#### AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

##### Hungary (Jun 01)

Long-term trade agreement for 1986-90. Under it China will in the next five years export to Hungary rice, beans, tinned fruits and vegetables, tea, cotton, garments, knitwear, leather shoes, and machinery. Meanwhile, Hungary will export to China steel and aluminum products, urea, trucks and medical instruments.

Total volume of bilateral trade between Hungary and China stipulated by the agreement will double that of the last five years. (XNA, Jun 1, 1985)

##### Great Britain (Jun 03)

A Agreement on economic cooperation. It stipulated that both sides shall create favorable conditions for strengthening economic cooperation between the two countries and for bringing about a rapid increase in their economic ties, and shall strive to promote mutually beneficial and coordinated development of the economic relations of both countries. Both sides will encourage their firms, enterprises and organizations to develop diversified and mutually advantageous cooperation in the economic, industrial, agricultural and technical fields. Under the agreement, China and Britain will expand economic cooperation and exchanges involving technology transfers, manufacturing equipment and products in a wide-range of sectors. The agreement also stipulated that both sides shall provide financial arrangements on as favorable terms as possible for the economic cooperative projects agreed upon by the two sides, within the framework of their respective laws and regulations in force. This agreement goes into effect on 1 January 1986 and shall remain in force until 31 December 1990.

B Agreement on cooperation in the peaceful uses of nuclear energy. It provides that the two governments shall encourage cooperation between the organizations in their respective countries responsible for research in the peaceful uses of nuclear energy, as well as between industrial

enterprises concerned with the development of the peaceful uses of nuclear energy in both countries. The cooperation agreed upon under this agreement shall be exclusively for peaceful purposes. This agreement enters into force upon signature and shall remain in force for a period of 15 years.

##### Norway (Jun 04)

Minutes of talks on strengthening technological cooperation. (XNA, Jun 6, 1985)

##### Italy (Jun 07)

Loan agreements under which Italy is to provide 40 million U.S.dollars of soft-loan and grant more than 10 million U.S.dollars. Under the agreements, Italy will send specialists and technicians to China and provide technical service and transfer technology to Chinese enterprises. The main content of the agreements include: The Italian government is to provide 30 million U.S.dollars of loans and grant 6 million U.S.dollars to tractor plants in Shanghai and Loyang and help them with their technical transformation and personnel training; the Italian side is to provide 10 million U.S.dollars of loans for the Xuzhou-Shanghai power transmission project; the Italian side is to give a ground satellite station to the Chinese side and undertake to bear the expenses for the test of the station; and the Italian side is to grant 2 million U.S.dollars for the construction of a training center of the Shanghai printing house. ##### Germany, Federal Republic (Jun 10)

A Agreement on the avoidance of double taxation aimed at the encouragement of German investment in China.

B Protocol to extend the 1979 economic cooperation agreement for another 10 years starting in 1985.

C Memorandum for nuclear power cooperation.

D Agreement on financial cooperation. (XNA, Jun 19, 1985)

##### North Korea (Jun 11)

Protocol on scientific and technological cooperation. It stipulates that the two countries would conduct cooperation in the fields of agriculture, forestry, light and metallurgical industries, machinery and medicine. (XNA, Jun 13, 1985)

##### Soviet Union (Jun 16)

Protocol on cultural cooperation for 1985. It provides for exchanges of cultural and art delegations and artists and staging of arts exhibitions in each other's country. (XNA, Jun 4, 1985)

##### Netherlands (Jun 17)

Agreement on reciprocal encouragement and protection of investments. Under it, both countries pledge to extend and intensify their economic relations and encourage investments through the creation of stable and favorable conditions for such investments. The agreement will remain in force for 10 years. (XNA, Jun 19, 1985)

##### Portugal (Jun 18)

Minutes on cooperation in science and technology. (XNA, Jun 20, 1985)

##### Uganda (Jun 19)

Agreement on cultural cooperation. Under it, both sides agreed to develop their exchanges and cooperation in the fields of culture, education, science, health, sports, publications, and press and radio broadcasts in line with the principle of equality and mutual benefit. (XNA, Jun 20, 1985)

##### Gabon (Jun 19)

A Protocol on China to despatch an 18-member medical team.

B Summary of the 2nd meeting of the Sino-Gabonese Joint Committee for Cooperation. It says that China and Gabon will cooperate in sea fishing, lumbering, and the building of brick-making factories, a dental clinic and a railway line. (XNA, Jun 20, 1985)

##### France (Jun 20)

Agreement on cooperation in space technology. Both sides agreed that initially the two countries' ground-monitoring and controlling satellite stations would link up for observing, tracing and controlling satellites. Meanwhile, the countries would cooperate on the production of a multi-purpose module for use by satellites surveying natural resources. The two sides also discussed the possibility of cooperating in the production of components for carrier rockets. (XNA, Jun 20, 1985)

The two sides will cooperate on the production of ground-observation satellite platforms, processing of pictures from ground-observation satellites, the link-up of satellite ground-monitoring and controlling stations, and the production of components for carrier rockets.

Germany, Federal Republic (Jun 24) Memorandum on technical cooperation between the General Administration of Civil Aviation (CAAC) and Lufthansa. Under it, the Luft-hansa will provide a CAAC maintenance base with technology, advice and money to raise it to international standards. CAAC will initially employ Lufthansa technology and management experts to draw up maintenance standards, management systems and control programs.

Angola

China donated 2,000 t of wheat to the drought-stricken people of Angola.

Bangladesh

The Chinese government provided 500,000 U.S.dollars in relief aid following the recent cyclone and tidal wave disaster. Prior to this, the Chinese Red Cross had contributed 50,000 U.S.dollars to the Bangladesh Red Crescent.

Barbados

A new team of Chinese agricultural specialists arrived in Barbados to extend the agricultural aid program for another two years.

Kenya

It includes a 40 km long canal system providing all-the-year-round irrigation for 1,030 ha of land and a three-turbine hydroelectric station with a total capacity of 1,500 kW.

Projects in Africa Prepared by the FAO

China will fund eight projects prepared by the UN Food and Agricultural Organization (FAO) to help improve food production and rehabilitate agriculture in several drought-ravaged African countries, the FAO announced here today. The projects, valued at over one million dollars, will be used to rehabilitate and develop irrigation, supply seeds, aid livestock and vegetable production and generally improve the rural food supply in the present and the following two crop seasons in Botswana, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Kenya, Mauritania, Niger, and Somalia. Though designed for quick impact, many of the projects will have a lasting effect on medium and long-term development after the current food crisis. The Chinese government will implement seven projects on a bilateral basis, one in each of the seven countries. China will make 100,000 dollars in trust funds available for FAO to execute an additional rehabilitation project to be specified at a later date.

Guo has been a member of the Standing Committee of Henan Province CP before.

He, a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, has been minister of education before. His ministry was dissolved and the new state commission established instead.

#### He Guanghui

Identified as vice-minister of the State Commission for the Restructuring of the Economic System (official list of a delegation visiting F.R.Germany).

He is a newcomer.

#### He Zhenliang 何振梁

Identified as vice-minister of the State Commission for Physical Culture and Sports (XNA, Jun 26, 1985).

He is a cadre of sports affairs of long standing. His several other positions include: Member of the International Olympic Committee (since 1981), vice-president of the International Assembly of National Sport Organizations (since 1984), and vice-chairman and secretary-general of the Organizing Committee for the 1990 Asian Games.

#### Hua Luogeng 华罗庚

Deceased Jun 6, 1985 (XNA, Jun 13,

1985).

Hua died when visiting Japan in Tokyo. The most prominent positions this famous mathematician held were: Vice-chairman of the 6th CPPCC, vice-chairman of the Children's Foundation and president of the Mathematics Society.

Liu is a newcomer.

**Liu Zhongde 刘忠德**

Appointed vice-minister of the State Education Commission (XNA, Jun 19, 1985).  
Liu is a newcomer.

**Lu Dadong 鲁大东**

Identified as director of the State Office in Charge of Readjustment (Shanghai "Shijie Jingji Dabao", Jun 10, 1985; cit. SWB Jun 27, 1985).

Lu, a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, had been governor of Sichuan (1979-82) and secretary of Sichuan CP (1977-83).

**Lu Kejian 卢克俭**

Identified as deputy secretary of Gansu Province CP (Lanzhou Radio, Jun 20, 1985; cit. SWB, Jun 26, 1985).  
Lu, a Tibetan, has been member of the Standing Committee of Gansu CP before.

**Ma Yuan (f) 马原**

Appointed vice-president of the Supreme People's Court (XNA, Jun 18, 1985).  
Ma, born in 1929, became known when she was elected a judge of the Supreme People's Court in 1981. Two years later she was elected a member of the Standing Committee of the Women's Federation.

**Meng Zhongren**

Appointed president of the Military Court of the PLA (XNA, Jun 18, 1985).  
Meng is a newcomer.

**Ni Xiance 倪献策**

Elected deputy secretary of Jiangxi Province CP (XNA, Jun 16, 1985).  
Since 1983 Ni also holds the post of a vice-governor of Jiangxi.

**Peng Peiyun (f) 彭佩云**

Appointed vice-minister of the State Education Commission (XNA, Jun 19, 1985).

Peng has been vice-minister of education until one day before, when this ministry was dissolved.

**Qiao Xiaoguang 乔晓光**

Resigns as 1st secretary of Guangxi Autonomous Region CP (Nanning Radio, Jun 20, 1985; cit. SWB, Jun 25, 1985).

Qiao is a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee.

**Qin Hezhen 秦和珍**

Resigns as chairman of the People's Congress of Shandong Province (Jinan Radio, Jun 3, 1985; cit. SWB, Jun 8, 1985).

**Quan Shuren 全树仁**

Identified as deputy secretary of Liaoning Province CP (Shenyang Radio, Jun 15, 1985; cit. SWB, Jun 18, 1985).

Quan has been secretary before.

Resigns as leading secretary of Shandong Province CP; elected chairman of the Advisory Commission of Shandong CP (Jinan Radio, Jun 2, 1985; cit. SWB, Jun 6, 1985).

**Sun Weiben 孙维本**

Elected deputy secretary of Liaoning Province CP (Shenyang Radio, Jun 15, 1985; cit. SWB, Jun 18, 1985).

Sun, an alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, has been secretary of Liaoning CP before.

**Tao Aiying 陶爱英**

Elected deputy secretary of Guangxi Autonomous Region CP (Nanning Radio, Jun 20, 1985; cit. SWB, Jun 25, 1985).

Tao, who belongs to the Zhuang minority, is a newcomer.

**Wan Shaofen (f) 万绍芬**

Elected (leading) secretary of Jiangxi Province CP (XNA, Jun 16, 1985).

Wan, born in 1931, is the first female leading Party secretary in the history of the provinces. She derives from the Communist Youth League. Before her new election she has been a member of the Standing Committee of Jiangxi CP.

**Wang Chenghan 王诚汉**

Retires as commander of Chengdu

Military Region (Chengdu Radio, Jun 13, 1985; cit. SWB, Jun 15, 1985).

**Wang Mingda 王明达**

Appointed vice-minister of the State Education Commission (XNA, Jun 19, 1985).

Wang is a newcomer.

**Wang Tao 王涛**

Appointed minister of petroleum industry (XNA, Jun 18, 1985).

Wang is a newcomer. He was born in 1932 in Leting, Hebei Province. A specialist in geology, he worked as an engineer at the Dagang oil-field and with the China National Offshore Oil Corporation.

**Wu Jinghua 伍精华**

Appointed secretary of Tibet Autonomous Region CP (XNA, Jun 10, 1985).

Wu, a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, has been vice-minister of the State Nationalities Affairs Commission before. Born in 1931 in Mianning, Sichuan Province, into a family of Yi nationality he joined the CCP in 1949, served in the PLA and started his political career in 1953 in the later Liangshan Yi Autonomous Prefecture in Sichuan.

**Xia Nai 夏鼐**

Deceased Jun 19, 1985 (XNA, Jun 19, 1985).

The famous archeologist at last holds several prominent positions: Honorary president of the Archeology Society, vice-president of the Academy of Social Sciences, and member of the National Academy Degrees Committee under the State Council.

**Xiao Quanfu**

Resigns as commander of Ürümqi Military Region when it merges with Lanzhou Military Region (Hongkong "Wen Wei Po", Jun 14, 1985; cit. SWB, Jun 18, 1985).

**Xiao Yang 肖全夫**

Elected mayor of Chongqing (XNA, Jun 22, 1985).

Xiao is a newcomer. He was born in 1930 and studied at Qinghua University and later in the German Democratic Republic.

**Xu Qin 许勤**

Elected deputy secretary of Jiangxi Province CP (XNA, Jun 16, 1985).

Xu, an alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, has been secretary of Jiangxi CP before.

**Xu Yuancun 徐元存**

Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Jilin Province (XNA, Jun 1, 1985). Xu is a newcomer.

**Yang Baibing 杨白冰**

Appointed political commissar of Beijing Military Region (Hongkong "Wen Wei Po", Jun 14, 1985; cit. SWB, Jun 18, 1985). Yang has been deputy political commissar in this region before.

**Yang Baibing** Identified as deputy director of the International Liaison Department, CCP Central Committee (XNA, Jun 30, 1985). Yang is a newcomer.

**Yang Haibo 杨海波** Appointed vice-minister of the State Education Commission (XNA, Jun 19, 1985).

Yang, an alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, had been vice-president of the Beijing Science and Technology University (1979-82 ?) and deputy secretary of Anhui Province CP (1983-84).

Yangling, an alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, has been secretary of Tibet CP before.

**Yu Hongen 于洪恩** Appointed minister of coal industry (XNA, Jun 18, 1985).

Yu, a member of the CCP Central Committee, has been vice-minister in the same ressort before.

**Yu Ke 于克** Resigns as chairman of the People's Congress of Jilin Province (XNA, Jun 2, 1985).

**Yue Xiaoxia 岳肖峡** Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Henan Province (Zhengzhou Radio, Jun 6, 1985; cit. SWB, Jun 12, 1985). Yue has been a vice-governor of Henan before.
