**Belgium (Nov 03)**

Loan agreement for 1986. Under it, the Belgian government will provide the Chinese government with interest-free loan for China's light, medical as well as chemical industrial projects.

(XNA, Nov 3, 1986)

**Poland (Nov 06)**

Protocol on the 19th Session of the Sino-Polish Commission of Scientific and Technical Cooperation. Under it, China and Poland will conduct 99 short-term and long-term cooperation projects in the fields of machinery, electronics, metallurgy, agriculture, light textile industry and public health and medicine, showing a considerable increase over last year.

**Yugoslavia (Nov 06)**

Agreement on cooperation in broadcasting and television under which both countries will exchange programs and reporters in the next five years.

**Burma (Nov 07)**

Protocol on the first joint inspection of the China-Burma boundary.

**Nepal (Nov 11)**

Letters of exchange relating to trans-frontier pasturing by border inhabitants on basis of an agreement concluded on Oct 10, 1983. Under them, China agreed to extend the trans-frontier pasturing for Nepalese border inhabitants of Sindhupalchok and Dolakha districts in the pasture grounds of Nyalam county of China's Tibet Autonomous Region to another two years till September 30, 1988. The number of livestock for trans-frontier pasturing shall be discussed and agreed upon between the local officials of the two governments.

**Switzerland (Nov 12)**

A Agreement on mutual promotion and protection of investment.  
B Agreement for cooperation on peaceful uses of nuclear energy. Under it, the two countries will enlarge and strengthen cooperation

on peaceful uses of nuclear energy on the basis of equality and mutual benefit and in the framework of the International Atomic Energy Agency.

**Pakistan (Nov 12)**

Cultural exchange program for 1986 and 1987. According to it, the two countries will exchange delegations in the fields of culture and arts, education, broadcasting, television, films and information, sports and religion.

Plan for the implementation in 1987 and 1988 of the agreement on cultural and scientific cooperation.

**Hungary (Nov 14)**

Cooperation plan for 1987-88 between the Chinese People's Association for Friendship with Foreign Countries and the Hungarian International Cultural Association.

A Summary of the second meeting of the China-CSSR Committee for Trade, Scientific and Technological Cooperation.

Loans agreement between the Chinese State Administration for Building Materials Industry and the Kuwaiti Arab Foundation for Economic Development. According to it, the foundation will provide loans to the Qilu Building Ceramics Plant in Shandong Province.

**Bolivia (Nov 17)**

Contract for agricultural research (for details see under China's Economic Aid).

A Protocol on the 7th meeting of the Committee for Economic and Technical Cooperation.

**Bangladesh (Nov 17)**

10th barter protocol. This is the third protocol concluded under the five-year long-term trade agreement signed in 1984 between the two countries. The ninth protocol for 1986 provided for exchange of goods worth 87m US\$. The protocol stipulated goods from Bangladesh to China for the next year, including raw jute, jute goods, leather, hides and skins, tea, newsprint, urea and light industrial products. China's exports included pig iron, dyes and chemicals, light industrial products and hardware, machinery equipment and spares, diesel, cotton, sugar, steam coal, electric meters and other equipment.

**Canada (Nov 20)**

Memorandum on a Canadian loan of 350 million Canadian dollars (about 252 U.S. dollars) at concessional rates and terms. With the loan China will purchase Canadian capital goods and services, in conjunction with the credit facility between the Export Development Corporation of Canada and the Bank of China dated October 1, 1984. The memorandum becomes effective on Nov 20, 1986 and will terminate on Oct 1, 1988.

**Poland (Nov 28)**

Document on the main direction of long-term economic cooperation. Under it, the two countries will launch cooperation projects in such industrial sectors as raw materials, coal, power, machinery, electronics, chemical, transport, textile and food processing as well as in agriculture.

**North Korea (Nov 29)**

1987-88 executive plan for cultural exchange.

**Pakistan (Nov 29)**

Seven agreements on technical cooperation. Under these agreements, China will help Pakistan technicians study Chinese acupuncture and moxibustion, biogas production and preserving yak semen. China will also provide Pakistan with 20 solar energy stoves and send workers to offer technical services, and receive a Pakistan study-tour group on Chinese buildings and building materials. Meanwhile, Pakistan will receive a Chinese study-tour group on animal husbandry and irrigation projects.

**Sri Lanka (Nov 29)**

Six agreements on technical cooperation. Under these agreements, China will receive a Sri Lanka

study-tour group looking into China's leather goods production, and send technicians to demonstrate their skills in producing handcraft articles and provide technical guidance on low-cost house-building materials production. (XNA, Nov 29, 1986)

**Romania** (Nov 30)  
sports exchange protocol for 1987. Under it, the two countries will coordinate their efforts in such events of common interest as athletics, shooting, fencing, soccer and judo. (XNA, Nov 30, 1986)

**CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID**

**General**  
China has established cooperative relations with developing countries over the past 30 years. In addition to sending 400,000 engineers and technicians, China has trained 35,000 technicians and 3,000 students in 70 countries. Since 1979, China signed 3,000 project and labor service contracts involving 170,000 Chinese workers in 88 countries. Since 1963, it has sent 8,000 medical personnel to 40 countries and regions, treated 70 million patients and trained 10 million medical workers in those countries. Cooperating with the United Nations Development Program, China has set up regional research and training centers to provide services to developing countries. (XNA, Nov 11, 1986)

**Bangladesh**  
Construction of a bridge over the Buriganga river started on Oct 18, 1986. The bridge will be over 874 meters long and 17.6 meters wide, with 21 spans, and horizontal and vertical clearances of 76 meters and 12,2 meters respectively for easy navigation. It will have an underpass at the Dhaka end to ease out traffic congestion. (XNA, Nov 18, 1986)

**Bolivia**  
Under a contract for agricultural research, China will help Bolivia build an experimental station for soybean and peanut crops, another for rice and vegetable crops as well as a tea planting and processing project. (XNA, Nov 17, 1986)

**Cameroon**  
The Lagdo hydro-electric power station was completed with Chinese assistance. The plant, situated on the upper reaches of the Benue

river, will greatly enhance agricultural and industrial development in northern Cameroon. (XNA, Nov 30, 1986)

**Kenya**  
On Nov 28, 1986 thirteen biogas digesters with a total volume of 200 cubic meters built by Chinese experts were handed over. These biogas digesters were built on four sites in Nakuru and Kiambu under a contract signed between the two sides on Feb 19 this year. (XNA, Nov 28, 1986)

**Tanzania**  
Chinese experts constructed three Chinese-type pilot biogas centres and trained 17 local technicians to master the biogas technology. During their two-month stay, the Chinese experts established two biogas centres in Mwanze region and one in Mara region. The three centres have started producing gas for lighting and cooking after completion of the construction. (XNA, Nov 2, 1986)

Oct 31, 1986; cit. SWB, Nov 7, 1986). Wang is a newcomer.

**Xie Fei**  
Appointed secretary of Guangzhou CP (Guangzhou Radio, Nov 8, 1986; cit. SWB, Nov 12, 1986). Xie is an alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee. Since 1983 he has been deputy secretary of Guangdong Province CP.

**Zhang Boting**  
Identified as vice-governor of Shaanxi Province (Xi'an Radio, Oct 28, 1986; cit. SWB, Nov 4, 1986). Zhang is a newcomer.

**Zhang Haoruo**  
Appointed vice-minister of foreign economic relations and trade (XNA, Nov 7, 1986). Zhang has been deputy general manager of the China National Petrochemical Corporation before.

**Zheng Guozhong**  
Identified as commander of Tianjin Garrison (Tianjin Ribao, Oct 7, 1986; cit. SWB, Nov 13, 1986). In Oct 1985 Zheng was elected member of the Standing Committee of Tianjin CP.
