AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Finland (Jun 01)

Nuclear cooperation agreement. According to it, China and Finland will strengthen the ties between universities, colleges and research institutions and assist visits, training and lecture tours between the two countries. They also agreed to exchange magazines, journals and information on nuclear science for mutual benefit.

Poland (Jun 03)

Seven economic and technological cooperative agreements. Their major points are: Poland will provide China the technology and equipment to produce multi-function gas ranges, and the machine and technology transfer for a coal washing plant in Zaozhuang county, Shandong province. The plant, jointly designed by China and Poland, will be able to clean 3 million tons of coal annually. Poland will provide China inland river radar navigation equipment and technology; and China will provide Poland electronic equipment, components and raw materials for linear cutting.

Bangladesh (Jun 12)

Minutes of the 3rd meeting of the China-Bangladesh Joint Commission on Economic, Trade, Scientific and Technical Cooperation.

Nepal (Jun 14)

Minutes of understanding between the Lhasa Branch of the Bank of China and the Nepal Rastra Bank. It suggested that a modality be introduced to accept the currencies of the two countries to facilitate border trade. To implement this, the two sides establish bank branches and fix the exchange rate for the currencies of the two countries, and officials of the branches should meet every fortnight or month to settle their account and whoever has surplus will be paid in convertible currency. The NRB officials also suggested to set up branches at Kodari point of the Nepalese side and at Zhangmu town of the Chinese side as the start and more branches would be extended to other places later.

Canada (Jun 17)

Two memoranda of understanding covering development assistance projects in China valued at more than 6.5 million Canadian dollars. According to one agreement, the Canadian International Development Agency is to provide more than 4 m Canadian dollars to help the Chinese Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications to upgrade and maintain its domestic satellite communications system. Telesat Canada has been selected as the executing agency for the project. The assistance also includes training of Chinese personnel in Canada and on-site training in China. Under the other agreement, Canada will offer 2.5 m Canadian dollars to the Anhui enterprise management training institute in Hefei, Anhui province. Canada will establish a management development resource centre and provide technical assistance and training for the teachers in industrial enterprise management and international business management.

The first modern paper plant in Nepal, which was built in 1986 with Chinese assistance, is capable of meeting 14% of the country's demand. This Bhrikuti mill, located at Gaidakot, about 150 km southwest of Kathmandu, has produced 1.600 tons of paper since its trial production a year ago. The mill was designed with a capacity of 10 tons a day. With the assistance of 30 Chinese experts, it will be in full operation by the end of this month and its production is expected to exceed the designed capacity. Identified as deputy director of the State Environment Protection Bureau (XNA, Jun 2, 1987)
Jiao is a newcomer.

Lei Jieqiong 雷洁琼

Elected chairman of the China Association for Promoting Democracy (XNA, Jun 11, 1987)

Lei has been the association's vice-chairman since the 1950s. Other posts held by her: Member of the Standing Committee of the 6th NPL; vice-president of the Women's Federation, and vice-chairman of the 6th CPPCC.

Lin Lanying 林兰英

Identified as vice-chairman of the State Science and Technology Commission (XNA, Jun 16, 1987)
Lin, a specialist in solid state physics, has been deputy director of the Institute of Semiconductors under the Academy of Science since 1977.

Liu Mingjiu 刘鸣九

Appointed vice-minister of supervision (XNA, Jun 23, 1987)
Since 1978 Liu has been a member of the CCP Commission for Inspecting Discipline.

Lu Rongjing 卢荣景

Appointed acting governor of Anhui Province (Beijing Radio, Jun 23, 1987; cit. SWB, Jun 25, 1987)
Lu was born in 1934. Since 1984 he has been deputy secretary of Anhui CP.

Song Ping 宋平

Appointed director of the Organization Department of the CCP (XNA, Jun 23, 1987)
Song was elected a member of the CCP Central Committee in 1977. In 1983 he was appointed state councillor and minister of the State Planning Commission.

Wang Wei-ch'eng 王维澄

Identified as permanent deputy director of the Propaganda Department under the CCP Central Committee (Changsha Radio, Jun 15, 1987; cit. SWB, Jun 19, 1987)
Wang was a newcomer when he could be identified as vice-president of the Association for International Exchange of Personnel in Apr 1984.

Wang Yuzhao 王郁昭

Transferred from his post as governor of Anhui Province to the Rural Policy Research Center under the Secretariat of the CCP Central Committee (Hefei Radio, Jun 23, 1987; cit. SWB, Jun 27, 1987).

Wei Jianxing 尉健行

Appointed minister of supervision (XNA, Jun 23, 1987)

Wei is a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee. Since Sep 1985 he has been director of the Organization Department of the CCP Central Committee.

Xie Shijie 谢世杰

Identified as vice-governor of Sichuan Province (Chengdu Radio, Jun 28, 1987; cit. SWB, Jul 1, 1987)

Xie is a newcomer.

Xu Qing 徐青
