#### AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Italy (Apr 01)

Memorandum on setting up a modern Italian language center. It will be set up in the Beijing University of Foreign Economic Relations and Trade. The Italian government will supply equipment and help training teachers for the center. (XNA, Apr 01, 1986)

Singapore (Apr 02)

Initialling of a comprehensive agreement for the avoidance of double taxation. (XNA, Apr 02, 1986)

Mongolia, People's Rep. (Apr 07)

A Long-term trade agreement for 1986-90. According to it, the two countries would further develop bilateral trade on the basis of equality and mutual benefit. China will export silk, light industrial products and fresh and dried fruits to Mongolia while importing boards, horseskin and deerhorn.

B Protocol on goods exchange and payments for 1986

(XNA, Apr 07, 1986)

The long-term trade agreement is first since the two sides established diplomatic relations. According to it, China will export light industrial products, textiles, and fruit, while Mongolia is to export timber, animal byproducts and medicine.

(XNA, Apr 17, 1986)

German Democratic Rep. (Apr 09)

Agreement under which Chinese workers will work in German industrial enterprises. The agreement, which covers a period of 10 years, stipulates that the Chinese workers will be employed in German industrial enterprises for two to four years. These enterprises will offer them training courses in the German language and basic job training before they actually start working. (XNA, Apr 09, 1986)

Poland (Apr 09)

Minutes of talks on agricultural cooperation. The minutes set a high value on the achievements the two sides scored in 1985 in exchanges covering fruit trees, bee-breading, ornamental plants and sugar beet.

It pointed out that the two sides would expand the supply of varieties of agricultural products and scientific and technological cooperation.

(XNA, Apr 09, 1986)

Poland (Apr 13)

Cooperation agreement between the Chinese Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications and the Polish Ministry of Posts and Telegraph. It provides that the two ministries will carry out cooperation in post and telecommunication services, development of related sciences and technologies and production of telecommunication equipment. (XNA, Apr 13, 1986)

German Dem. Republic (Apr 17?)

Long-term cooperation agreement between Beijing University and Humboldt University. (XNA, Apr 17, 1986)

Bulgaria (Apr 18)

Sports exchange agreement for 1986. Under it, China will send 12 sports teams to Bulgaria this year. These include a fencing team from April 24 to May 5, a rhythmic gymnastics team between May 9 and 11, a gymnastics team from June 6 to 8, an archery team between June 9 and 15, a shooting team between June 25 and 30, a sports acrobatics team from July 4 to 9, a water polo team between July 27 and August 2, a wrestling team and a sports delegation. Bulgaria will dispatch five teams to China. They include a weightlifting team between June 6 and 24, a rhythmic gymnastics team in October, an archery team between November 24 and December 4. (XNA, Apr 18, 1986)

Singapore (Apr 18)

Agreement on the avoidance of double taxation. It will remove double taxation and provide concessions for any incentives designed to encourage economic development in both countries. It will become effective after being ratified by both governments. It provides that either country would reduce its tax on dividends, interest and royalties received by residents of the other country. (XNA, Apr 18, 1986)

United Nations (Apr 21)

Renewing the cooperation agreement between the United Nations University and the Chinese Academy of Sciences. The cooperation agreement between the two institutions was first signed in 1980 and since then they have worked on several joint projects, including studies on energy, biology and micro processing. They have also cooperated in providing training services to third world countries. The Tokyo-based U.N. University founded by an act of the U.N.

general assembly began to work in September 1975, with support from the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization. The university promotes exchanges among scholars and technicians in various countries and has many research centers around the world. (XNA, Apr 21, 1986)

U.S.A. (Apr 21)

Agreement to extend the 1980 protocol on cooperation in the basic sciences. The agreement provides that the two countries will further their cooperation in natural sciences, engineering and social sciences. The two countries have worked on 81 cooperation projects in these fields in the past five years. (XNA, Apr 23, 1986)

Surinam (Apr 24)

Agreement on economic and technical cooperation. Under it, China will provide Surinam with an interest-free loan, which shall be used for implementing projects to be mutually agreed on, providing individual equipment, general commodities and technical assistance. (XNA, Apr 24, 1986)

Poland (Apr 25)

Agreement to cooperate in several surveying and mapping projects within and outside of the two countries. (XNA, Apr 25, 1986)

Mongolia, People's Rep. (Apr 25) Initialling of a consular treaty. (XNA, Apr 25, 1986)

Iraq (Apr 25)

Agreement on economic and technical cooperation. It stipulates the spheres and principles for the economic and technical cooperation between the two countries in the next five years and provides a basis for their long-term cooperation in these fields, Zhang Jifu said after the signing ceremony. Under the agreement, Chinese firms will contract projects for building irrigation and drainage facilities, highways, bridges and railway in Iraq. (XNA, Apr 25, 1986)

Algeria (Apr 28)

A Protocol on barter trade.

Summary of the 2nd session of the Sino-Algerian mixed commission on economic, commercial, scientific and technical cooperation. (XNA, Apr 28, 1986)

Sri Lanka (Apr 30)

The Sri Lankan cabinet approves an agreement on economic and technical cooperation with China (see C.a., 1986/03, p 174/2). Under the agreement, China provides an interest-free loan of rmb 50 million

yuan (about 15.67 million U.S.dollars) for a period of five years beginning April 1, 1986. This loan will be used for projects agreed upon by the two governments. (XNA, Apr 30, 1986)

#### Liberia

The sports complex constructed with Chinese aid was handed over on April 12, 1986. The sports complex consists of a stadium with 30,000 seats, a sportsman dormitory with 100 beds, nine outdoor exercising grounds and a series of other facilities. The whole complex covers an area of 22.31 hectares and its floor space totals 27,670 square meters. (XNA, Apr 12, 1986)

The Chinese-aided sugar refinery in Lotokila was handed over on April 24, 1986. The sugar refinery, which went into production last October, includes a 3,000-acre sugarbeet farm, a refinery with a daily capacity of 1,000 tons of sugar and a workshop producing 12,000 liters of ethyl alcohol everyday. 


