This Bhrikuti mill, located at Gaindakot, about 150 km southwest of Kathmandu, has produced 1.600 tons of paper sice its trial production a year ago. The mill was designed with a capacity of 10 tons a day. With the assistance of 30 Chinese experts, it will be in full operation by the end of this month and its production is expected to exceed the designed capacity. 


