AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

North Korea (Oct 01)

Protocol on science research between the Chinese and Korean Academies of Sciences. It involves a total of 15 items of joint research concerning physics, biology, maths, geology and geography.

Egypt (Oct 03)

Protocol on technical cooperation in power industry. Under it, China will provide Egypt technical assistance for producing insulation materials for 110,000-volt power transmission, and Egypt will send its technicians to be trained in China for producing insulation materials.

Italy (Oct 05)

Agreement on Italy to send China applied technology to promote Chinese economic and social development. Both sides will attach special attention to exchange of their work in biotechnology, energy, agriculture, health, food and nutrition, communications and information.

Jamaica (Oct 07)

Joint venture agreement of 48.2 million U.S.dollars. It is the first time that China has converted an interest-free loan into a capital investment. China, through the Shanghai No.12 Cotton Mill, will hold 46 per cent of the total investment while Jamaica through Jamaica Industrial Development Corporation (IDC) will hold 54 per cent. The agreement will be ratified through the exchange of letters between the two governments by the end of this month. The joint venture, the Cotton Polyester Textile Company Limited, is expected to be in full operation by the end of October 1988. It will employ 700 peoples. Initially, it will produce

2,000 tons of cotton yarn and 7.5 million metres of cotton grieger goods for export.

Yugoslavia (Oct 08)

Protocol for scientific and technical cooperation through 1988. The agreement includes 89 items, covering architecture, machinery, light industry, electronics and sanitation, on which the two nations will work together on a long-term basis.

Cultural exchange program for 1988-89.

Federal Rep. of Germany (Oct 12)

Agreement on technical cooperation. Under it, the Federal German government will render China a free emergency aid of 10 million Federal German marks. Later today, Chinese state councillor Zhang Jingfu, met with Fried. Lengl, thanking the Federal German government for its free aid to China to compensate for the losses caused by forest fire in northeast China.

Federal Rep. of Germany (Oct 15)

Agreement on the pre-development phase of the project for the MPC 75 aircraft. This is the first time China has cooperated with a foreign aircraft manufacturer in all activities related to an aircraft's production - from the feasibility study, to design, manufacture and marketing. The MPC 75 is a regional passenger aircraft with 75 to 90 seats. The first plane is expected to be completed in 1994.

North Korea (Oct 20)

Sports exchange protocol for 1988. It includes 29 team exchanges covering sports of boxing, marathon, rhythmic gymnastics, wrestling, table tennis, soccer, volleyball, basketball, handball, archery, diving and cycling.

Albania (Oct 21)

Goods exchange and payment protocol for 1988.

Federal Rep. of Germany (Oct 22)

Agreement on juridical exchange. It includes the exchange of legal personnel, holding seminars on the relevant legal regulations of both countries, trade and economic laws and regulations in particular, and information and data concerning the existing regulations and important court decisions of the two countries.

Hungary (Oct 27)

Agreement between the Bank of China and the Hungarian Foreign Trade Bank on the settlement for local barter trade. This is the first agreement of its kind between the head offices of the Chinese bank and an Eastern European bank.

Agreement on private remittances between the citizens of the PR China and the USSR.

CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Tanzania

China has donated about 1.9 million U.S. dollars to the Tanzania-Sambia railway authority. The money will be used to purchase spare parts of railway equipment as part of Tazara's ten-year program launched in 1984 to restore and develop the Uhuru railway. China will provide Tazara with another 57 experts for the maintenance and repair of the line and locomotives in addition to 150 experts under the fifth technical cooperation agreement signed last year.
