## AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

### People's Republic of Mongolia (Jul 03?)

Protocol on the establishment of a joint border railway transportation committee.

### Bangladesh (Jul 04)

Protocol on China to assist constructing the Shambhugon road bridge.

New co-operation agreement between Xinhua News Agency and the News Agency of Nigeria.

### People's Republic of Mongolia (Jul 04)

Protocol on scientific and technological co-operation for 1987-88. According to the program, the two sides will cooperate in study projects mostly in the fields of animal husbandry, energy, light industry and building material.

### Poland (Jul 04)

Protocol on co-operation between the Chinese Writers' Association and the Polish Writers' Union for 1988-89. The two sides will send delegations to each other's country, exchange literary works and make efforts to publish translated versions of each other's literary works.

### Soviet Union (Jul 06)

Agreement for co-operation 1987-92 between the Chinese Journalists' Association and the Union of Journalists of the USSR.

### Japan (Jul 06)

Second project loan agreement for 1987. Under the agreement, Japan will provide China with a project loan of 85 billion yen (about 570 million US\$). The Japanese loan will help China develop railway transport, expand port facilities, extend its telecommunications network and build a hydro power station. The interest rate of the loan is 3% and it is repayable in 30 years.

### France (Jul 10)

Protocol of finance under which France will provide China a loan of 897 million francs for 13 Sino-French co-operation projects, including the renovation of the Beijing subway. According to the first Sino-French protocol of finance for 1987 between the Chinese and French governments 370.95 million francs, or about 41% of the loan, is provided directly by the French government.

A Letters of intent on co-operation between the Chinese Ministry of Electronics Industry and the Siemens Corp.

B Cooperation agreement on importing trained personnel between the China Construction Machinery Corp. and the Orenstein and Koppel AG.

C Contract between the China Great Wall Industry Corp. (representing the Chinese Academy of Space Technology of the Ministry of Astronautics Industry) and the Space Systems Group of the Messerschmidt-Boelkow-Blohm (MBB) Corp. of the FRG on purchase of equipment and technical co-operation involving DFH-3 (Dongfanghong-3) satellites. According to it, China will use the Long March 3-A carrier rocket to launch a DFH-3 broadcasting and communications satellite in the early 1990s, while the MBB Corp. will enter into co-operation in the design of the satellite system and the supply of some equipment. The project will help China meet its needs for transmitting TV programs and tele-communications in the 1990s, with its technology reaching world level at that time. There will be 24 transponders with six TV transmission channels and 18 communications transmission channels on the satellite.

Gao was a newcomer when he was elected deputy for the PLA to the 6th NPC in May 1983.

### He Jingzhi 贺敬之

Identified as vice-minister of culture (XNA, Jul 29, 1987).

He, a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee and deputy director of its Propaganda Department since 1980, had been vice-minister of culture from 1978 until 1982.

### He Zhukang 何竹康

Appointed acting governor of Jilin Province (XNA, Jul 19, 1987).

He, a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, has been governor of Henan Province before.

### Hui Liangyu 回良玉

Appointed vice-governor of Jilin Province (XNA, Jul 19, 1987).

Hui has been a member of the Standing Committee of Jilin CP before.

### Jiang Chunyun 姜春云

Appointed acting governor of Shandong Province (Beijing Radio, Jul 2, 1987; cit. SWB, Jul 7, 1987).

Jiang has been a deputy secretary of Shandong CP since 1983.

### Li Chang'an 李昌安

Appointed deputy secretary-general of the State Council (XNA, Jul 8, 1987).

Li, a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, had been governor of Shandong Province from Jun 1985 until Jul 1987.

### Ma Zhongchen 马忠臣

Identified as vice-governor of Shandong Province (Jinan Radio, Jul 31, 1987; cit. SWB, Aug 5, 1987).

Ma, an alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, had

been in the same position from Jun 1986 until Apr 1987 when he was appointed deputy secretary-general of the State Council. He was relieved from this post on Jul 8, 1987.

### Wang Guangxi 王广玺

Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Tibet Autonomous Region (Lhasa Radio, Jul 8, 1987; cit. SWB, Jul 15, 1987).

Wang could be identified as secretary-general of Tibet People's Government in Dec 1986.

### Zhang Zhijian

Identified as deputy commander of Jinan Military Region (Jinan Radio, Jul 31, 1987; cit. SWB, Aug 5, 1987).

Zhang is a newcomer.

### Zhen Peiyan

Identified as vice-minister of electronics industry (XNA, Jul 21, 1987).

Zhen is a newcomer.
