## AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

### South Pacific Permanent Commission (Sep 03)

Agreement to cooperate on oceanography and related subjects.

### German Democratic Rep. (Sep 03)

Agreement to cooperate in construction and environmental protection.

### Finland (Sep 04)

Exchange program for culture, education and science in 1988-90.

### Malaysia (Sep 09)

Agreement on maritime transport. According to it, crew members shall be granted the most favoured nation treatment by both contracting parties. In addition, bilateral seaborne cargo of both contracting parties shall, in principle, be carried by vessels of both parties. Vessels of both parties have equal rights and opportunities to carry bilateral seaborne cargo.

Agreement between the Chinese Nuclear Society and the European Nuclear Society. It aims at enhancing mutual understanding and technical exchanges and cooperation in order to promote the development of peaceful uses of nuclear energy.

Protocol of the 8th Session of the Sino-Romanian Economic and Technical Cooperation Committee.

### German Democratic Rep. (Sep 15)

work will involve a search for sylvite in Xinjiang and other research in geophysics, hydrology, engineering, environmental geology, geochemistry and the making of geological meters. The two sides will jointly work on computer technology, data processing and the research and production of post indexing devices.

### Nepal (Sep 16 ?)

Loan agreement. Under it, China agreed to provide a grant assistance of 50 million renminbi (about 13.5 million US\$) for the construction of an international conference center in Kathmandu and for support of some projects currently undertaken in Nepal.

## CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

### Botswana

On Sep 15, 1987 the Chinese-aided railway line renewal project was handed over. It runs from the capital to the country's southern border. At the request of Botswana, China has also agreed to help the country renew another section of

about 85-kilometer railway line from Botswana's northern town, Francistown up to the border with Zimbabwe. The project is scheduled to start in September this year.

Hu, a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, has been governor of Fujian Province before.

### Li Ruihuan 李瑞环

Appointed secretary of Tianjin Municipality CP (XNA, Sep 4, 1987).

Li, a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, has been deputy secretary before and also holds the post of the city's mayor since 1982.

**Li Shouren 李守仁**

Identified as vice-minister of the State Machine Building Commission (XNA, Sep 2, 1987). From Dec 1985 until Nov 1986 Li had been vice-minister of machine building.

**Li Zhensheng 李振生**

Appointed vice-president of the Academy of Sciences (XNA, Sep 5, 1987)

Li has been deputy director of the Northwest Institute of Botany under the Academy of Sciences before.

**Meng Liankun**

Identified as deputy director of the Organization Department under the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Sep 21, 1987).

Meng is a newcomer.

**Qiao Zonghuai 乔宗淮**

Appointed deputy director of the Hongkong Branch of XNA (XNA, Sep 23, 1987).

Qiao, son of the late foreign minister Qiao Guanhua and an alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, has been the branch's deputy secretary-general before.

**Su Xing 苏星**

Appointed acting editor-in-chief of Hongqi (XNA, Sep 9, 1987).

Su has been the paper's deputy editor-in-chief before.

**Wang Qun 王群**

Appointed secretary of Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region CP (XNA, Sep 9, 1987).

Wang, an alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, has been deputy secretary of Hubei Province CP before.

**Wang Zhaoguo 王兆国**

Appointed acting governor of Fujian Province (XNA, Sep 1, 1987).

Wang, a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee and a member of its Secretariat, was brought into the Central leadership by Deng Xiaoping in 1982.
