#### CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

#### Botswana

Four documents on economic cooperation were signed on Oct 1, 1986. Under these documents, China will help Botswana renew the 85-kilometer railway line from Francistown up to border with Zimbabwe, provide a batch of agricultural machines including spare parts, and give a new interest-free loan to Botswana. China also agreed that the utilization period of the loan provided under the agreement on economic and technical cooperation between China and Botswana signed on August 8, 1976, will be extended for five years to December 31, 1991. (XNA, Oct 1, 1986)

Guyana

A duckfarm built with China's assistance was handed over on Oct 29, 1986. It is located at Mon Repos, 20 km east of Georgetown. The farm will raise 1,000 breeder ducks and produce 60,000 ducklings annually. However, its actual productivity may double. The project was begun in December 1984 with the ar rival of a four-member Chinese expert group and the introduction of an original batch of 2,700 Beijing and Kunshan duck eggs as well as equipment, such as incubators. Ethiopia

China donated 20 tons of diazinon to help Ethiopia combat locusts. (XNA, Oct 23, 1986)

Two Chinese medical teams arrived in Morocco. Acupuncture experts make up the one team which will work in the city of Mohammedia north of Casablanca. The other team of various medical specialists will go to the southeastern city of Errachidia.

Vice-president Ulanhu has presented 2 water-turbogenerators to the Nepalese King Mahendra Trust for Nature Conservation. (XNA, Oct 14, 1986)

North Korea

49 Chinese engineers and technicians helped to construct the Haijoo paper plant. Construction of the plant was started in 1981, and trial production has just been successfully carried out. Using reeds and bamboo that grow locally as raw material, the plant has a designed annual capacity of producing 11,000 tonnes of paper. (XNA, Oct 1, 1986)

Philippines

The Chinese government presented a set of fishing machines to an aquaculture training center under the Philippine Agriculture and Food Ministry in response to an U.N. call to help Asian countries expand fish and prawn farming. (XNA, Oct 17, 1986)

#### Somalia

A foundation stone was laid on Oct 19, 1986 for an animal husbandry development center near Wenlewen in the State of Hamar. The Chineseaided project is located in the pastoral area in Central Somalia. China will provide medicines to the center, und send veterinarians and build three service stations for livestock there. Meanwhile, a Chinese drilling team has successfully drilled 30 wells in six Somali states to provide drinking water to herdsmen and livestock in northern Soma-(XNA, Oct 19, 1986)

Sudan

China will aid Sudan to build a modernized granary and to renovate the equipment of the Al Hasaheisa textile mill. The granary will be built in Khartoum with a capacity of 12,000 tons. The Al Hasaheisa textile mill has been built by China. According to the protocol, China will dispatch experts to examine and renovate the equipment of the mill, provide spare parts of the equipment and train technicians. (XNA, Oct 22, 1986)

#### Zaire

A Chinese technical team is here to discuss details of an agreement reached last July to help Zaire build a sports complex. The complex will accommodate football, track and field, volleyball and tennis and will include a heliport. (XNA, Oct 25, 1986)

The 330-km Sereje-Mansa road, constructed with Chinese aid, was opened to traffic last month. It enables Zambians in the remote Luapula province to drive to the Zambian capital in only one day. Construction work began in 1977 and lingered on for nine years due to a lack of funds on the part of the Zambians. Chinese technicians actually spent some 43 months on construction of the road, since work had to be halted during the sixmonth rainy season each year. The key to the project is the road bridge spanning the Luapula river. Chinese technicians spent more than four years building the 2,8 kilometre highway bridge, the longest in Africa, with 140 openings and 139 piers.

Qian was born in 1933 and graduated from the Shanghai Tongji University in 1955.

Wu Guanzheng 吴官 1-Appointed governor of Jiangxi Province (XNA, Oct 25, 1986). Wu was born in 1939. In March 1983






