An agreement on the exchange of caravans between Gilgit and Kashgar was finalized earlier this year. A caravan of Pakistani merchants and goods will leave for Kashgar in the first week of November while a Chinese caravan will reach Gilgit in the last week of December. China-Pakistan border trade, which began in 1969, now amounts to 4.5 million rupees (about 300,000 US\$) in volume.

**CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID**

**Bourkina-Fasso (ex Upper Volta)**  
Under a contract of Aug., 1984, China agreed to build a hospital. The new 150-bed hospital will be situated in Koudougou, Bourkina province. Its departments will include internal medicine, ophthalmology, ear-nose-throat, gynaecology, paediatrics, acupuncture, massage, emergency service and pharmacy.

**Cameroon**  
The Lagdo hydro-electric power station, which was constructed with Chinese aid, was consigned to Cameroon on July, 4. It consists of four generating units with a general installed capacity of 72,000 kilowatts. On Aug 13, 1984 the China National Complete Plant Export Corporation signed a technical service contract with the Cameroonian National Power Company, under which the Chinese corporation will send a technical service team to the Lagdo hydro-electric power station. The Chinese team of technicians will assist their Cameroonian counterparts in developing an equipment maintenance and repair program for the hydropower station, and also help train Cameroonian technicians and managerial personnel.

The National Center for Pharmaceuticals Production built with Chinese aid will begin trial production in October this year. Construction was started in 1981.
