Under an agreement of May 8 China agreed to send a new 15-member medical team.

China donated 1,000 t of wheat to Ghana.

Guinea
On May 4 China donated biogas equipment. The gift includes 500 sets of gas-rings, 100 gas lights, 500 pressure-gauges and spare parts. Under the auspices of the United Nations, Chinese experts went to Guinea in 1983 to build biogas pits and show Guineans how to use it.

To help combat cholera, China provided 146 cartons of medicine and cholera vaccine for some 40,000 people. (XNA May 11, 1985)

Sudan

China promised to grant 15,000 t of maize as a relief to the drought-stricken people. (XNA May 10, 1985)

Tunisia

China is engaged in the Bourguiba Project which will protect the city of Sfax from floods. This project situated along the river Ezzit will be completed in three years at a cost of 36 million dinars (about 41,4 million U.S. dollars). As its part of the project, the Chinese electric and hydraulic company will construct a 900-meter long canal, valued at 11.81 million dinars (about 13,6 million dollars). (XNA Apr 18, 1985)

On May 1, 1985, a chemical industrial complex was inaugurated in Gafsa. The complex, one of the two largest enterprises in the country, is comprised of four factories, two of which produce tri-super-phosphates (tsp).
