Millions of people around the world are receiving benefit from Chinese medical teams working abroad. Last year 4.97 million outpatient visits were recorded by 1,300 Chinese doctors working in more than 40 countries and regions. They have treated a total of 340,000 patients in hospitals including 38,800 critical cases, and performed 153,000 operations. China has been sending medical teams abroad, especially to third world countries, since 1963. There have been, in all, about 10,000 postings to 50 countries and regions. Through the United Nations volunteer organization, Chinese medical workers have been dispatched to the Comoros, Jamaica, Western Samoa, and Niue since last October. China has also responded to invitations from Tanzania and the United States to send acupuncturists to treat Aids victims.
