Summary of the 2nd session of the China-Iraq Joint Committee of Trade Exchange and Technical and Economic Cooperation. According to a list of recommended goods for exchange attached to the summary, China may import dates, phosphate fertilizer and sulphur from Iraq while Iraq may import textile and light industrial products, machinery, native and handicraft products from China.

change in the fields of archeology, music, theatre, dance, cinema as well as in pedagogy and teaching. (XNA Dec 14, 1984)

Liberia (Dec 13)

Agreement on an interest-free loan. According to the agreement, the loan is for projects to be agreed upon by the two sides, and to pay for the cost overruns on projects financed by a 1978 loan. (XNA Dec 14, 1984)

Bulgaria (Dec 13)

Goods exchange and payment agreement for 1985. (XNA Dec 14, 1984)

Japan (Dec 13)

Memorandum on the 15-year loan of 580 billion yen (about 2.4 billion U.S.dollars, the annual interest rate of which is 7.125%. (XNA Dec 13, 1984)

Zaire (Dec 15)

Agreement on setting up a mixed inter-governmental commission to reinforce and develop economic, trade and technical cooperation. (XNA Dec 16, 1984)

Sudan (Dec 15)

A Trade protocol. Under it both countries will import 50 million U.S.dollars-worth of goods from each other from July 1984 to June 1985.

B Loan agreement. Under it China will extend an interest-free loan to Sudan from 1986 to 1990.

C Protocol on a Chinese grant of 2,000 tons of maize.

D Protocol on Chinese intesion to carry out feasibility studies on expansion of a textile mill, rice growing and utilization of medical herbs in Sudan. (XNA Dec 15, 1984)

German Democratic Republic

Agreement on goods exchange and payments for 1985. Under the agreement China will export rice, canned food, textiles, native produce, animal by-products, light industrial products and minerals to GDR while importing trucks, farm and textile machinery, potassium chloride and machine tools. (XNA Dec 20, 1984)

Bangladesh (Dec 21)

A Long-term trade agreement, under which goods worth about 200 to 250 million U.S.dollars will be exchanged each way over the next five years. Under the new five-year trade accord, China will export to Bangladesh coal, steel billets, pig iron, raw cotton, rice, diesel oil,

lubricating base oil, consumer goods and chemicals. China will import from Bangladesh raw jute, jute goods, hides and skins, finished leather products, processed timber, tobacco, newsprint, electric wires and cables and telephone cables.

B Barter protocol for 1985 under which goods worth 32 million U.S.dollars will be exchanged each way. (XNA Dec 28, 1984)

A Working plan for scientific and technological cooperation between the Academies of Sciences of China and Korea.

B Agreement on cooperation in science and education between the Chinese University of Science and the Korean University of Science. (KCNA Dec 27, 1984; cit. SWB Dec 31, 1984)

Japan (Dec 26)

Notes exchange on the establishment of additional Chinese consulate generals in Fukuoka and Nagasaki. (XNA Dec 26, 1984)

Soviet Union (Dec 28)

A Agreement on economic and technical cooperation. It stipulates that the two countries will study and exchange production technologies and technical know-how, design build and transform industrial enterprises and other projects, provide each other with technical services and train each other's technical personnel.

B Agreement on scientific and technological cooperation. It calls for the exchange of scientific and technological groups, scholars and experts, exchange of scientific and technological information and data, and joint study and exchange of scientific research achievements.

C Agreement on the establishment of a Sino-Soviet committee for economic, trade, scientific and technological cooperation. This committee will mainly supervise the implementation of agreements and protocols on economic, trade, scientific and technological co-operation between the two countries, promote steady development of economic, trade, scientific and technological co-operation, and jointly study measures for expanding such co-operation.
