The agreement runs for eight years and can be extended for another three years if both sides so wish. After its completion, the latter, which traverses three provinces of At-tamin, Salahuddin and Diyala, is capable of irrigating 250,000 hectares and will greatly promote the agricultural production in the northern part of the country. The Dibis dam, 200 km north of Baghdad, is situated in a scenic tourist area. (XNA, Aug 13, 1985)

The dam spanning the lesser Zab river about 90 km downstream of the Dokkan dam, and lying about 40 km north of Kirkuk will cost 12.6 million U.S.dollars. The embankment and cut-off of the original dam are reported to have been washed away by flooding. (XNA, Aug 28, 1985)

Sierra Leone

China agreed to give 3,000 t of maize as an interest-free loan. The maize will arrive in 2 shipments over a two-year period. Sierra Leone will repay the loan on a barter basis from 1990-94. (XNA, Aug 31, 1985)
