North Korea (Mar 01)

- A Agreement on cooperation in public health and medical science.
- B Implementation plan for 1986-87 related to the above agreement.

Egypt (Mar 04)

Agreement to launch a joint venture to promote banking in the Islamic world. The new firm will be set up later this year in Yinchuan, Ningxia Hui autonomous region. The two parties in the venture are the Ningxia International Trust and Investment Company and the Faisal Islamic Bank of Egypt.

Nepal (Mar 10)

- A Trade protocol between Tibet and Nepal. Under it, Tibet will increase exports of sheep, wool and salt to Nepal, while Nepal will export more industrial products and grains to Tibet.
- B Agreement on tourism cooperation between Tibet and Nepal. Under it, the two sides agreed to facilitate travel for tourists between the two regions, and to supply each other with necessary goods for the tourists. Both sides agreed that earlier air links between Lhasa and Kathmandu would help tourism development. They also agreed to study the joint efforts in Tibet to collect and process salt for Nepal and the training in Nepal of tourist service and management personnel for Tibet.

Bangladesh (Mar 10)

Agreement on an interest-free loan from China of 500 million taka to be utilized for financing development project in the public sector during the 3rd Five-year Plan.

Turkey (Mar 12)

Minutes of talks of the 4th Meeting of the China-Turkey Joint Economic Committee. According to them, each side will export to the other side 100 million dollars worth of goods. Turkey will import from China

500.000 tons of crude products as well as chrome ore, fertilizers, synthetic fibres and other goods. In strengthening the economic and technical cooperation between the two countries, China will provide technical know-how and equipment in building the Ozkoy Power Plant in Turkey. Under negotiations between the two sides are the establishment of some joint ventures in Turkey and China.

Agreement of the 25th Meeting of the China-Korea Committee for navigation cooperation on the border Rivers of Yalu and Tumen.

Under this program, which was worked out in accordance with a cultural cooperation agreement signed in Cairo on April 15, 1956, the two sides will send delegations of education, theater companies, journalism, public health and youth and youngsters to have mutual visits. Both sides will also send their experts and scholars in historical relics, medicine and agriculture for mutual survey and study, exchange educational and academic materials, documentary films and publications about journalism, children and youth and hold film festivals and exhibitions of arts in each other's country. It will also involve cooperation in physical culture, acrobatics, television and music instrument repair.

- B Letters of exchange about consultation between officials of their foreign ministries and about mutual visits by personnel from their institutes for inter-

national affairs.

Minutes of the 2nd Meeting of the China-Nepal Inter-governmental Economic and Trade Committee. The two sides also stressed the need to encourage and further develop border trade. The Chinese side agreed to commit in 1986 some projects in Nepal through grant assistance.

General

China will arrange 253 projects of foreign aid this year to benefit 67 countries, according to the "international business" paper. These will include 106 construction projects and 101 projects of technical cooperation and management. In 1985, China started construction on 29 projects of foreign aid and completed another 35, the paper added.

China donated 10,000t of grain to the Ethiopian Relief and Rehabilitation Commission.

Liberia

Ding Ling (f) 丁玲

Deceased Mar 4, 1986 (XNA, Mar 4, 1986).

Ding is the most famous Chinese writer of the 20th century.

Ding Qiao 丁峒

Appointed vice-minister of radio, cinema and television (XNA, Mar 24, 1986).

Ding has been vice-minister of culture before.

Gao Zhanxiang 高占祥

Appointed vice-minister of culture (XNA, Mar 24, 1986)

Gao derived from the communist Youth League. In 1982 he was elected alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee and the following year secretary of Hubei Province CP.

Guo Zhenqian 郭振乾

Identified as deputy secretary of Hubei Province CP (Wuhan Radio, Feb 26, 1986; cit. SWB, Mar 3, 1986). Since Jan 1986 Guo holds the post of acting governor of Hubei Province.

Hao Pingnan 郝平南

Relieved from his post as vice-minister of radio, cinema and television (XNA, Mar 24, 1986).

He Jiasheng 何界生

Appointed vice-minister of public health (XNA, Mar 24, 1986). He is a newcomer.

Lin Hua 林华

Relieved from his post as vice-minister of metallurgical industry (XNA, Feb 27, 1986).

Liu Jiang 刘江

Appointed vice-minister of agriculture, animal husbandry and fishery (XNA, Feb 27, 1986).

Liu is a newcomer.

Liu Suinian 柳随年

Appointed vice-minister of the State Planning Commission XNA Feb 27, 1986).

Liu had been in the same position from 1984 until Sep 1985.

Nie has been deputy secretary of Gansu Province CP before.

Qi Huaiyuan 齐怀远

Identified as vice-minister of foreign affairs (XNA, Mar 3, 1986).

Qi has been that ministry's assistant minister before.

Sun Jiazheng 孙家正

Identified as deputy secretary of Jiangsu Province CP (XNA, Mar 27, 1986).

Sun derives from the Communist Youth League. He was by-elected alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee by its National Party Conference in Sep 1985.

Sun Kehua 孙克华

Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Shaanxi Province (Xi'an Radio, Mar 16, 1986; cit. SWB, Mar 19, 1986).

Sun had been vice-governor of Shaanxi from 1982 until Mar 1986.

Wang Rulin 王汝林

Appointed vice-minister of metallurgical industry (XNA, Feb 27, 1986).

Wang is a newcomer.

Xiang Nan 项南

Relieved from his post as secretary of Fujian Province CP (XNA, Mar 15, 1986).

Xiao Peng 肖鹏

Relieved from his post as vice-minister of agriculture, animal husbandry and fishery (XNA, Feb 27, 1986).

Xiao Tong 肖桐
