Theater Building

Under a protocol of December 1965 (1) this project was started with Chinese assistance in Mogadishu in November 1966 (2) and completed in November 1967 (3). The theater, the equipment of which was totally supplied by China, has 1,200 seats. It can be used as a cinema and conference room, too (3). Its floorspace covers 4,100 square meters, its height is 24 meters (4).

Rice and Tobacco Experimental Station

The station was set up at Jowhar, 100 km from Mogadishu on the

Sheblili river. Construction started in 1966 (1) and was completed at the end of 1969 (2). Samples of the first "Somali Cigarettes" produced from tobacco of the station were handed over to the Supreme Revolutionary Council of Somalia in December 1969 (3). Early in 1970 China agreed to enlarge the experimental station (4). Due to the station's guidance, 300 hectares of rice were sown in the Jowhar District in 1974 (5).

Well-drilling I

At Hargeisa a well-drilling project was started with Chinese aid (1) in August 1969 (2). At Ged Gedleh six wells were sunk which produce 4,000 cubic meters of water a day (3). The whole project was put into operation in February 1974. It is able to meet the need for water of the inhabitants and livestock in Hargeisa, thus ending the history of water shortage in this second largest city of Somalia (4). The project sends underground water to the city and its suburbs over a distance of 25 kilometers for the north of the city, thus making it possible for the more than 100,000 inhabitants and herdsmen and their livestock for the first time to get enough water (5). The volume of water supplied by the project increased to 2,200 tons daily in August 1976 as compared with 1,800 and 860 tons in the same month in 1975 and 1974 respectively. In August 1976 there were 32 running water supply centers in the residential areas of the city (6).

Well-drilling II

Under a protocol of 1969 (1) and minutes of talks of 1975 (2) the well-drilling and water supply works in Baidoa were constructed from November 1977 until July 1979. Due to this project, the 30,000 people living in Baidoa, 240 km west of Mogadishu, are supplied with 1,000 tons of water a day. They are served from ten pumps, erected in various parts of the city (3).

Cigarette and Match Factory

Under a protocol of March 1971 (1) the factory was set up with Chinese assistance in Mogadishu. Its annual capacity is 23,000 cartons of cigarettes (10,000 cigarettes per carton) and 12,000 cartons of matches (1,000 small boxes per carton). The factory went into operation in October 1974 (2).

Construction of the Belet Wen (Beletweyne) -Burao road started in July 1973 and was completed in August 1978 (1). It stretches 970 km from Belet Wen in the south through the northeast and northwest via Garowe to Burao (2). The surface of the road is paved with asphalt (3).

Hospital

Construction of the Benadir gynaecology, obstetrics and pediatrics hospital started in December 1974 and the hospital was handed over in March 1977 (1). It is situated to the southwest of Mogadishu (2). In 1978 9 Somali acupuncturists were trained at the hospital under the tutorship of Chinese acupuncturists (3). The hospital has a staff of only 40 and handles an average of 400 out-patients per day. In the first two years of its existence over 200,000 women were treated there and 20,600 babies delivered (4).

Stadium

Construction of the Chinese-aided Mogadishu stadium started in December 1975 (1) and was completed in November 1977. It has a capacity of 30,000 seats, covers a building area of 23,000 and a total area of 210,000 square meters, has playing fields and training facilities for athletics and ball games, and a dormitory building which can house 200 sportsmen (2).

Dam Project

The Fanole dam project on the Juba river (1) in Jelib District in southern Somalia (2) has been undertaken by the Chinese since the Soviet experts were driven out of Somalia in 1978. It is the

first key water control project in Somalia for hydro-power generation and irrigation and water supply for local residents (2). The inauguration of the hydraulic power station and the main canal took place in October 1982. This Fanola project is the largest agricultural project in Somalia. 370 Chinese experts worked on it (3). The power station has two generators with a capacity of 4,600 kilowatts (2). In 1983 the project irrigated 40,000 ha (4).

Rice Farm

The Bala Weyne state owned-rice-planting farm, located near Jowhar, the capital of the Middle Shabelle Region, was handed over as a gift of China in October 1971. It is situated about 90 km northeast of Mogadishu and has 300 ha of cultivated land (1), a pumping station, a grain processing plant, a storehouse, and an administration office. Egypt

The China Construction Engineering Corporation won a bid for building 1,000 low-cost flats. The 1,000 flats will be built in the "October 6" city, close to the pyramids and 17 kilometers from Cairo. The city, one of the 9 satellite towns of the capital, is to be built under a government plan. When built, the towns will ease the housing shortage and traffic jam in Cairo.

Notes exchange on grain-increasing cooperation. According to the document, Japan will provide agricultural machinery, chemical fertilizers, pesticides and transport vehicles gratis to help China increase grain production.
