Botswana (Oct 01)

A Agreement on economic and technical cooperation.

A Exchange of notes. Under them, China will assist Ghana in the construction of a theatre and grant Ghana manufactured goods for daily use worth 200,000 Yuan Renminbi (approximately 54,000 U.S. dollars).

B Protocol on goods exchange in 1987-88. Under it, China will import cocoa beans and timber logs from Ghana and export to it farm implements and industrial machines, textile raw materials, jute products, sports goods and stationery, light industrial products, drugs, chemicals and electronics.

Cooperation agreement between the justice ministries.

A Protocol on goods exchange and payments for 1987.

Agreement on a 1987 cooperation plan in the shipbuilding industry.

Australia (Oct 20)

Agreement for the protection of migratory birds and their environments. The agreement involves the control over the taking of migratory birds and their eggs, regulation of trade or exchange of migratory birds and their eggs, formulation of joint research programs on migratory birds, conservation of migratory birds in danger of extinction, establishment of sanctuaries for the protection of migratory birds, controls on importation of animals and plants which are hazardous to the preservation of the birds. Eighty-one species of birds are covered by the agreements. These birds will be protected by the agreement only if there is existing reliable evidence of their migration or joint determination by competent Chinese and Australian authorities through published reports and photographs of the birds.

Protocol on building a granary with Chinese assistance (for details see under "China's Economic Aid").

Agreement on the establishment of a China-Zambia Joint Committee on Economy and Trade.

Soviet Union (Oct 23)

Agreement to establish a committee to oversee matters to do with the Ergune and Heilong rivers which form along stretch of the international border dividing the two countries. It stipulates that the

committee should guide a plan for the comprehensive utilization of the two rivers' water resources (power generation, flood prevention, navigation and water utilization) in an effort to enhance the development of the national economy of both countries.

German Democratic Rep. (Oct 24)

A Agreement on the development of the long-term economic, scientific and technical cooperation. According to the agreement valid for 15 years, the two sides will further explore the possibilities of bilateral economic, scientific and technological cooperation and of the exchange of their commodities in machine-building, electric and electronics industries, agriculture, forestry, animal husbandry, fisheries, ferrous and non-ferrous metal raw material and precision processing industries, petroleum processing as well as coal exploration.

B Protocol 1987 on goods exchange and payments.

Agreement on preventing double taxation and tax evasion.

Protocol on the implementation of the agreement on cultural cooperation during the next four years. Under it, China and Romania will conduct broader cooperation in science, education, culture, broadcast, television, health and sports.

A Agreement on the avoidance of double taxation and the prevention of fiscal evasion with respect to income taxes.

Botswana

Four documents on economic cooperation were signed on Oct 1, 1986. Under these documents, China will help Botswana renew the 85-kilometer railway line from Francistown up to border with Zimbabwe, provide a batch of agricultural machines including spare parts, and give a new interest-free loan to Botswana. China also agreed that the utilization period of the loan provided under the agreement on economic and technical cooperation between China and Botswana signed on August 8, 1976, will be extended for five years to December 31, 1991. Guyana

A duckfarm built with China's assistance was handed over on Oct 29, 1986. It is located at Mon Repos, 20 km east of Georgetown. The farm will raise 1,000 breeder ducks and produce 60,000 ducklings annually. However, its actual productivity may double. The project was begun in December 1984 with the arrival of a four-member Chinese expert group and the introduction of an original batch of 2,700 Beijing and Kunshan duck eggs as well as equipment, such as incubators. Ethiopia

China donated 20 tons of diazinon to help Ethiopia combat locusts. (XNA, Oct 23, 1986)

Morocco

Two Chinese medical teams arrived in Morocco. Acupuncture experts make up the one team which will work in the city of Mohammedia north of Casablanca. The other team of various medical specialists will go to the southeastern city of Errachidia. (XNA, Oct 10, 1986)

Nepal

Vice-president Ulanhu has presented 2 water-turbogenerators to the Nepalese King Mahendra Trust for Nature Conservation. (XNA, Oct 14, 1986)

North Korea

49 Chinese engineers and technicians helped to construct the Haijoo paper plant. Construction of the plant was started in 1981, and trial production has just been successfully carried out. Using reeds and bamboo that grow locally as raw material, the plant has a designed annual capacity of producing 11,000 tonnes of paper. (XNA, Oct 1, 1986)

Philippines

The Chinese government presented a set of fishing machines to an aquaculture training center under the Philippine Agriculture and Food Ministry in response to an U.N. call to help Asian countries expand fish and prawn farming. (XNA, Oct 17, 1986)

Somalia

A foundation stone was laid on Oct 19, 1986 for an animal husbandry development center near Wenlewen in the State of Hamar. The Chinese-aided project is located in the pastoral area in Central Somalia. China will provide medicines to the center, and send veterinarians and build three service stations for livestock there. Meanwhile, a Chinese drilling team has successfully drilled 30 wells in six Somali states to provide drinking water to herdsmen and livestock in northern Somalia. (XNA, Oct 19, 1986)

Sudan

China will aid Sudan to build a modernized granary and to renovate the equipment of the Al Hasaheisa textile mill. The granary will be built in Khartoum with a capacity of 12,000 tons. The Al Hasaheisa textile mill has been built by China. According to the protocol, China will dispatch experts to examine and renovate the equipment of the mill, provide spare parts of the equipment and train technicians. (XNA, Oct 22, 1986)

Zaire

A Chinese technical team is here to discuss details of an agreement reached last July to help Zaire build a sports complex. The complex will accommodate football, track and field, volleyball and tennis and will include a heliport. (XNA, Oct 25, 1986)

Zambia

The 330-km Sereje-Mansa road, constructed with Chinese aid, was opened to traffic last month. It enables Zambians in the remote Luapula province to drive to the Zambian capital in only one day. Construction work began in 1977 and lingered on for nine years due to a lack of funds on the part of the Zambians. Chinese technicians actually spent some 43 months on construction of the road, since work had to be halted during the six-month rainy season each year. The key to the project is the road bridge spanning the Luapula river. Chinese technicians spent more than four years building the 2,8 kilometre highway bridge, the longest in Africa, with 140 openings and 139 piers. (XNA, Oct 12, 1986)

Chen Peimin 陈培民

Identified as deputy political commissar of Beijing Mil.Reg. (Hebei Ribao, Sep 7, 1986; cit. SWB, Sep 29, 1986).

From 1977 until about 1980 Chen had been vice-minister of the State Commission for Physical Culture and Sports. In May 1983 he was elected deputy for the PLA to the 6th NPC.

Dong Xuelin

Identified as commander of Hebei Military District (Hebei Ribao, Sep 7, 1986; cit. SWB, Sep 29, 1986).

Huang Ju 黄菊

Appointed vice-mayor of Shanghai (XNA, Oct 25, 1986).

Huang was born in 1938 and graduated from Qinghua University in 1963. Since 1985 he has been deputy secretary of Shanghai CP.

Liu Bocheng 刘伯承

Deceased Oct 7, 1986 (XNA, Oct 9, 1986).

Liu had been one of the ten marshals of the PLA. Under his Field Army served Deng Xiaoping during the revolution.

Ni Xiance 倪献策

Relieved from his post of governor of Jiangxi Province for serious violations of law and discipline (Nanchang Radio, Sep 27, 1986; cit. SWB, Oct 1, 1986).

Nian Dexiang 年得祥

Deceased Oct 5, 1986 (Lanzhou Radio, Oct 15, 1986; cit. SWB, Oct 18, 1986).

Nian had been an alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee and vice-governor of Gansu Province.

Qian Xuezhong

Appointed vice-mayor of Shanghai (XNA, Oct 25 1986).

Qian was born in 1933 and graduated from the Shanghai Tongji University in 1955.

Tang Longbin 唐龙彬

Identified as assistant foreign minister (XNA, Oct 30, 1986).

Tang had been director of the Foreign Ministry's Protocol Department before.

Wu Guanzheng 吴官正

Appointed governor of Jiangxi Province (XNA, Oct 25, 1986).

Wu was born in 1939. In March 1983 he was elected mayor of Wuhan and in September 1985 alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee.

Yue Qifeng 岳 岐 峰

Identified as deputy secretary of Hebei Province CP (Hebei Ribao, Sep 7, 1986; cit. SWB, Sept 29, 1986). Yue had been secretary of Tangshan City before.

Zhou Wenhua

Identified as deputy secretary of Heilongjiang Province CP (Harbin Radio, Oct 16, 1986; cit. SWB, Oct 13, 1986). Zhou is a newcomer.

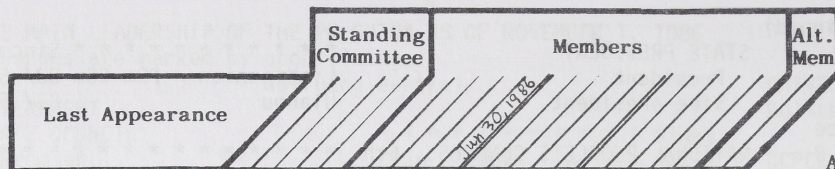
