stadium and implementation of other projects to be decided upon by the two governments.

Czechoslovakia (Apr 26)
Agreement on setting up a Sino-CSSR shipping company.

Guyana (Apr 27)
Agreement on economic and technical cooperation. Under it, China will provide an interest-free loan to Guyana for complete projects, technical cooperation and equipment for individual projects. Guyana will repay the loan in installment by means of convertible currencies or Guyanese exports as agreed upon by the two governments.

Soviet Union (Apr 30)
Protocol of the first meeting of the working group for education of the Soviet-Chinese Commission for Economic, Trade, Scientific and Technological Cooperation. It envisions further exchanges of students, trainees and teachers between the two countries. The sides also discussed a draft plan for cooperation in education for 1988-1990.

CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Afghanistan

The Red Cross Society of China has provided Afghan refugees living in Pakistan with a consignment of relief goods valued at about 100,000 U.S. dollars. The relief goods include medicine, medical instruments, 1,250 tons of rice, one million yards of cotton cloth, 200,000 pairs of shoes, 30 trucks and 50 tons of tea.

Kenya

On Apr 23, the Chinese-aided 60,000-seat stadium was handed over. It is located at Kasarani, 18 km northeast of Nairobi. It will serve as the main venue for the 4th All African Games in August this year. - The same day the foundation stone was laid for a 5,000-seat gymnasium and a 2,000-seat

swimming pool, also to be constructed with Chinese assistance.

Sudan

A Chinese medical team arrived in Kharoum on 26th April to replace a group of Chinese doctors who have worked in Khartoum for two years. The team of 30 specialists from various medical fields will work at Abu Usher regional hospital, some 120 km southeast of Khartoum.

Zimbabwe

On April 1, the Chinese-aided 60,000-seat sports stadium was handed over (XNA, Apr 1, 1987). It is situated at Warren Hills, west suburbs of Harare. China will help Zimbabwe establish an embroidery center under a protocol signed Apr 2. It stipulates that China will provide Zimbabwe with 10 sewing machines, spare parts and other embroidery instruments, and send a team of four experts to supervise the installation of the equipment and train women in embroidery. Initially 15 women will be trained in a period of two years. When the embroidery centre proves to be operationally successful, more women will be trained.

Removed from his post as vice-minister of the State Commission for Restructuring the Economic System. (XNA, Apr 18, 1987)

Bai Lichen 白立忱

Elected chairman of the People's Government of Ningxia Autonomous Region. (XNA, Apr 29, 1987)
Bai has been the government's acting chairman before.

Cai Zimin 蔡子民

By-elected member of the Standing Committee of the 6th NPC. (XNA, Apr 11, 1987)
Cai was born in 1920 in Taiwan. He is a veteran of the Taiwan Feb 1947 uprising and has been a deputy for Taiwan to the NPC since 1975.

Chen Minzhang 陈敏章
Appointed minister of public health. (XNA, Apr 11, 1987)
Chen has been a vice-minister of public health before.

Du Daozheng 杜导正
Appointed director of the State Media and Publications Office. (XNA, Apr 18, 1987)
Since 1984 Du had been editor-in-chief of GMRB.

Li Tieying 李铁映
Appointed minister of the State Commission for Restructuring the Economic System. (XNA, Apr 11, 1987)

Li, a son of Li Weihan, as a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee. From 1983-85 he served as secretary of Liaoning Province CP and as minister of electronics since then.

Qian Weichang 钱伟长
By-elected vice-chairman of the 6th CPPCC. (XNA, Apr 8, 1987)
Qian who received a doctorate degree of applied mathematics in Canada served as vice-president of Qinhua University before the Cultural Revolution. He is one of China's most prominent physicists and since 1983 vice-chairman of the China Democratic League.

Ruan Chongwu 阮崇武
Appointed vice-minister of the State Science and Technology Commission. (XNA, Apr 18, 1987)
Ruan is a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee. From Sep 1985 until Apr 1987 he had been minister of public security.

Wang Fang 王芳
Appointed minister of public security. (XNA, Apr 11, 1987)
Wang is a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee. From 1983 until now he had been secretary of Zhejiang Province CP.

Wang Feng 汪锋
By-elected vice-chairman of the 6th CPPCC. (XNA, Apr 8, 1987)
First Party secretary of Gansu Province and alternate member of the CCP Central Committee before the Cultural Revolution, Wang was purged in 1966. Reactivated in 1977 he served as member of the CCP 11th Central Committee (1977-82) and as 1st secretary of Xinjiang CP (1978-81). Since 1982 he has been member of the Central Advisory Commission under the CCP Central Committee.

Wang Jifu 王济夫
Appointed vice-minister of culture. (XNA, Apr 18, 1987)
Wang has been Party secretary of Yantai City before.

Wang Jinling 王金陵
Elected member of the Standing Committee of the 6th NPC. (XNA, Apr 11, 1987)
Wang became known as a soybean expert and served in Heilongjiang Province since 1948, his last position being vice-chairman of the province's People's Congress.

Wu Mingyu 吴明瑜
Removed from his post as vice-minister of the State Scientific and Technology Commission and appointed deputy director-general of the State Economic, Technological and Social Department Research Center (XNA, Apr 18, 1987).

Yan Jinsheng 颜金生
By-elected member of the Standing Committee of the 6th NPC (XNA, Apr 11, 1987). Once a major-general, Yan served as vice-minister of culture before the Cultural Revolution. After his reactivation he became deputy director of the PLA General Political Department (1977-85) and vice-chairman of the PLA Greening Committee (1982-?).

Xue Ju 薛驹
Appointed secretary of Zhejiang Province CP (Hongzhou Radio, Apr 21, 1987; cit. SWB, Apr 23, 1987). Xue Ju, a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, has been governor of Zhejiang since 1983.

Ye Duzheng 叶笃正
By-elected member of the Standing Committee of the 6th NPC (XNA, Apr 11, 1987).
Ye had been vice-president of the Academy of Sciences (1981-1985) and director of its Atmospheric Physics Institute (1981-85) whose honorary director he became in 1985.

Yi Meihou 蚁美厚
By-elected member of the Standing Committee of the 6th NPC (XNA, Apr 11, 1987).
Before the foundation of the PR China, Yi lived in Thailand. Since 1978 he has been vice-chairman of the Federation of Returned Overseas Chinese.

Zeng Xianlin 曾宪林
Appointed minister of light industry (XNA, Apr 11, 1987).
Zeng has been vice-minister of the State Scientific and Technological Commission (since Feb 1985) and vice-minister of the State Planning Commission (since Mar 1986).

Zhang Changshun 张长顺
Identified as commander of Sichuan Military District (Chengdu Radio, Apr 6, 1987; cit. SWB, Apr 9, 1987) (on this post possibly since 1985).
Zhang is a newcomer.

Zhang Zongde 张宗德
Identified as commander of Fujian Military District (Fujian RB, Apr 6, 1987; cit. SWB, Apr 20, 1987).
Zhang is a newcomer.
