**Canada** (Nov 04)  
Supplement to the memorandum of understanding on agricultural cooperation, related to the setting-up of a China-Canada Joint Agricultural Committee. (XNA, Nov 4, 1985)

**Mongolia, People's Rep.** (Nov 05)

Agreement on frontier trade between the Mongolian PR and Inner Mongolian Autonomous Region. Under the agreement, which totals about 230,000 U.S.dollars, the Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region will export to Mongolia light industrial products while importing papers and shoes. The two sides also reached a primary agreement for the exchange of rice and flour for the first quarter of 1986. (XNA, Nov 5, 1985)

**Argentina** (Nov 07)  
A Additional protocol to the agreement on economic cooperation of June 1980. According to it, China and Argentina will cooperate in vegetable growing and processing, fruit trees planting and fruit processing, the construction of granary, and the processing of grain and oil-bearing seeds. The cooperation items also include the management of grazing grounds, marine catch and freshwater raising, planting of forests and multi-purpose use of timber, the exploration, development and smelting of non-ferrous metals.

B Exchange of notes on the Bank of China providing the Central of Argentina with 20 million U.S. dollars of export credit loans for helping China to export to Argentina. (XNA, Nov 7, 1985)

**Japan** (Nov 07)  
Agreement on scientific and technological exchange. Under it, the two sides will carry out scientific and technological exchanges of various forms in chemical industry, electrical equipment, electronics, machinery, civil engineering, fibers, steel, transportation, environmental protection and other areas of common interest. (XNA, Nov 7, 1985)

Agreement on news cooperation between Xinhua News Agency and TELAM. (XNA, Nov 8, 1985)

Financial agreement. Under it, China will provide an interest-free loan to finance the construction of a 5,000-seat gymnasium and a swimming pool.

**Pakistan** (Nov 13)  
Border trade agreement for 1985. Its volume is expected to reach 5 million Pakistan rupees this year, as against 4.5 million rupees last year. China's exports to Pakistan boast of more than 200 varieties including textiles, light industrial products, metal tools, and ceramics while its imports from Pakistan include dry fruits, textiles, cigarettes and medicinal herbs. Goods are transported in both directions via Khunjerab pass on the Pamirs. A 420-kilometer-long highway will be rebuilt to link the pass with Kashi, a major town in the western part of China's Xinjiang Uygur Autonomous Region. (XNA, Nov 13, 1985)

**Yugoslavia** (Nov 13)  
Protocol on scientific and technical cooperation for 1985-86. The two countries will carry out cooperation in building industry, metal-making, agriculture, food industry, machine building, organic-chemistry and biology in 1985 and 1986. Scientists will be exchanged for a wide range of study. (XNA, Nov 13, 1985)

**United Arab Emirates** (Nov 14)  
Agreement on economic, trade and technical cooperation. (XNA, Nov 14, 1985)

**Bulgaria** (Nov 15)  
Summary of the 1st Session of the Commission for Economic, Trade, Scientific and Technical Cooperation. Under it, China and Bulgaria reached agreement on a number of cooperative schemes, such as Bulgaria's participation in production and technical transformation of a forklift truck works and a grape winery in China. (XNA, Nov 15, 1985)

**Japan** (Nov 15)  
Agreement to promote grain and cotton trade and to expand the cooperation in construction of ports in China. (XNA, Nov 15, 1985)

**Bulgaria** (Nov 16)  
Minutes on expanding cooperation

in trade, machinery, electronics, chemical industry, food processing and agriculture. (XNA, Nov 16, 1985)

**Australia** (Nov 19) Five-year scientific and technical cooperation agreement to exchange personnel and information between the China National Nonferrous Metals Industry Corporation and Australia's Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organization. (XNA, Nov 19, 1985)

**France** (Nov 19) Cultural exchange program for 1986-87. (XNA, Nov 19, 1985)

**Poland** (Nov 19) Agreement on exchange of delegations and the provision of information about literary events between the Polish and Chinese Writers' Associations. (Warsaw Radio, Nov 19, 1985, cit. SWB, Nov 26, 1985)

**Australia** (Nov 20) Memorandum on the expansion of cooperation and technical exchange in the field of transport. (XNA, Nov 20, 1985)

**Yemen, People's Dem. Rep.** (Nov 20) Contract on a project of irrigation and levelling of soil. The project, financed by Arab Fund for Economic and Social Development and Kuwaiti Development Fund, includes the levelling of 3,000 hectares of land and the building of water conservancy facilities. The project to be undertaken by the China Construction Engineering Corporation is scheduled to be completed in two years. The value of the contract is 12.62 millions U.S.dollars. (XNA, Nov 20, 1985)

**France** (Nov 21) Minutes of talks of the Joint Session on Scientific and Technological Cooperation. Priorities will be given to bio-engineering, agriculture, food and farm produce processing industries, energy and transport. (XNA, Nov 21, 1985)

**Singapore** (Nov 21) Agreement on the promotion and protection of investment. The two governments expressed their desire in the agreement to create favorable conditions for greater economic cooperation and investment in each other's country based on the principle of equality and mutual benefit. (XNA, Nov 21, 1985)

**Soviet Union** (Nov 22) Initialling of a new consular treaty. The previous Sino-Soviet

consular treaty was concluded in 1959. In view of the fact that after 26 years a considerable part of it no longer meets the needs of the current situation, the two sides decided to replace it with a new one. (XNA, Nov 22, 1985)

**India** (Nov 23) Trade agreement worth 100-160 million U.S.dollars during 1986. Among the goods China intends to import from India are iron, chrome and manganese ores, steel products, tobacco, finished leather, shellac, and power station equipment and other machinery. India plans to import Chinese raw silk and silk products, edible vegetable oils, fresh water cultivated pearls, coal, mercury, antimony, petroleum and petrochemical products, and pharmaceuticals. (XNA, Nov 23, 1985)

**Malaysia** (Nov 23) A Agreement on the avoidance of double taxation and prevention of fiscal evasion with respect to income taxes. It provides that China and Malaysia will avoid double taxation on business profits, investment returns and income from labor service.

B Cooperation agreement between the China Council for the Promotion of International Trade and the Sino-Malay Chambers Council of Malaysia. Under it, the two councils will unequivocally support the promotion and development of direct trade between China and Malaysia.

C Memorandum of understanding by the China Metallurgical Import and Export Corporation and Malaysia's Sabah Gas Industries. (XNA, Nov 23, 1985)

**Poland** (Nov 23) Protocol to further the bilateral trade exchanges and economic and technical cooperation. Both sides will explore possibilities of widening cooperation in the fields of energy, transport, machinery, electronics and building materials. (XNA, Nov 23, 1985)

**Kuwait** (Nov 25) Agreement on investment protection. (XNA, Nov 25, 1985)

**Singapore** (Nov 25) Agreement between the China Resources (Holdings) Company and Trade and Intraco Ltd. of Singapore to establish a transnational corporation to promote sales of products from both countries on the world market. (XNA, Nov 25, 1985)

**North Korea** (Nov 26) Consular treaty.

(XNA, Nov 26, 1985)

**Japan** (Nov 28) Agreement between the Civil Aviation Administration of China and the Development of International Transportation and Tourism of Japan's Transport Ministry on the increase of 45% in passenger transport capacity on air routes between China and Japan. (XNA, Nov 28, 1985)

**Netherlands** (Nov 28) Five-year coal supply agreement between the China National Coal Import and Export Corporation and the Dutch Coal and Shipping Company. Under it, China will supply the Netherlands with 400,000 tons of steamcoal in 1986, 600,000 tons in 1987 and one million tons each in the following three years. (XNA, Nov 28, 1985)

**Hungary** (Nov 28) Agreement on cooperation between the Academies of Sciences during 1986-87. (XNA, Nov 29, 1985)

**U.S.A., Hongkong** (Nov 29) Long-term cooperation agreement on safe use of nuclear power between China's Nuclear Industry's Nuclear Power Software Center, the U.S. Energy Incorporated and ATOZTEC Consultants Ltd. of Hongkong. Under the agreement, the three sides will expand cooperation on nuclear power software technology and personnel and data exchanges. (XNA, Nov 29, 1985)

**CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID**

**Iraq** The cornerstone for rebuilding Iraq's Dibbis dam was laid at a place 45 kilometers northwest of the city of Kirkuk today. The project of this medium-sized dam was contracted by the China International Water and Electric Corporation which will undertake the whole process of the reconstruction from designing and geological prospecting to concrete pouring and dam erection. The dam across the lesser Zab river, a tributary of the Tigris river, was originally built in 1962 and was destroyed in a flood in November 1983. The reconstruction of the dam is a part of the "Saddam water irrigation project", which will bring 250,000 hectares of farmland into irrigation in three provinces of Iraq. (XNA, Nov 5, 1985)

Kenya

China is to provide an interest-free loan to Kenya to finance construction of a 5,000-seat gymnasium and a swimming pool, according to a financial agreement signed on 11th Nov 1985. (XNA, Nov 11, 1985)

Mozambique

On Nov 5, 1985, China handed over a donation of 5,000 t of maize. (XNA, Nov 6, 1985)

Pakistan

On Nov 5, 1985, prime minister Jun-jeo inaugurated a 12.7 cm gun factory at the Pakistan Ordnance Factories in Wah. He thanked China for assistance in connection with the construction of this project. (Karachi Radio, Nov 5, 1985, cit. SWB, Nov 1, 1985) The Pakistan State Engineering Corporation and China's National Machinery Export and Import Corporation have signed an agreement under which a heavy electrical complex will be set up in Pakistan to manufacture high-voltage power transformers. These transformers will be used in heavy voltage transformer lines to extend the power distribution system in Pakistan. (Karachi Radio, Nov 8, 1985, cit. SWB/W, Nov 26, 1985)
