CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

*

General

Nearly 1,000 Chinese doctors are now working in 41 third world countries and regions according to statistics provided by the Ministry of Public Health, about 8,000 Chinese medical workers have been sent abroad since 1963. They have treated more than 160 million patients, performed operations for 2.7 million people, and handled 410,000 fatal cases. These medical workers, most of whom were physicians-in-charge, came from 26 provinces, municipalities, and autonomous regions all over China. They worked in 50 countries and regions in Asia, Africa and Latin America where they set up 90 medical centers. Their wholehearted service have won many awards from governments of the host countries, in Ethiopia where drought resulted in widespread diseases, a Chinese medical team treated 30,000 patients and performed 200 operations in six months last year. Patients from neighboring countries also went to Ethiopia to see the Chinese doctors. Over the past 20 years, Chinese doctors abroad have trained more than 1,200 local experts in acupuncture, anesthesia and surgery. After attending courses on traditional Chinese medicine many local people
