AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Federal Rep. of Germany (May 02)
Cooperation agreement to enhance international trade. It allows China and FR Germany to settle business disputes and marine affairs between them through consultations. (XNA, May 2, 1987)

France (May 04)
Agreement on judicial cooperation in civil and commercial matters. According to it, the two countries will cooperate with each other in transmitting and delivering judicial and extrajudicial instruments, investigate and obtain evidence on each other's behalf, and recognize and execute each other's judiciary decisions and arbitrations. A Agreement on the basic orientation for long-term economic, scientific and technological cooperation.

Bulgaria (May 07)
Cooperation agreement between Xinhua News Agency and the Bulgarian Telegraph Agency. Under it, the two sides will exchange news stories and photos free of charge, and each provides the other with additional materials, photos and other services about what is the special interest of the other. It says that the two sides will exchange views on expanding cooperation, news disseminating and new telecommunications technology of common concern. (XNA, May 7, 1987)

Czechoslovakia (May 08)
Accord on tax evasion prevention and avoidance of double taxation. (XNA, May 8, 1987)

Greece (May 12)
Protocol on the expansion of cooperation in science and technology. China and Greece will cooperate on research in energy and energy-related areas, biology, biotechnology, agriculture, physics, construction materials, metallurgy and sociology. (XNA, May 12, 1987)

North Korea (May 13)
Protocol on border river transport cooperation in 1987. (XNA, May 13, 1987)

Netherlands (May 13)
A Agreement on the avoidance of double taxation and the prevention of fiscal evasion with respect to income.

German Democratic Rep. (May 14)

Agreement on television cooperation. Under it, China Central Television (CCTV) and the Greek Radio-Television Organization (ERT-1) will exchange, on a regular basis or on request, television programs, films and tapes pertaining to political, economic, science and sports subjects. The two sides also agreed to exchange visits of TV crews as well as their management and production expertise. (XNA, May 20, 1987)

Switzerland (May 20)
Financing agreement. According to it, Switzerland will provide China 100 million Swiss francs in mixed financing. (XNA, May 20, 1987)

Soviet Union (May 21)
A Agreement on cooperation of television and radio (1).
B Plan of scientific ties between the USSR Academy of Sciences and the PRC Academy of Social Sciences for 1987-89 (2). Under this plan, both sides will exchange visits by researchers for the delivery of lectures and for participation in conferences and other activities. The plan also provides for exchanges of books, magazines and other specialised publication.

German Democratic Rep. (May 22)
Agreement between the GDR Journalists' Union and the PRC Journalists' Association. The five-year agreement says that between 1988 and 1992 the two countries will exchange delegations for training and to share information. (XNA, May 22, 1987)

India (May 27)
Trade protocol for the period Jan 1987-Mar 1988. According to the document, the contracting parties agree to set the total value of bilateral trade at about 150-200 million U.S.dollars. The document stipulates that according to the two countries' needs and capability, the Chinese side expects to import from India mineral ore, agricultural and engineering products, chemicals, plywood, jewelry and processed diamonds while the Indian side expects to import from China raw

silk and minerals, chemicals and petroleum products, fresh water cultivated pearls, engineering products and pharmaceuticals.

Federal Rep. of Germany (May 27)
Loan agreement. Under it, the FRG will loan China 100 million DM (56.2 million U.S.dollars) and donate 63.7 million DM in free technological aid.

Spain (May 28)

Two-year agreement on educational, scientific and technological cooperation: Under it, the two governments will intensify exchanges between colleges, universities and scientific research institutions. The two nations will increase exchanges between each other's artistic organizations and encourage the exchange of publications, cultural information and literature. During 1987-88, each country will hold an exhibition of its artistic achievements on the other's soil and step up their cooperation in museology, archaeology, archive science, library science, film, music and drama.

Soviet Union (May 28)

Protocol on exchanges between the USSR State Committee for Printing, Publishing and Book Trade and the PRC Press and Publishing Board for 1988-89. The document envisages wider book exchanges between the two countries, measures to increase the publication of books by Soviet and Chinese authors, and exchanges of publishing, printing and book-trade specialists. It was agreed to exchange specialists - editors and translators - to give assistance in the translation and editing of books. The protocol envisages a continuation of exchanges of book exhibitions.

Protocol on sports exchange in 1987.

Protocol on cooperation between the Chinese Communist Party and the United National Independence Party. Under it, the two parties will exchange delegations on a reciprocal basis, exchange publications and other materials, promote friendly relations and cooperation

between mass organizations affiliated to the two parties. The two sides will also send teaching staff and research workers to lecture at each other's party institutions or engage in study tours on chosen topics concerning party and national construction, and exchange views on matters of interest within the framework of international gatherings attended by delegations from the two parties.

CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Bangladesh

China is to give Bangladesh 20 million dollars for setting up textile mills in the private sector with Chinese machinery. A general agreement to this effect was signed in Beijing on 26th May by the Bangladesh Shilpa Bank and the China National Machinery Import and Export Corporation. Under another memorandum of understanding signed on the 25th, China is to give another 20 million dollars for setting up a leather finishing factory, a caustic soda plant, a plastic products plant, a tractor factory and other light engineering plants.

Jordan

China will cooperate with Jordan in building a sports city in Irbid, according to notes exchanged on May 5, 1987. The sports city located 80 km north to Amman will be named after crown prince Hassan of Jordan. It will include a gymnasium with 2,000 seats, an olympic-standard stadium with a capacity of holding 15,000 audience, a training hall for basketball, volleyball and badminton, and a world-class swimming pool. According to an agreement to this effect, China Metallurgical Construction Corporation based in Jordan will be in charge of the build the sports city, totalling some 21 million U.S.dollars.

Nepal

Construction of the China-aided Lumbini sugar mills, to be Nepal's biggest with an output of 12,000 t

of sugar annually, started on May 15 at Sunwal village, Nawal Parasi District, about 220 km southwest of Kathmandu. The mill, due to be operating within three years, will also have be able to produce 12,000 litres of alcohol per day from the sugar by-products. A thermo-power generating station with an installed capacity of 3,000 kw will be set up in the factory to produce electricity seasonally. The project, which area totalling 23,384 square meters, is being built by the China National Complete Plant Export Corporation.

Tanzania

A total operating expenditure in the Tanzania-Zambia railway 1987-88 budget will go up to 26.18 million U.S.dollars compared to 17.62 million U.S.dollars during the 1986-87. Under the 1987-88 budget, which begins on July 1 and ends on June 30 next year, the Tanzania-Zambia Railway Authority (Tazara) estimates to handle 1,355 million tons of cargo traffic, compared to 1,176 million tons during 1986-87. It also estimates to carry 1.3 million passengers as in the last budget, and to earn a revenue of 40.11 million U.S.dollars compared to 23.35 million U.S.dollars during 1986-87.
