The Chinese Red Cross donated 20,000 U.S. dollars to aid hurricane victims (XNA Apr 5, 1984)

Sierra Leone

A housing project was handed over in April 1984. It consists of living quarters for the Magbass sugar mill. (XNA Apr 17, 1984)

Somalia

In April 1984 a gravity irrigation project was inaugurated which is located on the bank of the Shabeelle river, at a farm 110 km north-west of Mogadishu. The pro-ject was completed in four and a half months at a cost 680,000 shillings less than the 2.680 million allocated by the Somali government. It consists of a sluice gate to stop the sand, a sluice gate for gravity flowing, a terminal flood-gate, a canal and a flood-control dam.

Japan (Apr 10)

Summary on scientific and technical cooperation. According to it, the two countries will: send four study groups from each side on academic visits; continue the joint research begun in 1981 on forecasting and estimating crop dis-eases and insect pests. Soviet Union (Apr 16) Protocol on student exchanges for the 1984-85 school year. 70 students will be exchanged between the two sides for one or two years' study in natural science, technical science and social science, apart from languages.

Great Britain (Apr 17) Agreement on the establishment of consulate-generals in Manchester and Shanghai (XNA Apr 17, 1984)

German Democratic Republic (Apr 18, 1984)

Summary of talks on economic cooperation. According to the document, the GDR will participate in technological reforms of China's industrial enterprises including the manufacture of agricultural machine tools and heavy equipment. (XNA Apr 19, 1984)

Ethiopia (Apr 19)

- A Trade protocol. Under it China will export to Ethiopia textiles, garments, tea, building materials, metals and steel products, machinery and farm tools, and will import from Ethiopia coffee, pulse, hides and skins, gum and frankincense.

Goods exchange contracts between the Irade Corporation of the Nei Mongol Autonomous Region and the Far East Foreign Trade Corporation of the Soviet Union (XNA Apr 25, 1984)

Austria (Apr 24)

Agreement on scientific and technical cooperation. Under it, the two sides will exchange publications, information and documents on science and technology and scientists and experts to conduct scientific study and research, work on joint project as well as promote direct cooperation between universities and other scientific research institutions. It also stipulates that a mixed committee composed of representatives and experts of the two countries be established to deal with matters relating to the cooperation. (XNA Apr 25, 1984)




