AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Belgium (Aug 24)

Loan agreement. According to the agreement, in 1987 Belgium is expected to extend to China a loan of 463 million Belgian francs to be used in projects of medicine, chemical industry, textiles, building materials and light industry. (XNA, Aug 24, 1987)

Finland (Aug 24)

A Protocol on revisions to the Sino-Finnish long-term trade agreement.

B Protocol on revisions to the agreement on economic, industrial, scientific and technological cooperation.

Luxembourg (Aug 25)

A Loan agreement under which Luxembourg will provide a low-interest loan of 100 million Lux francs in 1987 to finance the renovation of a blast furnace at the Anshan Iron and Steel Complex.

B Two contracts on technical cooperation for a bell-less top charging system and automation system for monitoring and control of the No.11 blast furnace of the Anshan Iron and Steel Complex.

C Credit agreement between the Bank of China and 3 Luxembourg banks, according to which the latter banks will provide a loan of 250 million Lux francs to finance the projects covered by the 2 contracts.

Malaysia (Aug 15)

Agreement on economic cooperation between the Guangdong Sub-council of the China Council for Promoting International Trade and the Federation of Malaysian Manufacturers. The two sides will cooperate in developing business and trade opportunities and facilitate the exchange of business visits and trade missions. Each party organizes or assists its domestic firms to participate in exhibitions, products-introducing meetings, trade negotiations, international seminars

on economic development, science and technology, to promote trade and economic ties between the two sides. The two sides also agreed to provide each other with published information on economy, trade, science, and other matters as may be mutually agreed upon. Both parties agreed to maintain close liaison regularly towards improving mutual understanding and strengthening economic cooperation.

Second trade protocol between China's Inner Mongolian Autonomous Region and PR Mongolia, worth an estimated 1.05 million U.S. dollars. Earlier this year, the two sides held their first round of talks in Hohhot, capital of Inner Mongolia, and signed a protocol for trade worth 1.38 million dollars. Trade between the two this year is up 53.2 percent. Inner Mongolia and Mongolia did 412,000 dollars worth of business in 1985, the first year of border trade between them.
